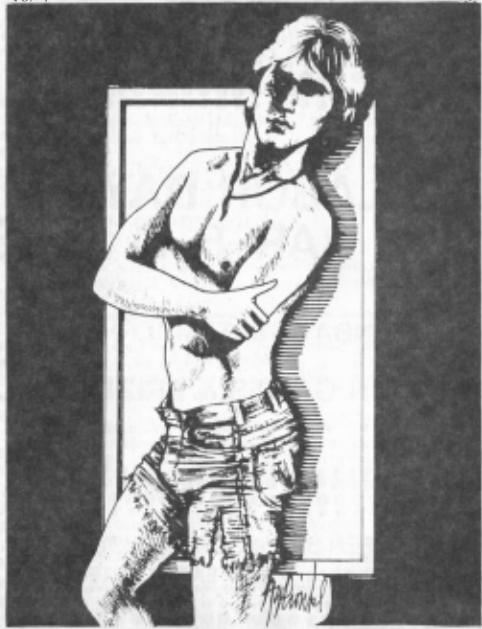

It should be noted that the Police Department has combed the gay community completely seeking clues to his killer. They have done this in a professional and friendly manner.

Many of us have had complaints about the actions of the police within the gay community; let us be glad to know how hard they have worked to solve this one.

A man has been arrested, and has now been released pending further investigation.

Anyone having ANY knowledge that would be helpful to the police should give them a call. The Police informed us this morning that this crime is NOT necessarily solved, and they do need more information.

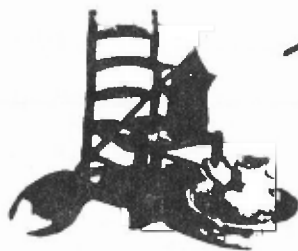

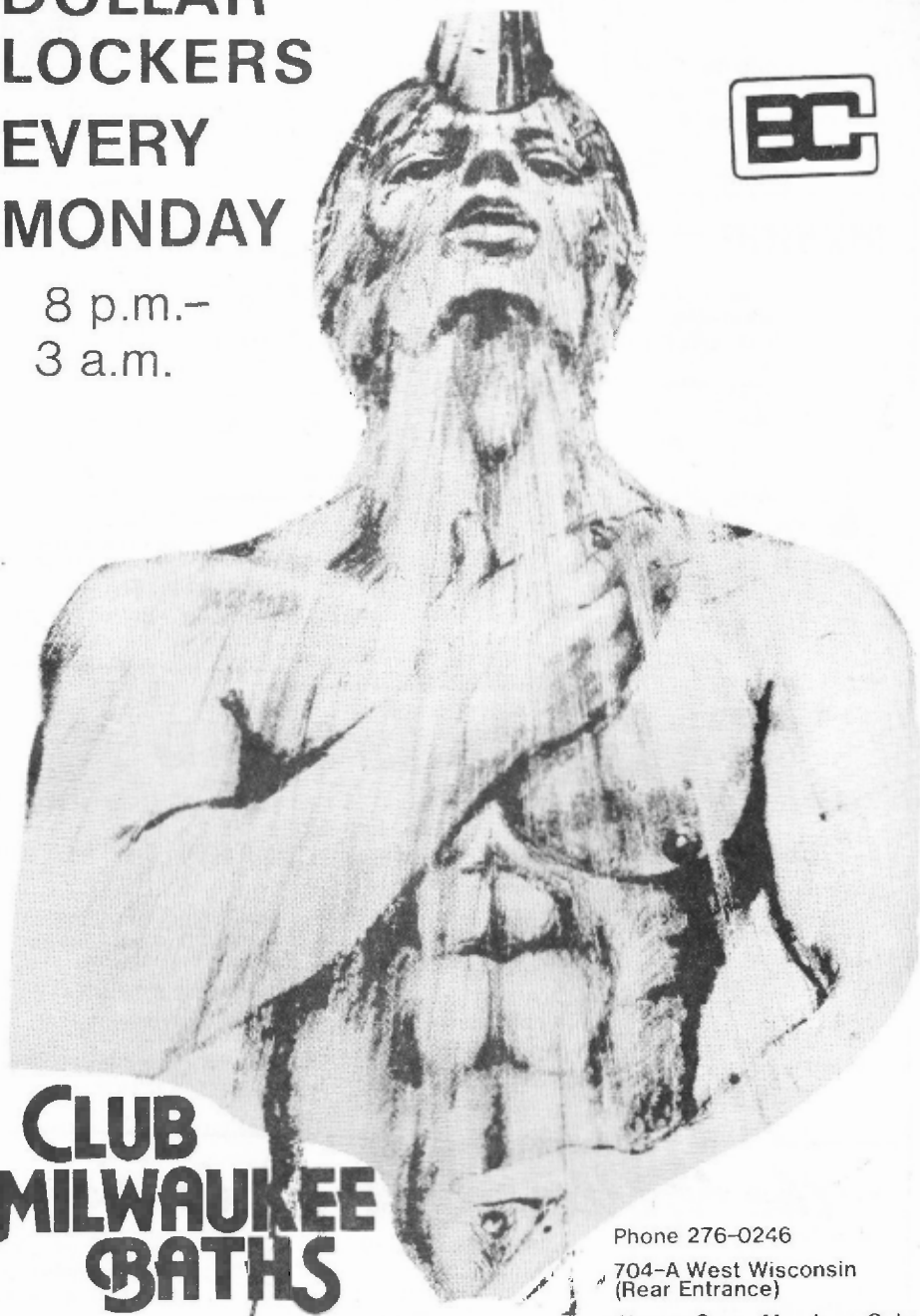
