We welcome some additional advertisers with this issue as well! It pleases me to tell you more are on the way, too!





Creater/Artist Tom Pawzun A REAL TROUPER

Many of us are somewhat familiar, if only vaguely, with that not-yet-completed series of twelve posters about AIDS by popular Racine creator/artist Tom Pawzun, some of which are pictured here.

Here's an update we hope you'll find inspiring as well as interesting.

We had the pleasure of interviewing Tom at his home recently - a first encounter for all of us! It was a delightful visit!

There was Tom, who'd just returned home from his day's work as chief display man at a well-known Racine department store. A selfdesigned pin he wears constantly — a red ribbon covered an "A"...Art Against AIDS — was on his chest. It says a great deal about this sensitive 34-year-old gentleman.

Tom, like most of us, has lost a number of friends to AIDS and is doing something about his virtual helplessness — a series of posters, each selling for only \$10, with all proceeds to the Kenosha-based S.E. Wisconsin Aids Project (1-800-924-6601). (For the record, Pawzun is HIV negative.)

As Tom spoke of each poster, one could feel his heart wrenching: "My poster emphasizing children and AIDS (very new/not pictured) was quite controversial. At first, I was rather hurt and confused, but I've come to realize the poster accomplishes its goal....attesting that pediatric AIDS is for real, and 100% of its victims are absolutely innocent."

Tom continued, "One of my favorites is the puzzle poster, stressing that life goes on it's sort of a tribute to a valiant fight waged by those who are stricken."

NOTE: TOM NEEDS MORE PICTURES OF WISCONSIN AIDS VICTIMS FOR POSTER NO. 10. HELP!!!

We asked Tom to share some letters he may have received in connection with his work. He complied. A Feb. 2, 1994, note from Mary, says a lot. In part: " ... You have given me a chance to share my memory of him; you make it possible for others to know that REAL people live and die with and from AIDS and its complications. You are such a kind person. I cannot stop crying (or smiling). SO GLAD am I that there is hope in this world! Thank you for hand writing me a personal letter and for creating a living memory of my brother and the others included in the poster." (Pawzun was near tears as he was reassured the letter will be returned; it has been.)


We came away deeply moved by Tom's dedication to his fellow human beings. "If I were a medical research scientist, my work would be in the AIDS field; I'm not, however;



so I'm doing what I can with the gifts God gave to me. I do feel CURE DAY will come in my lifetime, and I want to have made a contribution."

Pawzun's posters are on display at The 1100 Club in Milwaukee, JoDee's in Racine and at Kenosha's Club 94. "I'm grateful to these folks for their help. May I pay a special tribute to Judy, the owner of JoDee's; she always has a smile and a word of encouragement."

(Editor's Note: Judy is a true Wisconsin pioneer in the fight for gay and lesbian rights;



her contributions date back some thirty years when being 'out front' was exceedingly rare!) Finally, an aside to Tom....an idea for all of us: \$10 is enclosed. Will you please inscribe and autograph a puzzle poster — "Teddy remembers a precious love, Dennis."


