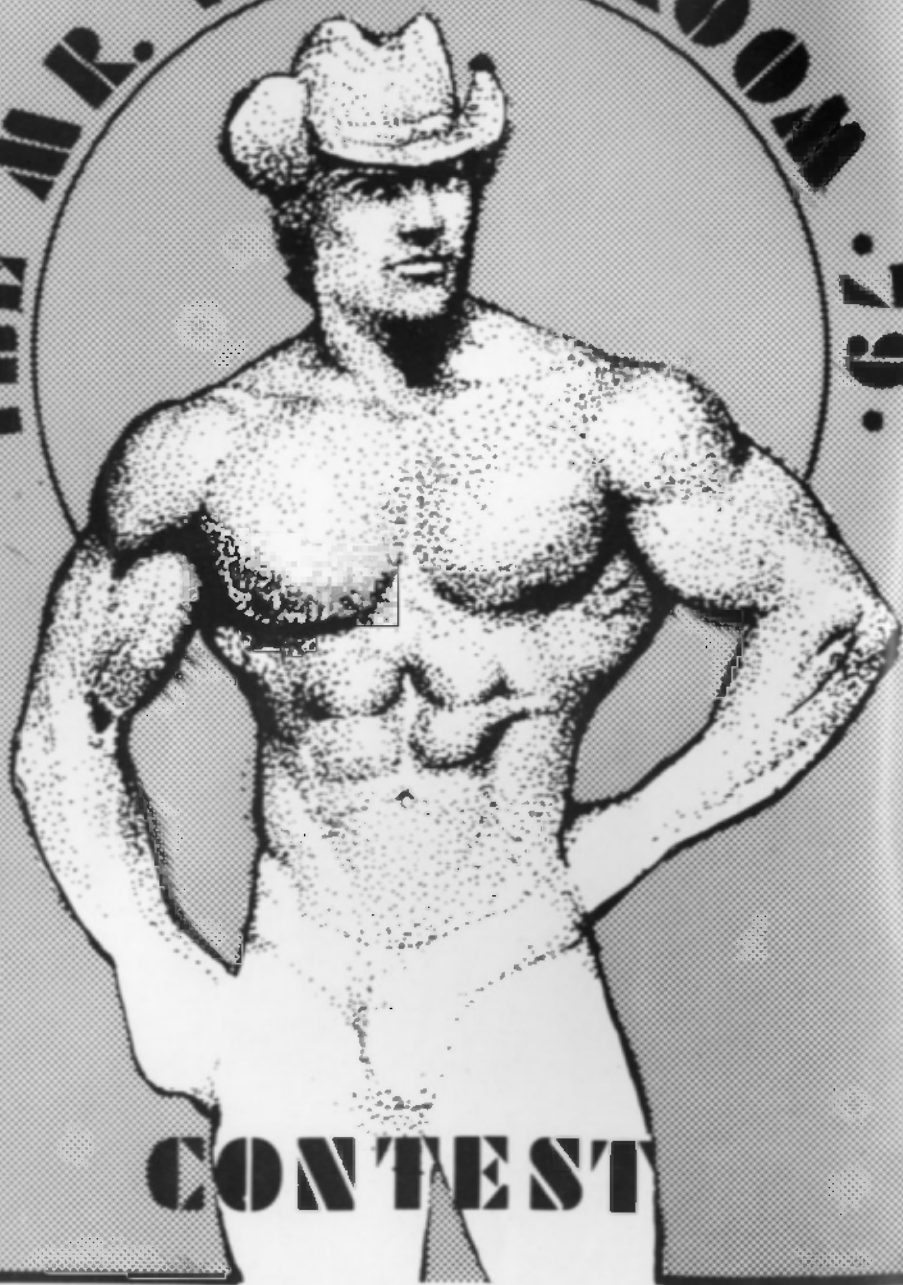

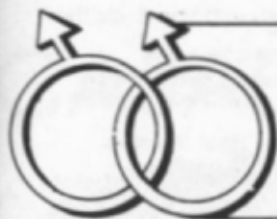

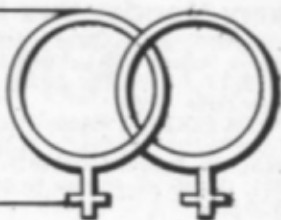

### AGE DISCRIMINATION
