WISCONSIN GAY REPUBLICANS GROUP

Coming on the heels of the first national gay Republicap organization, a Madison cloused official has ennounced that he plans etart gay Republican . group in Wisconsin. .fime McFarland, an openly CAT Alderman who is also Republican, is coordinating the effort to set up the first GOP organization for gays and lesbians in Wisconsin. He hopen to appeal to all parts of the state.

The general goals of the tentatively Dew group, named Wisconsin Republicans Equality and Privacy for (MERP), would be the same as that of the newly formed national group: to promote concerns of gays and lesbians within the Republican Party and to promote conof the Republican DATE Party among lesbians and gays.

There has been a tendency for Republican legislators to ignore gay/lesbian voters and outer to the interests of the religious fundamentalist wing of the party. McFarland claims that this is because most Republicans think that all the lesbians and any are
