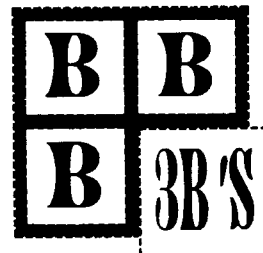

TONY DOMENICO HEADED FOR BROADWAY!



Tony Domenico identifies himself as a comic actor, and he's headed for Broadway, but not before he entertains Sunday, Sept. 11, at The New Bar in Madison, and on Thursday, Sept. 22, at ZA's in Green Bay!

"I got into show business quite by accident," Tony told our interviewer recently. "I followed my dad (who was a jockey and an inductee in the Sports Hall of Fame) and was taking pantomime lessons for balance, while in the process of learning to be a jockey, in much the same way as football players take ballet lessons for gracefulness and timing."

"While attending a party in Hollywood, hosted by Neil Simon's wife, Marsha Mason, and Jamie Lee Curtis, Marsha gave me \$150 to entertain the crowd," Tony tells. "I guess the right people were there, because my show led to the National Endowment for the Arts bankrolling my first national tour. That was ten years ago!"

As a matter of fact, Tony celebrates his tenth year in show business September 22 when he performs his many-costume-changes theatrical presentation at ZA's in Green Bay!

A frequent re-run on Showtime, Tony Domenico was on tour for the USO for two years ("the best sex of my life, with the Marines"), and recently starred at the Florida Gay Pride Festival (home is Fort Meyers). He'll appear as a TV guest with talk show host Jerry Springer this fall, and will go into rehearsal this winter for the yet-unnamed Broadway show about the life of a comic

(we'll keep you posted). He'll participate in a New York AIDS benefit Christmas time.

"There was a time," Tony notes, "when only 10% of my work was for essentially gay audiences, and now it's the opposite. Florida is a good home base, because of resort shows, cruise ships and the like - work is abundant for my gay perspective show....there certainly is more to gay entertainment than just drag!"

What comedy folks do you admire most, we asked. "Carol Burnett, Red Skelton and Bob Newhart are the top three!" When Tony opened in Atlantic City for Newhart, the big star told Tony he reminded him of Ernie Kovacs. "My, what a wonderful compliment!" Tony beamed.

Noting compliments, the Atlantic City Whoot review of Tony's show notes: "His impersonations of Dr. Ruth and Pee Wee Herman are as deadly accurate as they are hysterical." And, Atlanta Magazine's Greg Dougherty wrote, "His character changes are extraordinary. Don't miss it....he's total talent, folks." The Milwaukee Journal adds, "Tony had the audience howling with laughter!"

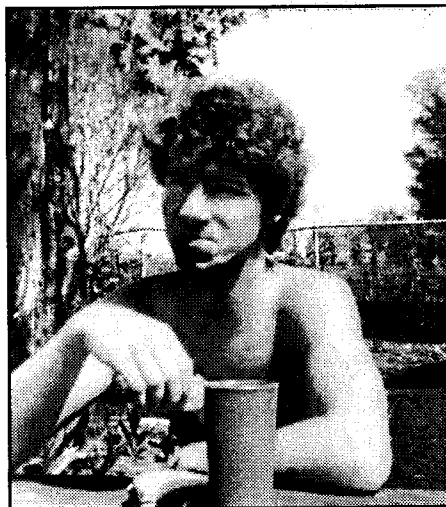

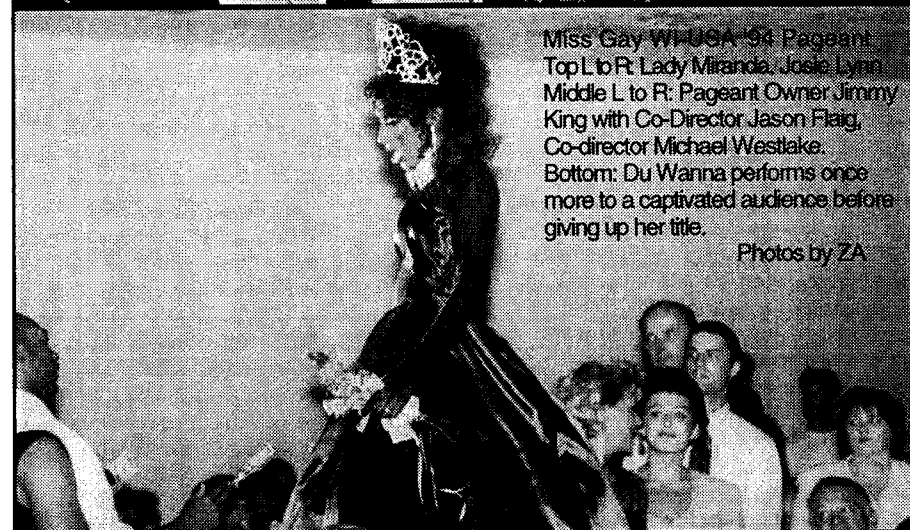
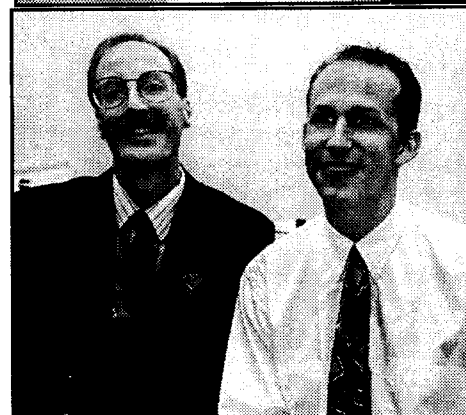
