




About the Cover -Milwaukee's PrideFest

In 1994 PrideFest moved from Juneau Park to a new site on park land just north of the Milwaukee War Memorial Center. The year, PrideFest expanded the hours of operation opening at Noon Saturday until 10:30 pm with Sunday's Interfaith service starting the day at 10:30 am. That was the same year that PrideFest had two entertainment stages.

1995 PrideFest was proud to "LITE UP THE SKY WITH PRIDE" with a fireworks display sponsored by Miller Brewing and produced by Wisconsin's famous Bartolotta family. A first for Wisconsin PrideFest, proved to be a big hit with festival goers.

1996 was the year PrideFest would "Carry the Torch" to Henry Maier Festival Park. Admission was \$4.00 a day or \$8.00 for a 3-day admission pass. Though it rained most of the time, PrideFest had over 9,000 people attending the first year at the Festival Park.

Since 1996, PrideFest has watched the attendance grow steadily, increased the number of celebrities entertaining on PrideFest stages, provide more exhibitors and vendors in the marketplace and has found new food vendors to feed hungry festival goers each year.

2003 promises to be the biggest PrideFest ever with Pat Benatar, Judy Tenuta, Martha Davis and the Motels to name just a few. PrideFest is produced by a dedicated group of volunteers who begin planning the next festival as soon as the gates close Sunday night. The festival depends entirely on volunteers from the community. The volunteers are the unsung heroes of PrideFest; Without PrideFest volunteers, there would not be a festival.


Last month, after cruising over to Madison and meeting up with the artist truck driver, the story left off with me getting into his truck to spend the night.







Captain Dix Resort

Finally someone from our community has the balls to open up a vacation property just for us in Wisconsin. Those balls belong to Gary and Dennis who are partners in both business and their personal lives. They are the proud owners of Captain Dix Resort in the Wisconsin Dells. I spent a March weekend getaway at their resort.

The resort is off HWY 13 a little over one mile north of the Dells. The resort is nestled in a small valley of mature trees on 24 acres of land. Hidden away from all of the tourist attractions, it is the perfect location for a vacation playground. This is not a hotel. The resort is a complex of buildings like the older resorts up north with several stand-alone cabins. If you are afraid of bugs, a little dirt, or wild animals lurking in the woods, this is not the place for you. In fact, I did see a couple of bears at the bar Friday night.

This is not a cookie cutter resort where each cabin is the same. Each unit has it's own unique character. Sizes and prices vary so there will be rooms to meet everyone's needs. You can rent a room for 1 to 6 people or more depending on how well you get along with your friend's.

The cabins are located on both sides of the valley. Running through the bottom of the valley is Cruz Creek which dries up during the summer. At the center of the complex is the Main Lodge which contains the restaurant, Weasel Head's bar, a small dance floor, and soon a wooden deck for outdoor drinking. Saturday I had a Swiss mushroom burger prepared on an open flame. Saturday evening I had the prime rib special which comes in petite, queen, or king size. Sunday brunch is held from 10:00 to 2:00. Gary has done an outstanding job on the menu. There is something for everyone.

The resort has been around for over one hundred years. The previous owners did not maintain the property. Gary and Dennis purchased the property over 2 years ago and have made extensive renovations. All of the cabins will get a fresh coat of paint and new carpeting before the season is in full swing.
