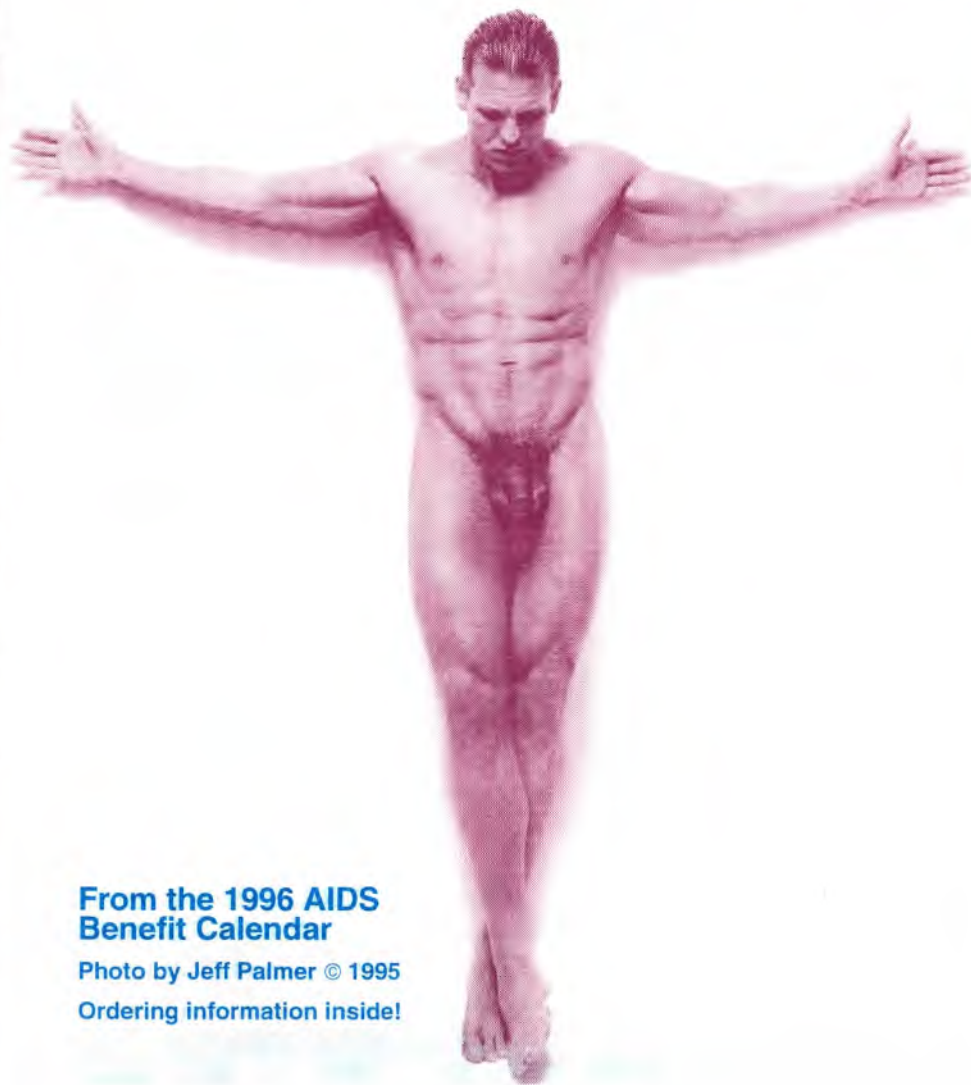



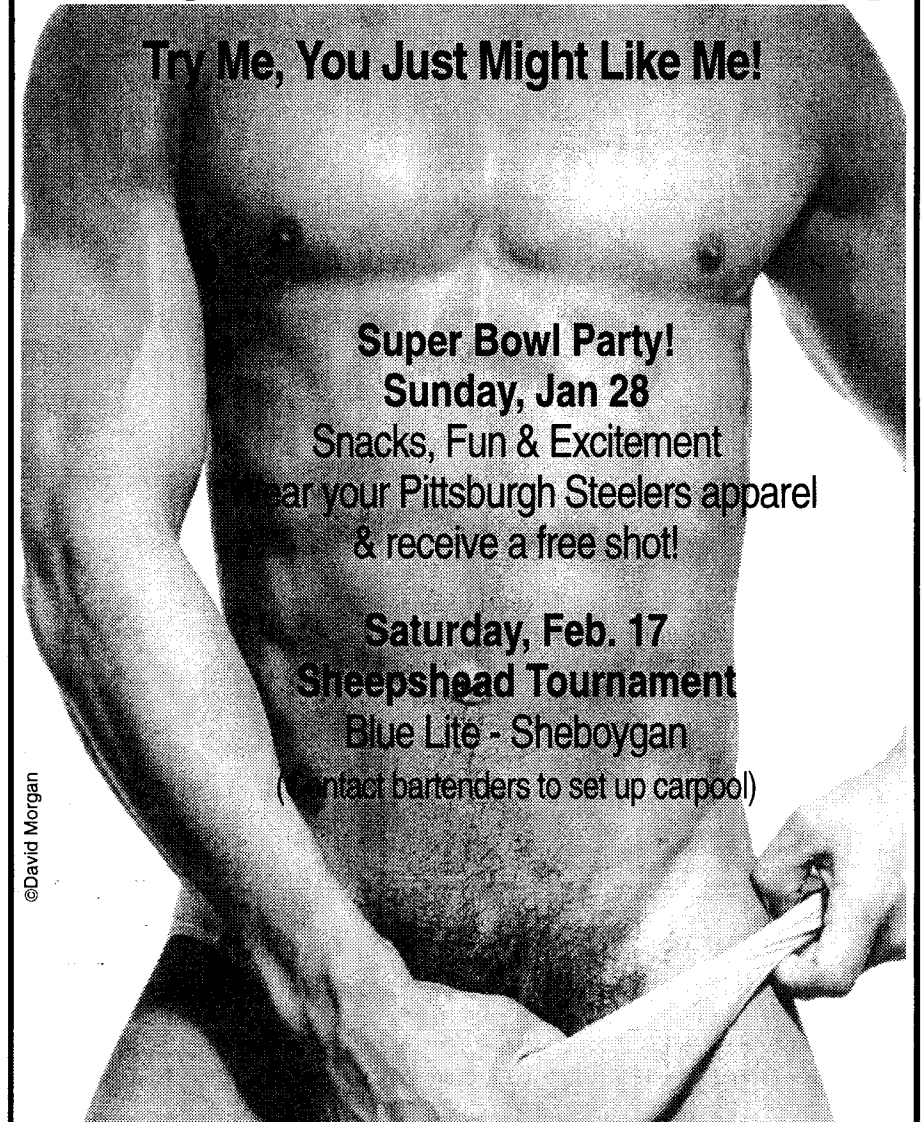

BESTD GALLERY FEATURES JON REICH ART

BESTD Clinic Gallery is featuring (thru March) the work of the late Chicago artist Jon Reich.

Jon, who died in 1992 at age 39 of complications from AIDS, worked in pastels, charcoal, pencil, pen & ink and acrylics. Some of his work was syndicated and is still available as prints, posters and cards.

The exhibit is from the collections of Ken Multhauf and Ross Walker/Erv Uecker. It features some original pieces and some prints. The hallmark of Jon's work is a four piece set entitled "Transparency I, II, III, IV" - sketches of an artist sketching male-male and female nudes, composites of Jon and other models' bodies.

Reich published a book before his death, "The Nudes of Jon Reich." His work was also featured in the July, 1991 issue of "Positively Aware," devoted to AIDS basics.

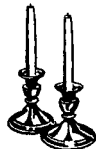

Day of Self Discovery Continued

Western Downtowner in Green Bay. A continental breakfast and the conference opening and welcome at 9:00 AM will precede the political forum.

Featured on the panel will be Juliet Brodie, president of Action Wisconsin, the state's gay political action group which recently launched a statewide gay voter visibility project. Also featured will be Scott Evertz, one of the leaders of Wisconsin's Log Cabin Republicans. Last fall the return of the Log Cabin's thousand dollar campaign contribution caused a political migraine for front-running Republican presidential candidate Bob Dole. the panel will also include representatives of other major political parties and independent movements.

Nearly twenty other speakers and panelists, will share their views on a variety of topics. A panel on gay and lesbian health issues will feature Drs. Rebecca Wolfe, John Laabs and Ray Bachhuber. Dr. Bachhuber is considered one of Wisconsin's and the nation's experts on HIV/AIDS and Dr.s Wolfe and Laabs are openly gay physicians from the Fox Valley.

Following lunch a panel on the secrets of long-term relationships will feature couples in relationships of ten years or longer, moderated by therapist Judy Hodel. Ms. Hodel's experience and research has indicated the reasons same-gender couples succeed vary by gender and can differ significantly from the so-called "traditional" nuclear family.

The conference concludes with a presentation on legal issues for both gay singles and couples by Legal Aid attorney Steve Byers. Byer will focus on both recent changes in legal status and the need to outline in writing all key agreements in non-traditional and legally unprotected relationships.

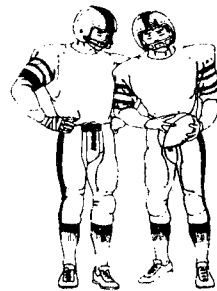

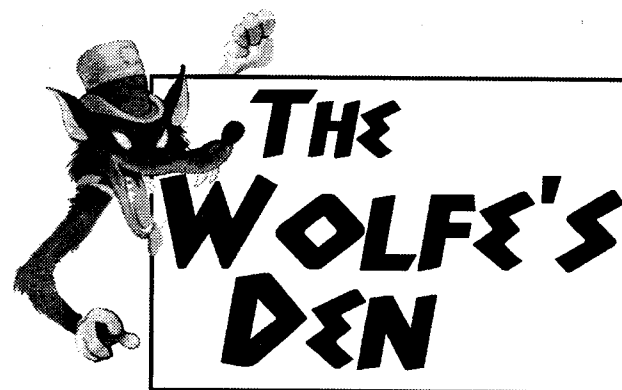

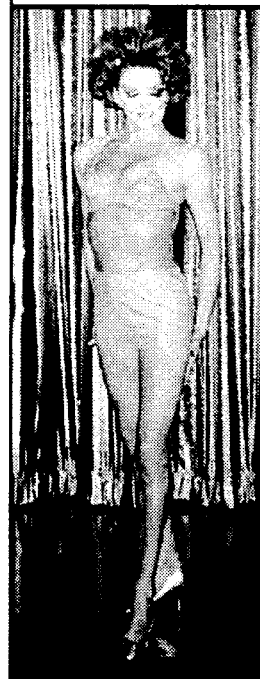

"All monies raised at the dinner stay right here in northeast Wisconsin," Ms. Terlap said.

Tickets for the dinner are \$35 per person, \$240 for tables of eight and \$500 for corporate tables.
