

Set up a killer's cell in such a way that he can contemplate his victim each and every day for the remainder of his life. How about a mural on his cell wall depicting his victim and the victim's family. How is that any crueler than the daily reminders the victim's family must endure -- family photos on the mantel, missed birthdays, or holidays? Set up a killer's prison cell where no interaction with other inmates can occur. Make him think about what he did.

If a killer wants to read, they get one book with restricted reading hours. That's it, one book to last them the rest of their life. And it better be a good selection because they'll only get one opportunity to make their selection. The tax payers will provide three squares a day and basic medical services. And just so they won't rot in prison, they can shower every third day. Soap optional.

When it comes to the death penalty debate, I believe the easy way out for a convicted killer is for the state to put them out of their misery - just like old Sparky. I know I'd just as soon be put out of my misery, rather than have to face that type of environment for the rest of my life.

But in order for this type of punishment to work, hard time must be hard time. ©

If you are looking for Mexican cuisine **La Perla** is one of many places to go in South Milwaukee. Being convenient to all the bars (corner of 5th & National), makes this a great place to start a night out for cocktails.

As we walked in, immediately we were greeted by a hostess who promptly seated us. Authentic Mexican music was playing that set the mood for an upbeat dining experience. Our waiter took our drink order, suggesting their famous frozen margaritas, as we looked over the menu. Since we are not avid tequila drinkers, we opted for our usual cocktails. The menu was very extensive, a lot to choose from and very reasonably priced. We started with chicken quesadillas for an appetizer, \$6.25. They arrived promptly, hot, and were very good. However, there were only three of them and two of us. Since it consisted of one large quesadilla cut into thirds, better planning would have had it divided into fourths.

While waiting for the main course, over in one area, a large group was enjoying rides on the bucking red chili pepper. They were laughing and a lot of pictures were being taken. Several people were sitting at the, bar keeping that cute bartender busy mixing up frozen margaritas that **La Perla** is so famous for. For the main course I had chimichangas for \$7.75 and my partner had three enchiladas also \$7.75. Both dishes were absolutely wonderful. The chimichangas were nice and crispy on the outside and filled with cheese and chicken. The chicken enchiladas were very good too, they did not skimp on the chicken nor

the cheese on either entree. Both entrees came with rice and refried beans as usual. The service was good despite the fact they were very busy and were short-handed. The total bill came to \$31,80, including a round of drinks. With the tip our bill still came to less than \$50. I would rate La Perla 8 on a scale of 1 to 10 (with 1 being the lowest and 10 being the highest). I recommend La Perla for a nice Mexican dinner, so try it out. 

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
MADISON BAR MAP

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




