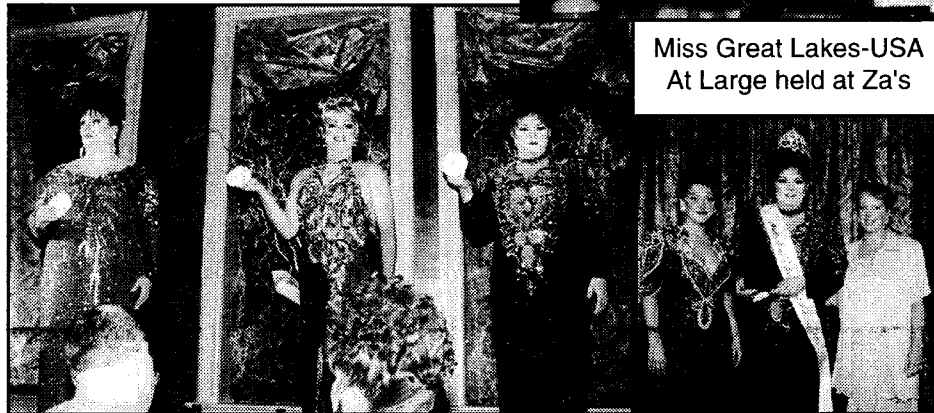

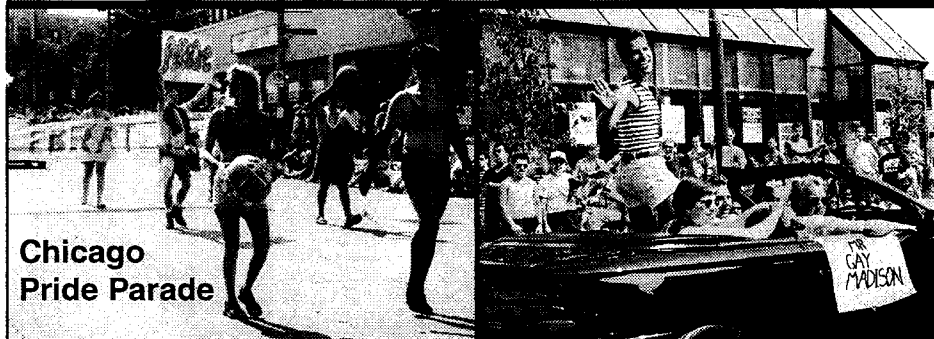

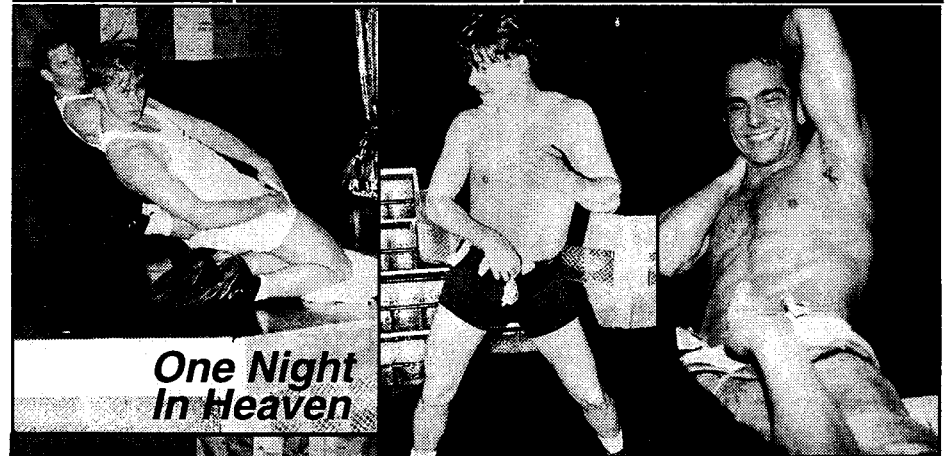
CREAM CITY CHORUS PRIDEFEST!

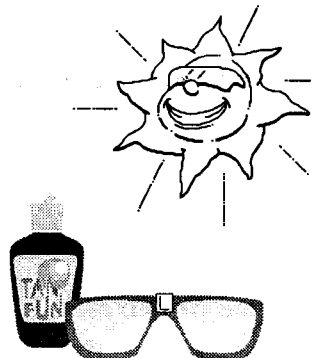

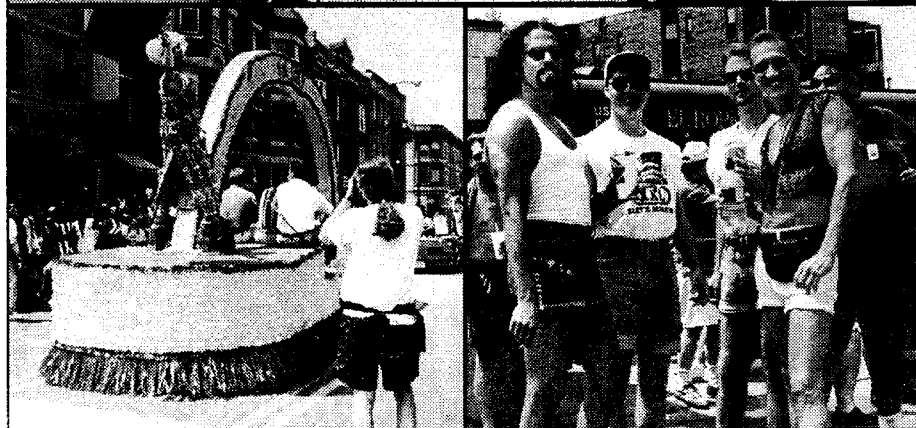
