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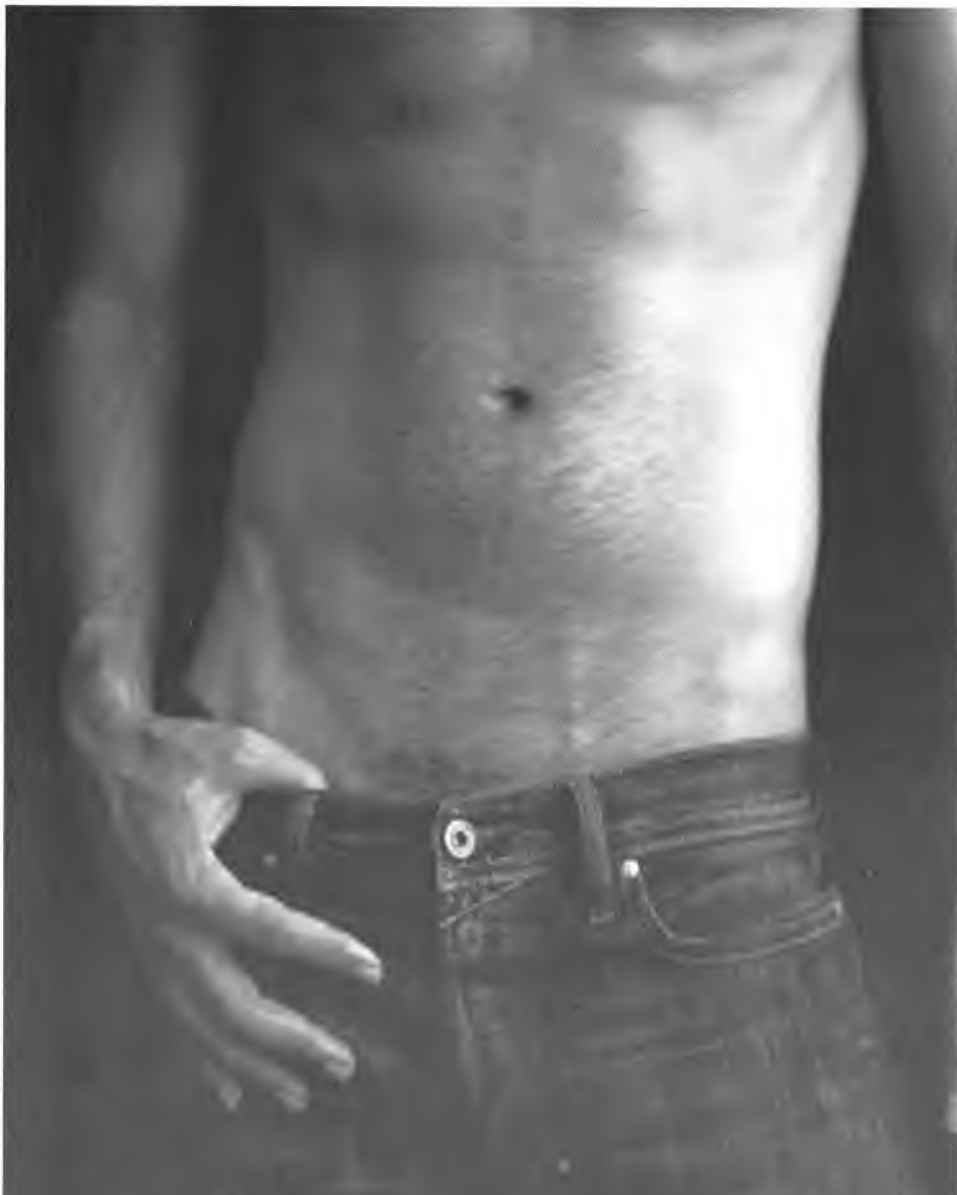

this musical collection is concerned, the "thumpa-thumpa" dance hits (as the boys on the show say) are well chosen: you'll find everything from the remix of club classic "Free" by Ultra Naté to DV Roxx's rave-style "Hardcore MuthaF***a," on through to a pumped-up remix of Cyndi Lauper's "Shine," a track exclusive to this collection. 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Hi, my name is Mike and I work for the Winnebago County Health Department as a STD/HIV Prevention Specialist. For my first column I thought I would write about a STD, you have to start somewhere I guess.

The Sexually Transmitted Disease I would like to write about is an oldie but goodie... Gonorrhea... the Clap... the Drip... Getting Burned...

Gonorrhea is a bacterial infection that is sexually transmitted and it is spread from person to person during anal or oral sex. It causes an infection the penis, throat or rectum. Symptoms may include a yellow or white drip from the penis, you may notice stained underwear, burning or pain while peeing, peeing more often, pain and swelling in the testicles. Approximately 90% of men have noticeable symptoms. Symptoms usually appear within 1 to 30 days after having sex with an infected partner. It is not unusual for someone to be without symptoms and still be infected.

Left untreated gonorrhea can be dangerous and can spread to the testicles and prostate gland, it can leave you unable to have children, may cause pain and swelling in the knees or other joints, skin and heart problems.

If you are having symptoms it is important to get checked and if needed treatment.

The Winnebago Co. Health Dept. STD Clinic hours are:

Mondays 10 am -Noon
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It is equally important that your partner(s) get treated also, so be kind and inform all the partners you can. Having an STD also puts you at risk for other STD'S as well as HIV. So reduce your exposure as much as possible, use condoms, know your partners, get tested regularly.
