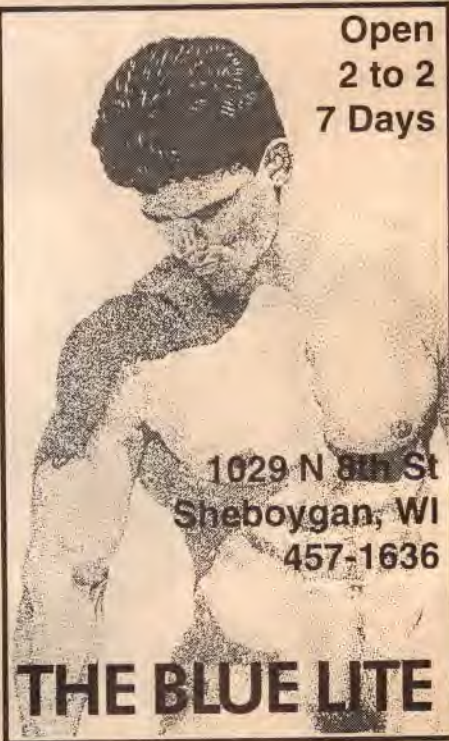

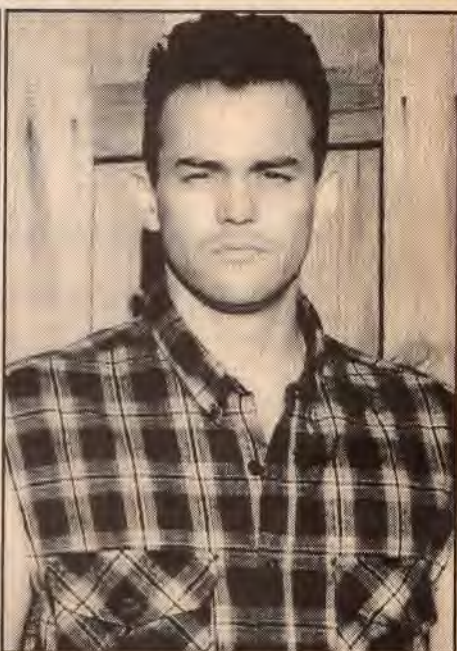
DAVID BURRILL FORMS NEW BAND - DEVIATE SEPTEMBER GIGS IN WISCONSIN & ILLINOIS

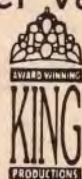

used equipment as I was upgrading my recording studio, and along came Chad Spikes to check it out. The magic was there instantaneously, as soon as I heard Chad sing. We spent the rest of the evening writing music together, and a professional team, Deviate, was launched. I am absolutely thrilled. We are in high gear!"

At press time, Burrill listed some titles in the "Let the Walls Fall Down" album, including the theme song, a dancey techno song, "Who's Normal?," and "Got to Dance," "I Feel the Rhythm," "Is it Love?," "Addicted to You," "Where are You Now?," "Do You Wanna Dance with Me?," and "Walk Away from Love."

Of his band partner, Spikes, David said he's anxious for all to meet and hear Chad (formerly with Stevie B), who has an extensive background in gospel and blues.

DEVIATE launches its first four-week tour in short order, and will include Sat., Sept. 17, at ZA's, Green Bay; Fri., Sept. 23, at Club 219, Milwaukee, and Sat., Sept. 24, at The Office in Rockford, IL. there are, at press time, gigs in North Carolina, Nebraska and Kansas.

Finally, Burrill's first album — "Bump da Booty Blue" — has now been released in Tokyo, and sales are brisk! "Deviante's first offering will undoubtedly move into the Japanese market as soon as we get a footing here in America."
