DANCE MUSIC VIDEO REVEIWS BY ZA

The past two months have not exactly made
up for the shameful lack of good music
videos we have been experiencing this past
summer and early fall, but things are getting
better. I think we all were spoiled with so
many great hits the previous two years, but
1994 has not been a good year for music in
my mind.

There are a few new songs worth mention-
ing on January's Rockamerica Dance reel.
The first is by D.J. Bobo called "Take

Control" and put out by CMC Records.

Paced at 134 bpm and complete with the
now cliché rap lines in place of the verse,
this song will remind you of 2 Unlimited or
Captain Hollywood. The video is a bit disa-
pointing though. The theme is a circus cage
filled with men dancing in the cage.

Unfortunately the men have far too many
clothes on! There is also a woman in the
video bearing a whip. Apparently she is
going to tame the men - ya right!

Erasure has a Rockamerica remix version of
"I Love Saturdays" on Mute/Elektra records.

The song is 140 bpm and is too la la disco
for my taste. It improves much later on when
the singing finally starts. I think the standard
version of this video would be better. I'll
have to wait until we get a copy to compare.

The editing of the video is one of the better
jobs Rockamerica has done and should hold
your interest through the whole song. Don't
expect this one to go over with the alternative
crowd unless they are die hard Erasure fans.

Next I want to pick on an import video fea-
tured on the reel. This one is from Kym
Mazelle & Jocelyn Brown and put out by
BMG UK. It is a remake of the disco classic
"No More Tears" (Enough Is Enough). First
of all, this video needed to be released when
the 12" first came out guys! The audio quali-
ty is also a bit poor, but that might be due to
its being an import. The video reminds me of
the campy stuff done for early 80's gay ori-
ented dance music. Kim and Jocelyn are sur-
rounded by white wigged girls in silver lame'
dresses in some kind of fantasy beauty parlor.
The video does have tons of energy and
should get a laugh or two from even the most
jaded queen (like me). With so many disco
classics being played in the clubs right now,
this one fits in very well.

My fave off this month's reel is "Hands Up"
by Clubzone from Logic records. The video
is a total bore, (a basketball game), but the
song really cooks and I have it as my pick hit
this month!

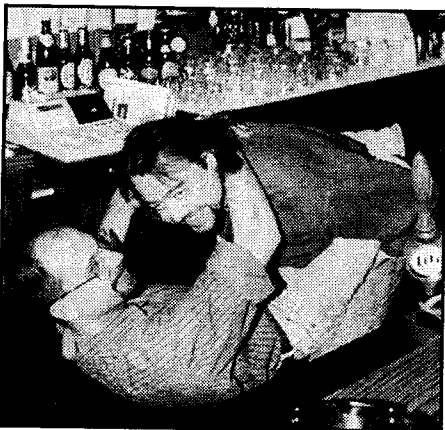

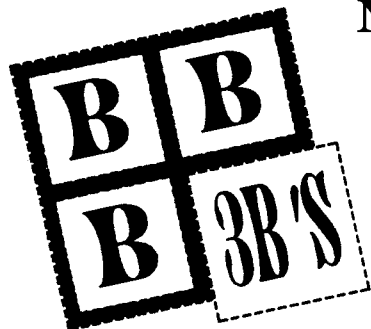

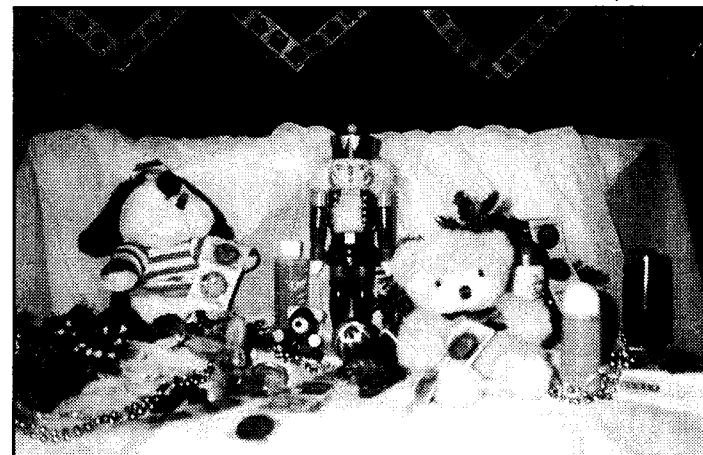
