If you haven't read that one yet, you may want. to chack it out in addition to Uniford's per book. The Fires of Hride, which is set on a rounte Scottish island with raphling casties and a ruined monastery harkening back to more matriarchal times. We follow the herione, and artist named Maria, as she discovers the mysteries of that matriarchal past as well as the mysteries of a local doctor, who is a witch.

Naiad Press has, of course, added lots of new light romande, mystery sto, to its list. One, titled Sunday's Child, by Joyce Bright, deals with a women who is trains to qualify Olympic trials in running. At the same time, a close friend and supportor is involved in trying to do something about a rapiut who is terrorizing Secramento (the story locale). Of course, it turns into a love story as well as a story of woman working hard and doing well, and a mys-Lery on top of all that! Leshians around the United States have been ignored in the media long enough, acording to a group of somen in Amon, long.

"When the gay presses began opening up in the sixties much of the material and advertising P 12 1- 14 devoted atrictly in eales. said Claire Hueholt, aditor of the moon-to-be-born The Hew Moon magezine. trend has not reversed itself over the venra. fact, several publications have become very successful that do not even pretend to nater to women."

The New Moos will be a Jnn bian quarterly and will be in print for the first time in Ontober. The idea for the magazine evolved during a brainstorming mension between several Amms area women and Elmine Noble, the first openly may person to be elected to a public office in the United Maters.

Many women around the country have perceived a need for something Meared their mocuifically to meeds, but because of the large emount of capital and the energous task involved with an endeavor of this nors, none have been successful. In fact, several groups have attempted to start magazines amenifi. caily for leabians and have nut been able to continue because of financial shortfalla.

"Ne are not attempting to start a publication that. will be simply a ter/informational gychange or a literary publication," Those Humbolt. said. things are already available to lesbians. We want to cover the events and propie who are constantly shaping and reshaping our community, an will also choose particular subjects to explane in the journalistic style of an enter-taining feature or news magazine.

The New Mook is to be a non-prufit, national publication for lesbians. It will examine the lesbian community as a positive group with very unique interests and famues. The

magazine will include features, profiles, travel, arts and satertalment, politios, news, short stories and poetry, sports and, of course, classified and display advortising.

Although cathumians for the potential of the Bagasine bas been enormous, the willingness on the part of many to subscribe and or advertise has been lacking, Hucholt anid. "We can have all the dreums, talent and energy in the world, but of the communaty is not willing to support this kind of angazine, it simply won't happen. I understand that many women want to see the product before they sink hard extred cash into a aubscription or an But, the bottom ilue is we need a few risk takens."

Subscriptions will be \$15 for a year (4 issues), and are tax-deductible.


