



"They want to take a 'wait and see' attitude," sales representaive Cindy Thomas said. "Some are fearful that in this political climate there might be negative repurcussions."

On the editorial front, layout editor Paul "Cricket" Jacob has met with the Guide's printer, Mark Mariucci, and has "synchronized computers." Typefaces have ben selected and layout designs are underway. Cricket is also designing some of the display ads as requested by accounts.






