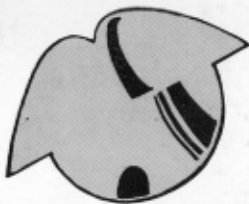

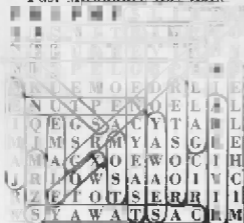
Editor's Copy

Angelo, sole owner of the Mint, died of a heart attack since the Calendar's last printing. At 65, he was as vibrant and active as he had been when he opened the Mint in 1949.
