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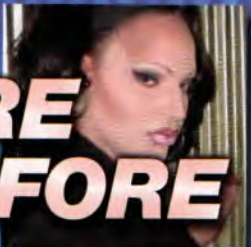


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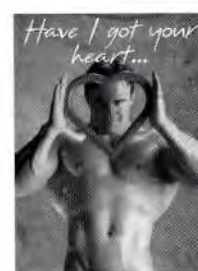


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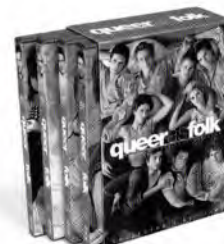

## PAUL MILAKOVICH LEAVES ARCW AFTER 14 YEARS

**Milwaukee, January 11, 2005-** Paul Milakovich, Chief Administrative Officer and General Counsel of the AIDS Resource Center of Wisconsin (ARCW), has decided to end his 14-year tenure at ARCW to pursue new career opportunities.

Milakovich has been a key member of the ARCW executive staff team that has led the transformation of ARCW from one of the smallest to one of the largest HIV/AIDS health and social service agencies in the nation.

"We will miss Paul terribly," said Doug Nelson, ARCW President and CEO. "But Paul leaves an extraordinary legacy of achievement that will serve us well for years to come."

"I'm proud of all that I've accomplished at ARCW. I will miss the staff, all of whom are so gifted and so dedicated to their work," said Milakovich.

Nelson praised Milakovich for building financial management, contract management, and technology systems at ARCW that are "best practice models" for nonprofit agencies. "It was Paul's administrative savvy that enabled us to successfully manage the rapid growth of HIV services propelling us from a \$1 million to a \$10 million agency," said Nelson.

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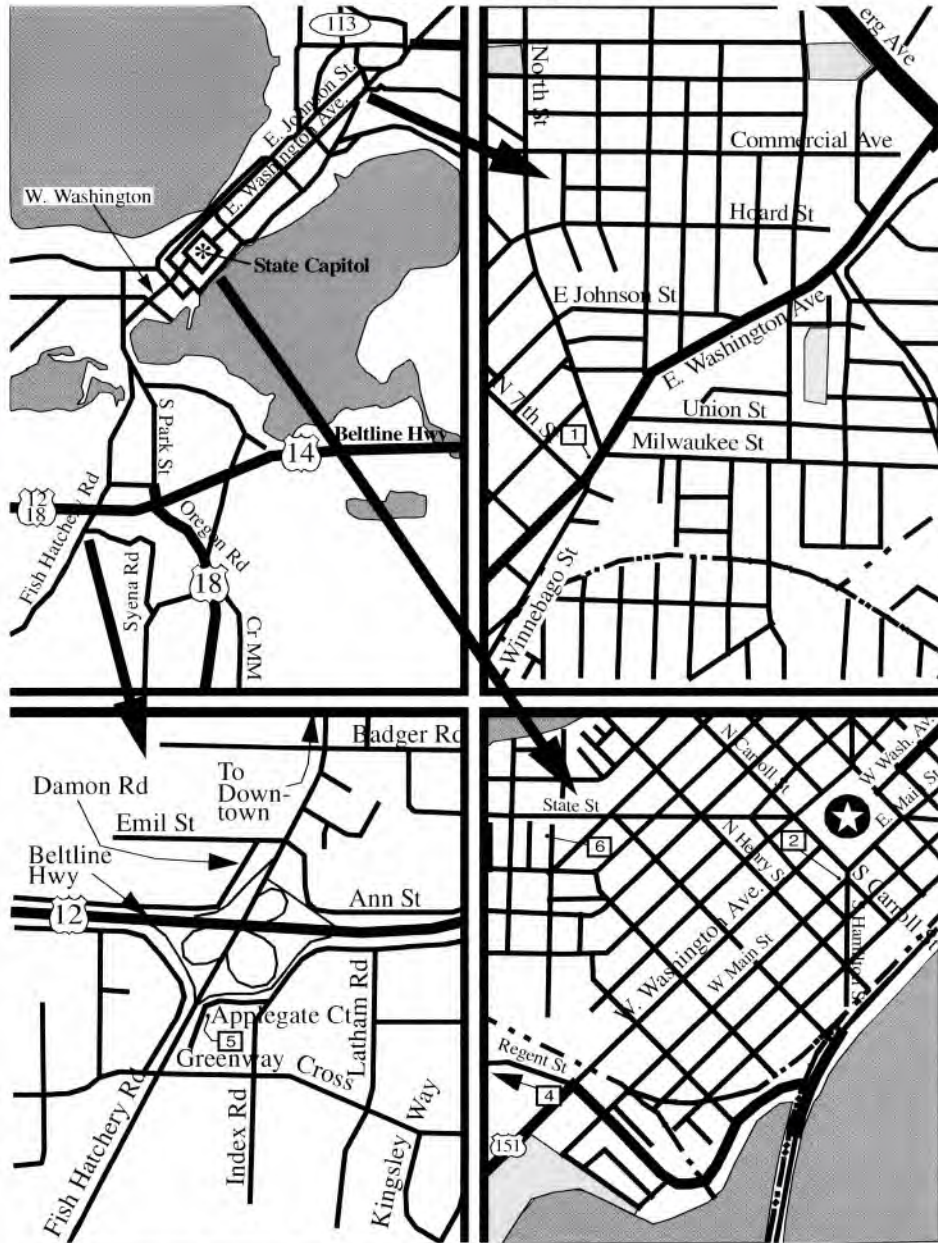

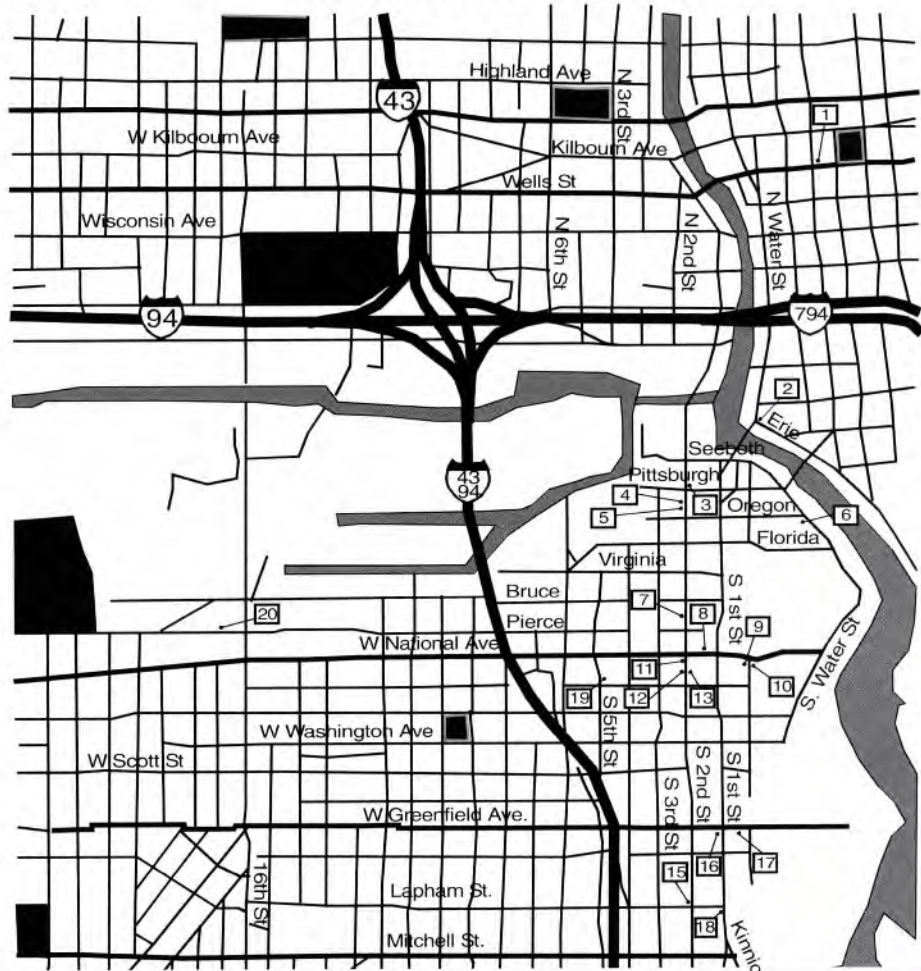
