

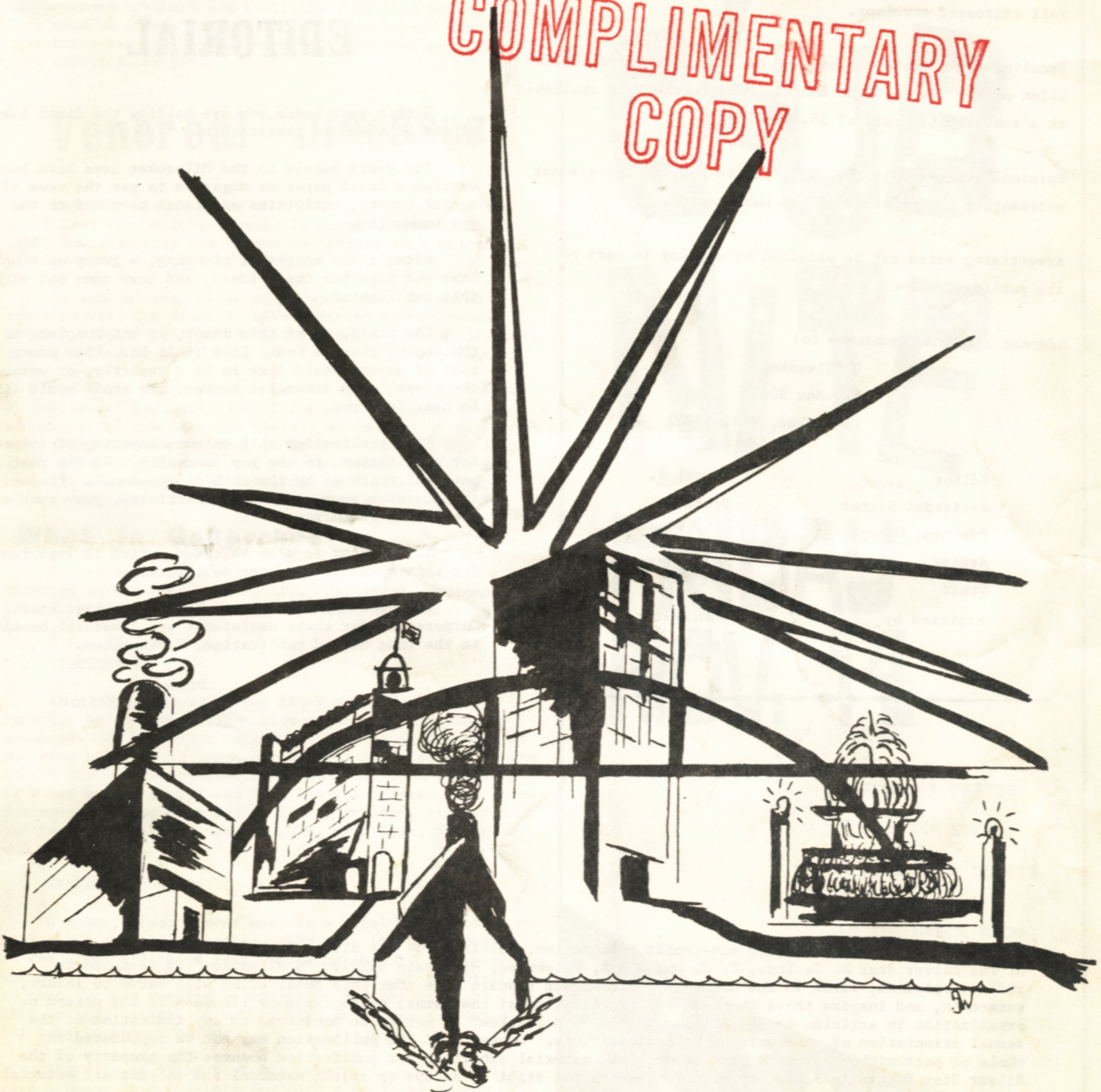

The following artical on vernereal diseases is a reprint from the Wisconsin Health Department. A series of articals, What is Gonorrhoea?, What is Syphilis?, Privacy and the Law, and what can you do?, will be published by this paper for the benefit of those who are unfamiliar with the diseases. Copies of the health departments brochure are available from this paper, if you send us a self stamped address envelope. Also any questions you may have on vernereal diseases we will get answered for you.

Venerael Diseases

Venerael diseases are on the increase in Wisconsin and across the nation, especially among homosexuals. In fact, homosexuality has become recognized as a major problem in the control of the disease.

In some cities, close to fifty percent of those reported with the diseases have admitted to homosexual contact. Both syphilis and gonorrhoea are serious diseases that can lead to blindness, heart trouble and death.

Syphillis and gonorrhoea can be spread by all forms of homosexual and heterosexual contact. A rectally infected homosexual can pass the disease on to many of his contacts without realizing that he is infected. No one is immune from the disease, and you can never tell who may have it. The person, himself, may not know. Therefore all precautions that can be taken must be taken.

What is Gonorrhoea

Gonorrhoea, like syphilis, can be caught from an infected person - male or female. The first symptoms in men, however, are a little different from those in women.

SYMPTOMS IN MEN

In a few days, or a week after a man has become infected he will probably notice a burning pain when he urinates. He will also notice a discharge or dripping of pus from his penis. A man may develop an infection in the rectum which is often unnoticed but is very dangerous. If a man has gonorrhoea and does not get treated, the germs can spread through the body. If not treated, gonorrhoea can cause sterility, heart trouble, arthritis, blindness and even death.

SYMPTOMS IN WOMEN

A woman, almost never notices any pain or other signs when she has gonorrhoea. She can, therefor, pass on the disease without even realizing she has it. When the disease spreads, a woman's organs may get so infected that she may require an operation and may never be able to have babies. A mother with gonorrhoea can cause her baby to become blind.

There is no blood test for gonorrhoea. A doctor will take a smear from the infected part - penis or rectum or vagina, for a laboratory examination.

At one time, all you had to do to find a master (in the East Coast Area) was to look for the ones who wore their keys (or chains) on the left side. Unfortunately, this is not the case anymore. The bars are filled with "Monkey see, Monkey does". Everyone and their mothers are wearing their keys and chains this way now. So take a minute, observe what's going on in the bar...real masters, (those who are on the prowl) generally are standing alone. Most would appear indifferent to the goings on around them. However, they are not. They are seeking, just like you are, and this is one of their signs. There are other subtle ways of seeking out those whom are into S & M, and with practice, you can spot them.

APPROACH

There is a ritual (or game) played here. It is not unlike picking up a woman. However, the regards are vastly different. It is the slave who must make the approach. This is true nine out of ten times. There is an explosive word in the English language as far as S & M people are concerned. It is "SIR". In any way you can, (taking a drink over, lighting a cigarette, even asking the time) use this word. It is a sexual turnon for the master and it is also a sign from you that you are interested in pleasing him. Do not expect immediate results but you can rest assured that you've gotten your message across. Do not expect him to strike up a conversation. It may not please him to do so at the moment. Go back

to where you were standing and wait. The idea is to please him, not annoy him. Stay in view. If he wants to speak with you, he'll let you know.

HUMILIATION

You do not need a resume when talking with a master. Your past conquests and experiences generally will not impress him. Seek to know his way of doing things, not what you've heard or have done before. You will benefit by not talking of these things. If you are new to the scene or frightened, tell him so. Most masters enjoy training a new slave by degrees. Be truthful. It opens the way for a more sexually honest time, and helps you enjoy the S & M pleasures more fully. The master will sense your eagerness and newness and act accordingly.

PUBLIC PERFORMANCE

There is only you and your master. No one else. You belong to him to do with as he wishes. If he chooses to put a collar on you, wear it with pride. You are part of his desire. There are those in the bar who would envy you and your position as a slave. It is not degrading as some might make you think. Unless the master tells you otherwise, there are many ways to please him in public. If he smokes, light his cigarettes (it is always wise to carry a pack of your masters' brand on you), if his drink is low, fetch him another. If he chooses to talk with his friends without you along, wait for him. With pride. You are pleasing him, and you will find this sexually exciting.

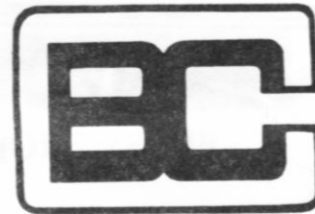
We appreciate much the support these guys from Chicago have given us on our monthly Club Night, which is held the second Friday of each month at our bar, The Wreck Room.

Friends of Matt

On March 6th, Leonard Matlovich decided to tell his commanding officer that he's gay, and wants to remain in the service.

Now after twelve years as an Air Force Sergeant, Matlovich, now 32, went before an Air Force Board in Hampton, Va., to hear testimony of Matlovich's military records and his psychological and emotional fitness for duty.

The board recommended a general discharge. (less desirable than an honorable discharge)

Despite the decision Matlovich and his attorneys plan to appeal the case and hope that the case will reach the supreme court, to produce a landmark decision on homosexual rights.

Since June Matlovich has been making appearances throughout the country and becoming well known in the fight for gay rights. In the upcoming long court struggle, Matlovich is going to need the support of his gay brothers and sisters.

Throughout the country there have been "fund raisers for Matt." None of these have been in Milwaukee. Is there any reason that Milwaukee can not contribute its share? Surely if other communities can help out Matlovich with a few dollars, in the fight for our rights, so can Milwaukee. This publication has therefor set up a "Friends of Matt Fund". All proceeds will be used to defray the personal and legal expenses incurred by Matlovich.

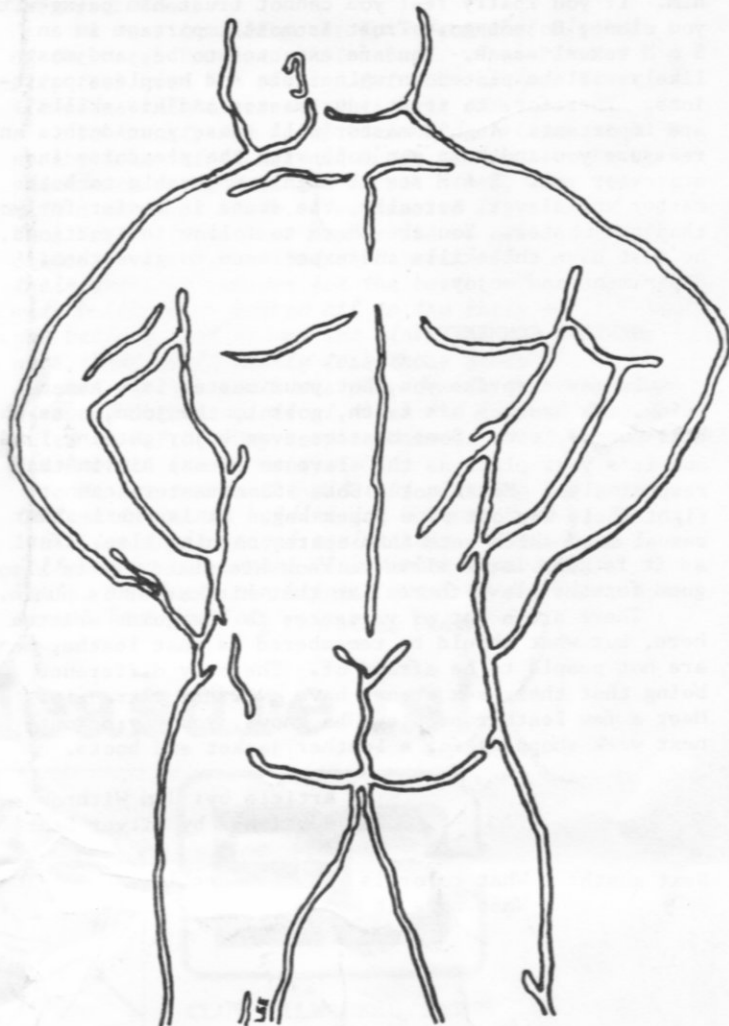
The "Friends of Matt Fund" is a excellent way of making it clear that Sergeant Matlovich does not stand alone. Its Milwaukee's fight also!
