Skin and Steel



Welcome back to newest and coolest article in Outbound. That's right *Skin and Steel* is back again. I want to thank everyone for the great response I have gotten since the beginning of this article. And now onto our new piercing of the month ... the Prince Albert (also called a P.A.).

First off let's talk about where the P.A. usually goes. The P.A. is a piercing that is placed through the underside of the shaft of the penis and out the urethra. It's typically done with a captive bead ring in a 12-gauge (gauge being the thickness of the jewelry). Now I know that all of you are probably going, "OW!
