What is the "Blues"? For just about anyone past the age ten, that question is practically sophomoric. The Blues is an experience of mood and feeling common to us all. The sharp ups-and-downs of day to day living, the shifting tides of our lives - these are the passing pictures of it all - love lost, love restored, the howl or the unheard whimper of pain and loneliness, loss of good fortune, good fortune regained and unleashed exuberance. And joy, yes even mighty sounds of joy. For every experience experienced, every feeling felt, there's a sound in

the strains and a story in the songs. The Blues is a music that mirrors to us, like a deep interior diamond reflector in the soul, this vast scope of feeling and experience. A Blues concert is a celebration of the sum of our

lives' events, ordinary and not. No aspect is overlooked as too trivial. All this weaves into a shared fabric as the collective and collecting nature of life. And that precisely is what makes



this music so vital, so urgent and never out of date. Blues is community at its zenith. There is no such thing as attending a Blues show. No spectator event here. This music DEMANDS, and unfailingly wins, intense participation. It's up and out of the seats for real ass-shakin' action!

In a recent conversation with Steve, bandleader for Nitros Blues Band, I asked this first question: "Why do you play Blues? Why not Rock or Jazz?" (I forgot to mention chamber music!) This commanding, tall and lanky guitarist smiled in broasdening degrees and slipped into overdrive enthusiasm. "Why do you eat, drink, sleep, make love and all the rest?" His response, a suspended query. As we talked on,

it became apparent that this music, his music, is his sustaining lifeblood. It's his necessity. Steve is a well-known, highly praised guitarist-musical artist in the Midwest. He was a founding member of the now legendary Pontiac Blues Band. He


