Most stations' news departments focus on murders, rapes, fires and other tragedies. WJLW/ACC believes that broadcast and print media must accept a new responsibility: to educate on the broader issues of our day.

In both the U. S. and abroad the greatest threats to a better way of life are self-serving political, religious and business leaders. As the end of the century approaches, "religious right" groups and militant militias moralize on issues of race, religion, gender equality and sexual orientation. Such propaganda clouds the civil rights of every man and woman.

As long as this self-serving leadership continues to question what should be the basic rights of mankind, their rhetoric will continue to motivate those who would persecute—and even kill—the targets of their hatred. From Martin Luther King's assassination and firebombed black churches in the '60's to Itzak Rabin's murder and gay-bashings in the '90's, the tragic pattern continues unabated.

Like the master teacher who discovers the talents and development of each student he touches before he challenges them to greatness, broadcast and print media have the ability to reinforce mankind's universal values of equality and brotherhood while entertaining and informing their audiences. Preface

In the last two decades mainstream America has become aware of the gay and lesbian subculture with which it has coexisted for nearly a century. During the 1980's geographic neighborhoods in all major cities and population centers of the country were identified. Within those neighborhoods it became possible for gay and lesbian people to live almost completely insulated from mainstream society if they so chose. These "ghetto" communities have attracted gay and lesbian people from smaller urban, suburban and rural areas in such numbers that the most recent census identified twelve cities as probably having estimated lesbigay communities ranging from 15% to 40% of their total population. Business and civic groups within the lesbigay communities publish over a hundred guides to lesbigay owned and operated retail businesses and service providers.

However, the gay and lesbian population in northeast Wisconsin is disseminated fairly consistently throughout the geographic area. Gay and lesbian people thus interact almost universally within the mainstream community. Through experience gay and lesbian consumers have learned who are the supportive business owners and service providers to deal with. The intention of this Guide has been to provide the opportunity for those merchants and professionals to get their name "out there" into that widespread gay community.

For that reason the Guide committee focused primarily on services within a twelve county area. A few of the listings in this Guide are from statewide resources, and a number are gay-owned and/or operated, but the majority are simply gay-supportive.

For this initial issue of The Gay/Lesbian Guide to Northeast Wisconsin gay-supportive is defined as a business, professional or organization which has been identified by members of the local lesbigay community as supportive in its service delivery or business practices. ▼

Introduction

The Guide you now hold in your hands, The Gay/Lesbian Guide to Northeast Wisconsin, is a very special little book. For starters it is the first of its kind produced in and for this part of the world. Second, it is the first regional book of its kind ever published in the United States to the best of our knowledge. But most importantly it is a product of more than a year's work and thousands of volunteer hours of effort by some very dedicated and visionary members of the lesbigay community in northeast Wisconsin. Here's the story of how it came to be.

Following its inception in the summer of 1993, the Education/Outreach Committee, a group cosponsored by Positive Voice and Northern Womyn, developed a list of projects which they felt would improve both the visibility and quality of life of the gay/lesbian community in the Green Bay area. Eight work teams began the process of developing a variety of projects ranging from a speaker's bureau on gay/lesbian topics and an achievement recognition program to a brochure on gay civic organizations and available services and a multi-county networking project.

As work on the various projects progressed over the next year the committee realized that, because the scope of some of the projects would demand just about every available volunteer hour, it would be necessary to prioritize the project list. The goal was to select the project that would provide the greatest benefit to the northeast Wisconsin lesbigay community.

After much discussion it was decided to combine the networking project and the brochure project into a guide for gay and lesbian consumers living in and visitors coming to northeast Wisconsin. Preliminary research limited the scope of the project to the eleven counties of Brown, Calumet, Door, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marinette, Menominee, Oconto, Outagamie, Shawano and Winnebago. (A twelfth county, Forest, was added later.)

At this point the committee decided to invite the Gay & Lesbian Education and Economic Development Alliance (GLEEDA) to become involved in the project. GLEEDA, which had been considering creating a similar document for the Fox Cities, happily accepted the invitation. As the Guide had become a tri-sponsored project, a separate subcommittee was formed: The G/L Guide to NEW Committee.

Plans were laid out for a guide to be published in the fall of 1995. Similar guides from around the country were looked at for ideas and the research phase of the project was mapped out.

From February to May the research phase was completed. The goal was to develop a database of organizations, professionals and businesses recommended as gay-supportive by members of the lesbian community. Questionnaires were mailed to every name on the Positive Voice, Northern Womyn and GLEEDA mailing lists. Outreach teams were sent to gay/lesbian bars and other established gay-supportive businesses. By early June, over 300 different recommendations had been received, about double the number the committee had projected.

The second phase of research required obtaining complete contact information on the recommended businesses and providers, a task almost as daunting as obtaining the recommendations. A prospectus brochure was developed and a mass mailing to all recommended entities was sent in late August. Simultaneously, volunteer sales representatives were trained and contracts, order forms and other paper documents were developed.

The follow-up contact phase began in September. By now the street date of the booklet had been pushed back to early December. The physical scope of the project now became apparent as sales reps travelled throughout the multi-county area. Lack of volunteer power made it impossible to contact every recommended entity with the thoroughness the committee had desired. Also, as is often the case on the "maiden voyage" of any such project, a number of businesses and professionals chose to take a "wait and see-call me next year" attitude. A few said "no" and an even smaller few said things too rude to repeat.

As the book began to take shape, another problem arose. The size of the guide was beyond the scope of the printer originally contracted to publish it. Just before Christmas a larger print shop was contracted and a January street date was set.

The Gay/Lesbian Guide to Northeast Wisconsin has been a lot more work than anyone involved probably guessed it would have been. But it has been a labor of love and we hope you'll find it the valuable resource it was intended to be. ▼

Positive Voice, Inc. (PV) is based in Green Bay but boasts active members in over a dozen counties in northeast Wisconsin. Founded in 1992, PV is dedicated to enriching the lives of gay, bisexual, lesbian and transgendered (GLBT) people and those who love or are supportive of them.

Positive Voice works to create an environment where all people, regardless of their affectional orientation, are treated with dignity, respect and love. PV also seeks to provide opportunities for the enlightenment, reflection, growth, development and celebration of the unique life journeys of all gay, bisexual, lesbian and transgendered people and their supportive others.

To accomplish these goals Positive Voice sponsors more than 40 educational, supportive and social events annually.
