He plays the role of Mar, the fabulous producer, in the movie about a brother and sister starting the first gay cable network.

While shooting the film in Dallas, Jason performed at the Texas State Fair for National Coming Out Day and shared the stage with Candace

Gingrich and Chastity Bono. And if that's not enough, he flew to St. Louis to headline Gay Pride and received a standing ovation.

How did he get the part? "Well, I read about the proposed movie as I was flying to Vegas to headline at Harrahs. I faxed the producer, "I can't believe you're doing the story without me!" Several days later they called, and the rest will be summer time entertainment.

Jason's recent apperance on "Comedy Central's Out There in Hollywood" was one of the highest rated specials for the network and garnered good reviews all over the country. Matt Roush of *USA Today* says, "A standout sardonic comic named Jason Stuart, who's especially adept at deflating homophobic fears about gays recruiting for their ranks 'What's the selling point? We have no rights and everyone hates us. Please come along, join us!" He's just joking, sorta."

Stuart isn't the first performer to come out of the closet and announce that he's gay. He's only one of the more recent. But even though the heavy weather of persecution for sexual orientation has lifted somewhat in the 90's, his restless anxiety, his eagerness to please mixed with a wariness of being ridiculed, his sense of fun and his sense of fear, all point to the experience of being gay as a full-time vigil.

There's still the potential for culture clash that can erupt in a sudden glare. There's the tough double jeopardy of maintaining one's irreducible identity in a heterosexual world while living in a performer's skin, where self-esteem is treacherously vulnerable to the

approval of others

"I perceive myself differently than other people perceive me," Stuart says. "When I was a kid, everyone thought I was jovial, funny. But I was one of those suicidal kids who went to sleep wishing I would-

> n't wake up. It's very, very tiring, being in the closet. It makes you feel bad about yourself. When I don't see myself represented in movies or TV, it makes me feel there's no place for me in this world."

Stuart, 36, has been making his place since 1993, when he first decided to tell all to an audience at Houston's Laff Stop, then to the nation on "Geraldo." Later, he did his act on Broadway for the Gay Games, in "OUTrageous Comedy" with Sandra Bernhard.

As an actor, he has done a number of TV spots within the past year or so, on such shows

as "Seaquest," "The John Larroquette Show" and "Murder, She Wrote."


"It's been two-and-a-half years since I did 'Geraldo'", Stuart muses. "The show was called 'Unconventional Comedians.' But what comedian is conventional? What are comedians but people who complain and get paid for it? I think this has made me a better person. And it may help some other kid who's thinking of killing himself. I'm not just out for me, I'm out for everyone."


