

BESTD HOLDS NEW VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION

BESTD Clinic has scheduled a new volunteer orientation on Sat., March 19, from 10 a.m. until noon at 1240 E. Brady St., Milwaukee.

An all volunteer agency, The Brady East STD Clinic is eager to welcome those who want to share their time and skills in an effort to make a difference. BESTD offers services to the entire metro Milwaukee area, but specializes in the health concerns of the les/bi/trans/gay population. Particular areas of direct client case care involve HIV infection and disease, all other sexually transmitted diseases and women's health care.

The March 19 orientation will give prospective and undecided volunteers an opportunity to familiarize themselves with BESTD before making a time commitment. The two hour session will be group oriented and a continental breakfast will be served.

Volunteer positions are available for physicians, nurse practitioners, RNs, LPNs, PACs, counselors, facilitators, and persons with public speaking, client intake, telephone, clerical or computer skills. Most BESTD services are offered during evening hours and volunteers are asked to give time consistent with their schedules and availability.

BESTD Clinic was founded twenty years ago to service greater Milwaukee. Ross Walker, president of the Brady Clinic urges "anyone who wants to quit talking and start doing" to consider becoming a BESTD volunteer. Walker personally noted that being a Brady Volunteer is one of the greatest gifts he has both given and received in his life.




