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




#### BESTD TURNS THIRTY

Milwaukee Clinic Celebrates Three Decades of Community Service. On October 16 the Brady East STD Clinic will celebrate thirty years of providing the Milwaukee community free STD counseling, testing, treatment and medication.

The clinic was founded in 1974 by the Gay People's Union in response to the rise of sexually transmitted diseases in gay and bisexual mean and the need for competent and sensitive health care. Originally located at Broadway and St. Paul, the clinic moved to its current location on Brady Street in 1981 after Dr. Roger Gremminger, volunteer physician and board member, donated his Brady Street building to BESTD.

The clinic's progressive and proactive strategy, fueled by the efforts of a dedicated volunteer work force, was responsible for one of the nations' first "outreach clinics" for off-site testing of STDs in the 1970s. BESTD has continued to be a leader in its outreach efforts and spearheaded the nation's first large-scale outreach use of the "Rapid" HIV test at Milwaukee's Pridefest in 2003. Today, BESTD remains one of the most active and accessible HIV testing sites in the state of Wisconsin.

With the economy, health care and Iraq, in the forefront, the issue of equality for America's LGBT community has taken a backseat in the Presidential campaign. Don't be fooled into thinking there is no difference between the main contenders. There is and it couldn't be starker. We must act not only to ensure further advances in LGBT equality, but also to maintain the gains we've already made.


John Kerry has a 100% pro-Gay voting record. Our appointed President never heard of a pro-equality measure he could support. Kerry calls for realistic AIDS safe-sex education, Bush demands "abstinence only" programs. Kerry opposes the Family Marriage Amendment to the Constitution, Bush promotes this attempt to turn us into second class citizens. Kerry is a co-sponsor of the Employment Non-Discrimination Act, Bush opposes it.

The Republican platform even calls for banning ANY recognition of same-sex relationships including Domestic Partnership benefits offered by private companies. Kerry supported legislation to grant domestic partnership benefits to all federal employees.

It's little wonder that even the Log Cabin Republican Clubs refuse to support Bush. His record and platform along with Kerry's active support of LGBT equality give us more than enough reasons to vote for the Senator. Yet there is an even more important reason: the federal courts.

The next President is expected to appoint at least one and possibly two Supreme Court Justices. These are lifetime appointments. Those put on the Court by the next President will have the final word on gay equality for the next two decades. Consider how closely divided the Supreme Court has been in deciding gay rights cases over the last few years. Think of what would happen if two more Anthony Scalia types are sitting on the Court when it decides future cases. More Anthony Scalia's is what we'll get. Bush appoint-
