About the Cover - Mixing Things Up at Out 'N About

If you haven't heard, there is a new bar in town. Out 'N About opened for business on August 1st at the corner of 1st and Greenfield. I stopped bye the place on the opening weekend. There still was some work that needed to be done. The kitchen was not finished yet. My first reaction was so so. The space was OK and the drinks were high priced.

I paid another visit on a Thursday night. The place was hopping. It was karaoke night. It was very entertaining, watching several talented patrons get up and sing.

I don't think I went there for several weeks. I started to hear from several people that the kitchen was open and that the food was very good and reasonably priced. I decided it was time to check out the food. I contacted my friend Ryan who I haven't seen in awhile and made plans to meet for diner. We met at another establishment for happy hour and arrived at Out 'N About (ONA) around 8:00. There were a few people in the bar and several tables eating.

Our waiter for the evening was Larry. The menu was surprisingly large. I knew the place had a small kitchen. I have no idea where they keep all of the food. We started off with a crab cake appetizer which contained 2 crab cakes for \$5.50. This was a bargain since I recently had one crab cake for \$9.95 at a restaurant in a Hilton Hotel. It is amazing how different you can make crab cakes. The ones at ONA come in a creamy tomato based seafood sauce with itty bitty shrimp. They were very good.



Next I had the cream of asparagus soup which was thick and loaded with bits of vegetables. Ryan had the house salad with balsamic vinaigrette dressing. The salad was very fresh and attractive with a garnishing of curled carrot peels. The soup or salad came with the main course.

For the main course I chose what was listed as the house favorite, Mediterranean pork chops for \$13.95. The dish is made with ONA's signature fresh basil, extra virgin olive oil, and balsamic vinaigrette sauce which is combined with Kalamata olives, sun dried tomatoes, artichokes, spinach, roasted red peppers, sweet red onions, and feta cheese. I couldn't even see the two pork chops with everything on top of them. It came with a very flavorful rice pilaf. I was very happy with my choice.

Ryan decided on the Jack Daniels Ribeye Steak for \$17.95. It came with ONA's Jack Daniels BBQ Sauce. He also chose the Cavatappi pasta in the house red sauce. The vegetable of the day was a medley of green beans, yellow beans, and carrots cooked so that they were still firm. The steak was good. He only wished that they would have served the BBQ sauce on the side instead of all over the steak. He couldn't eat everything so he took part of it home.

There were four choices for dessert. We decided to split the Chocolate Mosaic based upon the looks of it. It was very attractive but wasn't what we expected. It was a let down compared to the rest of the food. It was not made on site. I would rather have something that tastes good than looks good.

After dinner we decided to go into the bar area for a drink. It happened to be a Thursday night so karaoke was in full swing. We also had an opportunity to talk with one of the owners, Beverly. Some of you may remember Beverly from several years ago when she bartended at Switch. She was one of the first bartenders when Mugshots switched over to Switch. She was great behind the bar and always had a great

He must have had his new size 12 shoes on because he didn't make it up the steps with our drinks. They went all over him. When he reached for his pen he pulled out two olives and a pickle.

Alan had the salmon benedict for \$8.95 and Harold tried the crab cake benedict for \$8.95. I was different and ordered the apple and cream cheese stuffed French toast for \$6.95. It was made with challah bread, which is a very light Jewish egg bread. All of the meals came with very crispy American fries. We couldn't resist sampling each others dish. To top off our meal we had an ONA spritzer made with orange rum and various juices and a splash of 7-Up.



Both Beverly and Pam were at the restaurant that Sunday. They introduced us to one of their Managers, Vicky. Vicky also runs karaoke on Thursdays and has an excellent singing voice. They informed me that they have happy hour during the week from 3:00 to 7:00. They put out both cold and hot food for the patrons. I decided that another visit was in order.

I decided to go on a Tuesday after work by myself. I ended up working late so I didn't get there until 6:30. There were a few people at the bar and I decide to sit down and eat right away. It must have been my lucky day because I got Josh as my waiter again and Josh had Jen shadowing him for the

evening. I felt like I was getting two for the price of one.

Tonight I had a cup of mushroom soup. Again the soup was very thick and loaded with large pieces of mushrooms. It was rich dark brown and served at just the right temperature. Then I had the chicken and avocado sandwich with seasoned steak fries for \$6.50. It contained smoked Gouda cheese, fresh avocado, juicy beefsteak tomato, sautéed sweet red onions on a grilled Kaiser roll. It was a very tasteful combination, I decided to give dessert another try. I picked the fudge chocolate torte for \$5.95. It was very rich and creamy. Much better than the other dessert I tried earlier, Still not home made.

Overall the restaurant is very impressive. If you are planning on eating with a larger group please make a reservation or call and let them know you are coming. That will give them time to have things ready for you.

The entire place is very clean and fresh. There are windows on three sides of the building so the place has a very open feeling. This is a great place to go. Good luck Beverly, Pam, and all of the staff of ONA. Make sure you stop by and tell them Roger sent you.


