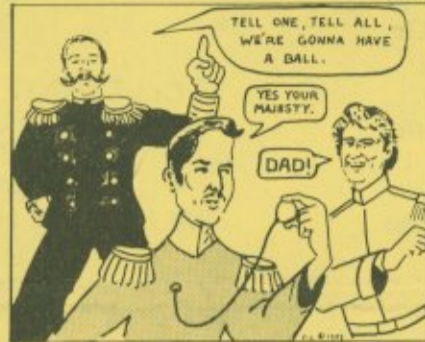

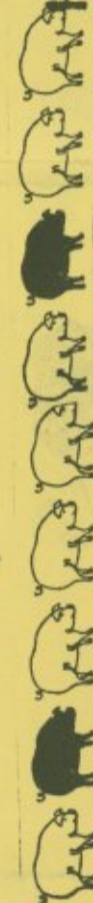

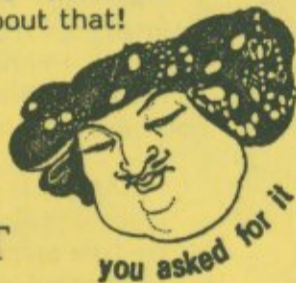
Did you ever wonder how certain decisions are made that affect your health and well-being? Like, what kind of beer to serve on Sundays? Or, how many bartenders it takes to open the back bar? Well, we'll let you in on a secret. All decisions are handled by memos that come from the "Main Office". Just the other day, for example, Kelly and Joe asked the boss for a raise. With lightning speed, Rodney fired off the following memo:

The issue which continues to propel our implementation intentions into a quagmire is the question of whether to designate selected activity matrices as "high priority" or "low priority". Of special importance is the data collection incumbent upon "high priority" designation and the assumption, though unwritten, that all staff members will apply the methodologies developed by the team, consistently and with a degree of fervor.
