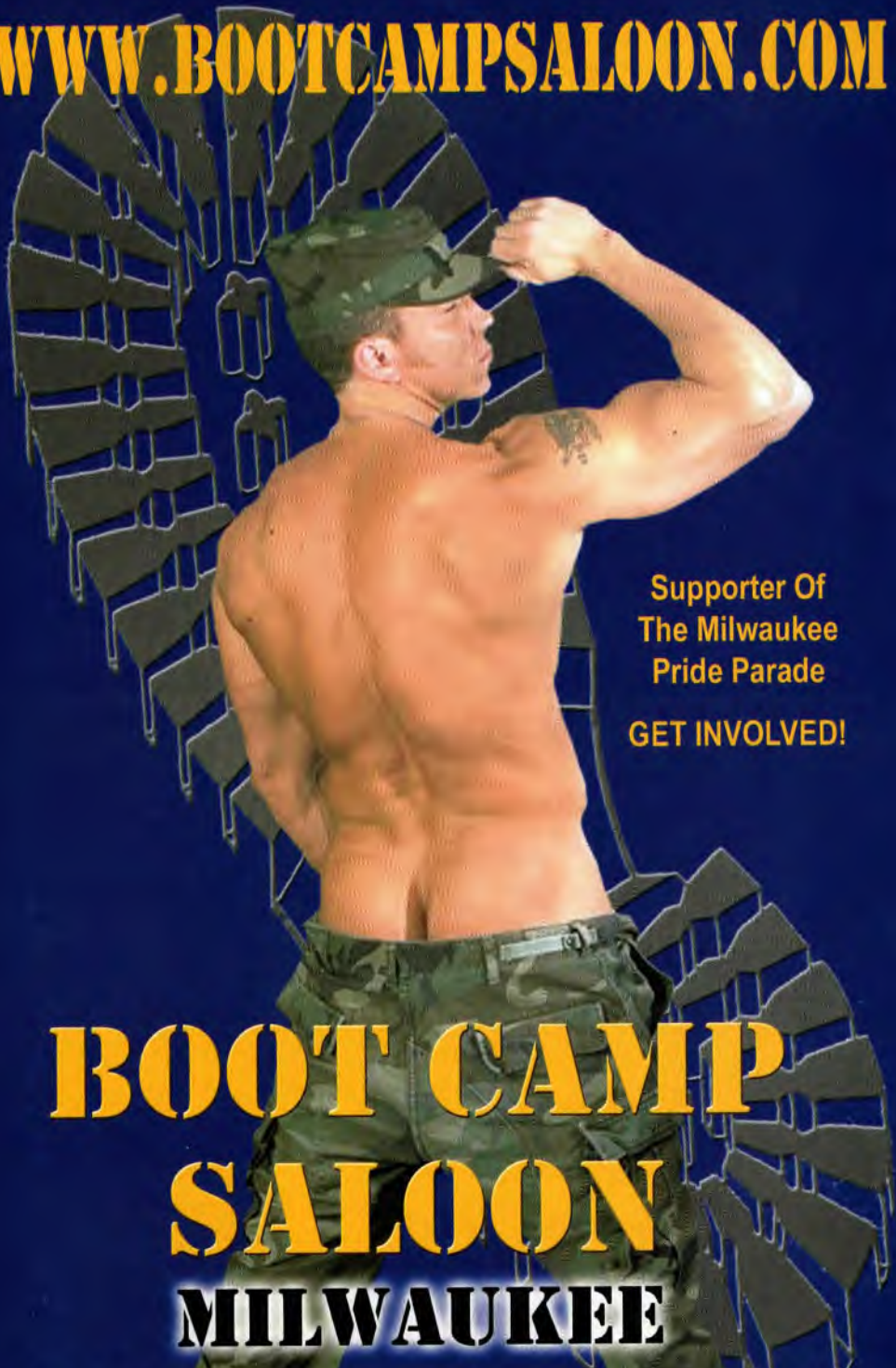

Skin and Steel

Hello again, I would once again like to welcome you to the new monthly column in *Outbound*, *Skin & Steel*! This month I would like to focus on a specific body piercing, but before I get to that I had a few emails asking what my qualifications were and how I learned so much about body piercing, so here we go. My name is Brent; I was trained by the owner of *Avant-Garde*, Jim, and have been piercing there ever since. I have been a body piercer for 5 years as of this print and have served on state committees attempting to toughen the laws on body piercing in the state of Wisconsin. I also teach a blood-borne pathogens and sterility course.

Another thing I would like to tell all my avid readers (you guys can read right?) is that each month I will talk about a specific piercing, the pros, cons, proper jewelry all that good stuff. I would like to hear feedback from my readers about their own experiences about their piercings and any questions that you have. I will try to print as many stories as I can and answer as

much I can. Now that we got all that out of the way, on to the piercing of the month.

With summer on its way, and most of you working on that set of abs you lost last November, we are all thinking about taking our shirts off during summer. So what a better piercing to start off with than nipples. Nipples can be a great source of enjoyment; they look great and in most cases feel great too! The placement of a nipple piercing greatly varies from person to person. Some people have very pronounced and developed nipples, when a nipple is this way it should be pierced right at the base of the nipple. The majority of male nipples we see are typically underdeveloped and rarely become erect (god I love that word) unless excited, some don't even become erect when they are played with. For these people the piercing is placed just behind the nipple for a few reasons. First by placing them further back the chance of the piercing staying in the body increases dramatically. Second, by placing them further back it will cause the nipple to develop out more to make the nipple more pronounced, not erect, but more developed. Helping those of use who were not so developed in the first place. With the nipple more developed it produces a more defined chest, causing the chest to look MUCH more appealing.

Now your all probably saying to yourselves, "That would hurt too much to get pierced!" Well, they're not that bad, as with any piercing if you come in relaxed and enjoy your time at the studio then you will have no problem getting through this piercing. Nipples heal quite well for most people; the most common problem is that the piercing gets irritated. Irritations happen because of a number of reasons, such as the following: touching or playing with the piercing, letting someone else play with the piercing (you bad boy's know

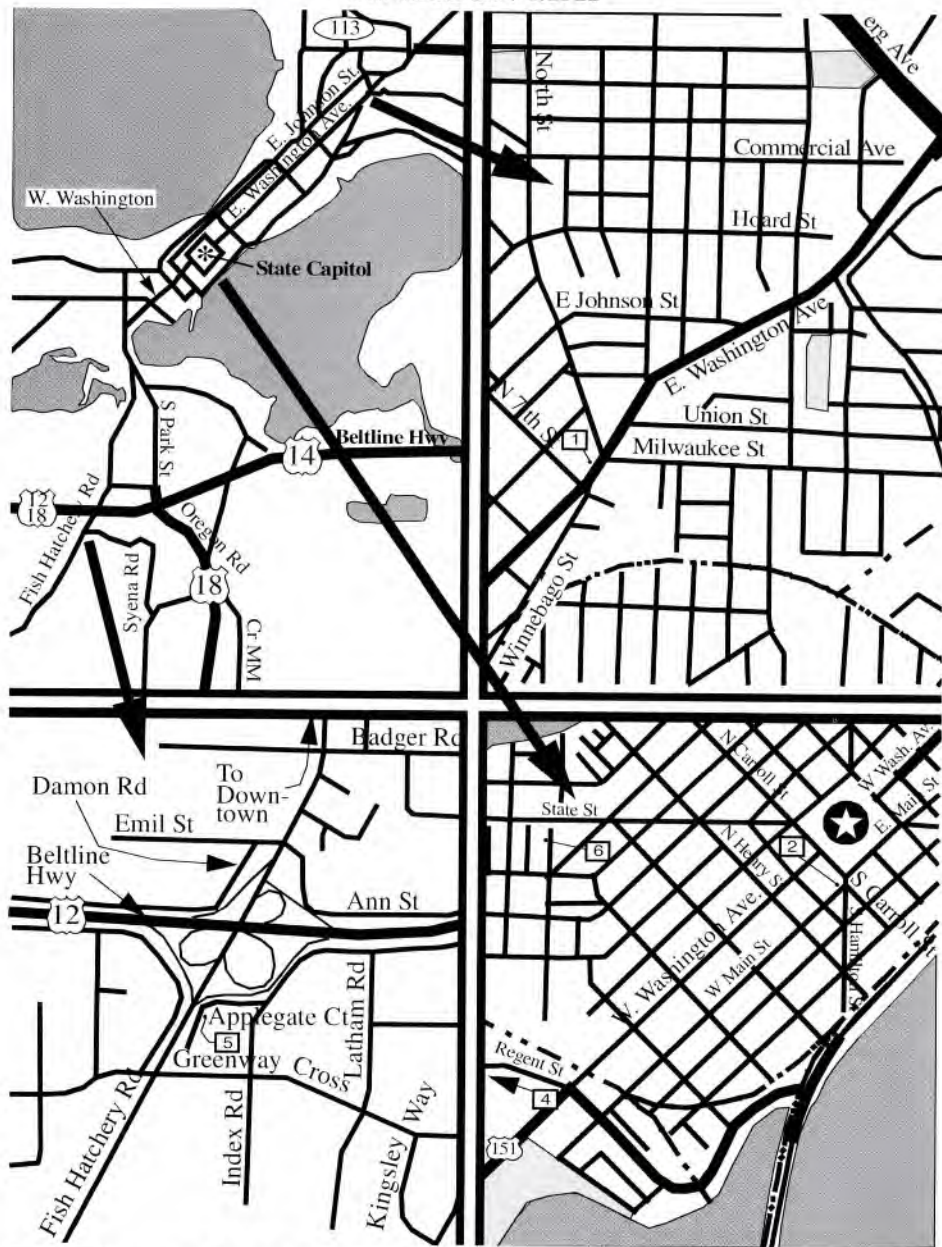

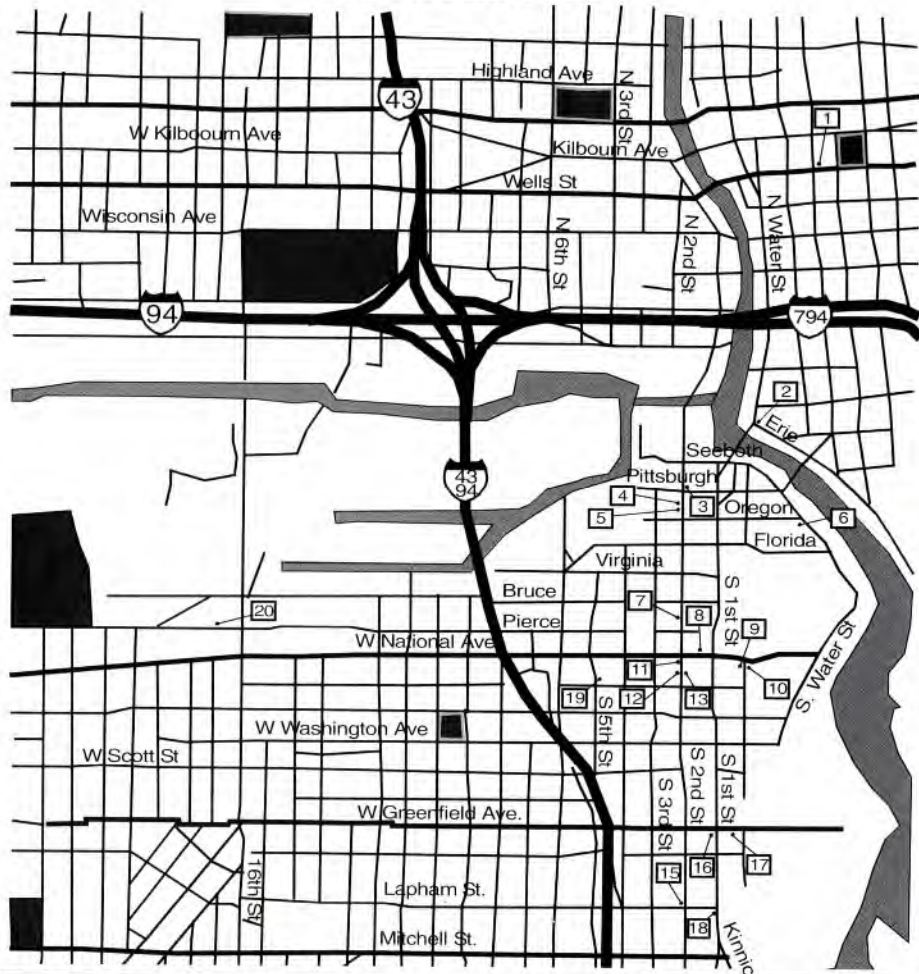

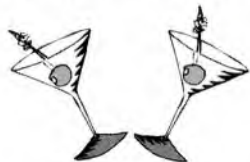
