

Equally preposterous is Private Man's One Track Mind, a big-budget offering featuring such hardworking Eurohunks as Vilem Cage, Eric Flower and Drago Lembeck.

Plot? What plot? To figure out what's going on, you'll have to replay the voice-over narration far more times than this reviewer was willing. Basically, there's a strange painting, a family curse and a demon guy in a horrible, Ozzy Osborne wig.

Much better to sit back and watch the sex, which for Private Man, is surprising energetic and hot. Case in point is the very first scene where two soldiers find a strange painting of a naked man. Both Drago Lembeck and Igor become positively transfixed, ripping off uniforms and humping each other like crazed rabbits. Rock hard throughout the scene, Drago rides Igor as if he were in a bronco riding completion at gay rodeo. Giddyup!

Drago, now in possession of the painting, both figuratively and literally, returns in several scenes including a kinky solo and later in a dream sequence where the badly-wigged demon guy gets Drago in a sling and rides him hard.

Thrown in for good measure are a couple of bondage-laced orgies with the always reliable Cage in control as the puppet master.

On Track Mind spirits along with a total of seven moody sex scenes with 14 hot, uncut Eastern European models flexing their ripped torsos and dabbling in a dazzling array of fetishes, from bootlicking and foot-worship to sex toys, dog collars and some pretty hot bondage.

Shake Your Bon-Bon Salsa

It may not be as hot as that cute, little Ricky Martin (Come out, come out wherever you are!) but it's darn good. It's a no-fuss salsa that's a refreshing treat to share with your amigos on a hot summer night. A gal-pal named Amy sent it.

2 seeded diced tomatoes

1/2 each medium red onion and white onion, diced 1/2 each medium green pepper and red pepper, diced

1 Scotch bonnet or Havanero pepper, diced

6 green onions, sliced thin

2-3 large cloves of garlic, minced

I avocado, diced

Combine all ingredients in a bowl. Serve with tortilla chips. Store leftovers in the refrigerator.

REVIEWS

One Track Mind from Private Man DaVinci Load 2: Electric Twinkaloo from PZP Productions

Adult entertainment doesn't get much more fun or certainly any goofier than One Track Mind from Private Man or PZP Production's Da Vinci Load 2. Electric Twinkaloo which picks up right where Da Vinci Load left off with tattooed muscle twink Sebastian Young returning as Agent Leo Da Vinci. His mission accomplished, Da Vinci now must defeat a dark prophecy that threatens mankind.

There's a twink out there, somewhere, named Billy O'Reilly destined to be father of "the Antichrist." Da Vinci must find that one twink. the Electric Twinkaloo, pound his ass and turn him away from pussy forever. To find the right Billy O'Reilly and complete his "righteous mission," he enlists the help of horse-hung Agent Randy Schlong (Casey Wood). If Randy's amazing schlong won't turn a straight twink gay, nothin' will.

The first Billy O'Reilly is a pizza boy (Matt Havoc). Gee, now that's certainly an original porn premise. Sebastian offers Billy a piece of pizza, then his substantial hardon. It ain't long before

straight-boy Billy eagerly services Leo from head to toe. Leo rides the pizza boy every which way he can. Sad to say, this Billy isn't the Electric Twinkaloo. Next!

The second Billy O'Reilly (Todd Hunter) is a obliging lad, helping Agent Schlong pack groceries into his car before the two head off for some nude swimming. Mop-haired Casey is absolutely huge. Hunter deserves credit when his Billy O'Reilly doesn't run screaming at the sight of it. Game lad that he is, this Billy gets banged left, right and center before each rewards the other with impressive cum facials.

Up next is bizarre three-way with Harry Beastt's loony Nazi lurking in the background. First Billy Matt Havoc is joined by slim twinks Tristan Everhard and Remi Steele and it's all fun and games until a spurting cock triggers a poor twink's gag reflex...

Casey's Randy Schlong is back, visiting a distant relative and happily bunking with the hot son, another Billy O'Reilly (Derrek Scott). Billy warns Randy not to touch him but touch him he does. Restless and armed with a mega-hardon, Randy turns his attention to the slumbering lad's trim little butt. Somehow Billy remains asleep while Randy rims him, turns him over and offers an energetic blow job. A kiss awakens Billy's sexual passion and soon he is happily taking every monstrous inch that Agent Randy Schlong has at his disposal. Wood's mighty cannon fires an impressive load while Scott's money shot looks rather dubious.

The final Billy O'Reilly (Jayden Holloway) is a clean-cut member of the Church of Latter Day Saints who just happens to turn up on Leo Da Vinci's doorstep. An explosive sneeze sends the two into a hot bath encounter with Sebastian Young hard and more than eager to seduce the wayward Mormon. Holloway is a pro and accommodates every inch Young offers, leading to the cumshot that saves the world. Or is it Da Vinci's laser penis that saves the world?

Twink-lovers be warned, Da Vinci Load 2: Electric Twinkaloo is a decidedly low-budget for those used to Bel Ami. On the plus side, the screenplay is fun and Casey Wood not only offers a major piece of hardware but a great smile and some genuine enthusiasm. Let's hope the promised sequel loses the strange soundtrack, the shaky camera work not to mention some of the phoniest cumshots seen since the 1980s.

Juicy Drunken' Meatballs

You can't believe how surprised I was when this recipe arrived. That's because it was sent by Jim and James...the previous owners of "Outbound Magazine." They are living large in Pennsylvania and wish everyone the best. The dynamic duo wanted to share a favorite dish, and sent this keeper. Serve the meatballs on their own as a Pride Party appetizer, ladle them over pasta for dinner or tuck 'em into a sandwich bun for a satisfying lunch! No matter how you like your balls, you'll think of Jim and James when you pop these suckers in your mouth. (Okay...that sentence didn't sound quite right.)

3/4 cup milk

1/2 cup soft breadcrumbs

I tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

I teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon garlic powder

1/8 teaspoon pepper

1/8 teaspoon hot pepper sauce

1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg, divided

1/4 teaspoon ground ginger

2 pounds ground beef

2 tablespoons vegetable oil

I (18-oz.) jar peach jam

1/4 cup granulated sugar

1/2 cup brandy

I tablespoon cornstarch

I tablespoon water

- 1. In a large bowl, combine the first seven ingredients. Stir in 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg. Crumble the ground beef over the mixture and kneed it all together. Shape into 1-inch balls.
- 2. Heat oil in an extra-large skillet over medium heat. Add the meatballs in small batches until browned. Drain meatballs on paper towels.
- 3. In a Dutch oven, combine the jam, brown sugar, brandy and remaining nutmeg. Heat over low heat and simmer 10 minutes. Carefully add meatballs to Dutch oven, cover, and simmer for 1 hour, stirring occasionally.
- 4. In a small bowl, combine cornstarch and water. Slowly stir into the Dutch oven. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until sauce thickens.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

A Dutch oven is a large pot-like thing-a-ma-gig that will allow you to simmer the sauce and the meatballs all at once. If you don't have one, use an extra large skillet or two large skillets with lids.

Make soft bread crumbs by tearing up fresh bread and chopping it with a food processor. Do not use dried (canned) bread crumbs in this recipe.

If you'd like to half the recipe, simply use a dash of hot pepper sauce and pepper, and remember that half a tablespoon is 1-1/2 teaspoons. You'll need about 2 slices of bread to make the 1/2 cup of bread crumbs the meatballs call for.

Gay 'n' Gooey Butter Bars

Okay...if there's only one recipe of mine that you ever try, make it this one! A gal named Marcee sent the recipe, and I'm telling ya, it's gonna become your all-time favorite treat. Best of all, you can dress the snacks up however you like. You just can't beat 'em damnit! Marcee calls 'em Gooey Butter Bars, but since it's Pride time, I figure it couldn't hurt to gay them up a bit!



CAKE

I (18.25-oz.) box yellow cake mix

I stick butter, melted

FILLING

I (8-oz.) package cream cheese, softened

2 eggs

I teaspoon vanilla extract

I (16-oz.) box confectioner's sugar I stick butter, melted

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Lightly grease a 13x9x2 baking pan with nonstick cooking spray.
- 2. In a bowl with an electric mixer, combine the cake ingredients. Pat into the bottom of the baking pan and set aside.
- 3. Use the electric mixer to beat cream cheese until smooth. Add eggs one at a time. Add vanilla; mix well. Add confectioner's sugar and beat well. Reduce speed of mixer and slowly pour in butter. Mix well.
- 4. Pour filling over cake mixture and spread evenly. Bake for 40-50 minutes. Remove from oven and cool completely.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Marcee says that there are many variations you can create with this basic recipe. She manually stirs in 1/2 cup EACH of white baking chips, peanut butter chips, butterscotch chips and toffee chips at the end of Step 3.

Experiment with different flavors of cake mix.

"These bars are very rich," writes Marcee, "and a little goes a long way so I cut them into small bars or squares."





Well, now that I have gotten all that out of the way, lets get to talking about what you really read this column for . . . piercings and tattoos!

This month I figured I have talked enough about piercings for a while so why not talk about tattoos for a bit. Let's get going.

First off, in tattooing you have to decide what you want to have tattooed on you! Now I know all you guys are thinking to yourself about getting a hanging rooster tattooed on your calf so you can tell people," Hey guess what? I have a cock that hangs below my knees!" But don't get it! Don't be a douche, think about what you are going to get. Don't just pick something or let your friends talk you into something. Remember you are the one who is going to have to live with that pink flower on your ass when you friends die from laughing at "How cute it is!" So remember think long and hard about the tattoo you are going to get!

Next let's talk about choosing a shop. Now I know I got a bunch of hate mail for saying this last time but I will say it again. Don't go to any tattoo shop in the City of Milwaukee! The reason for this is that 99% of all the people who are tattooing in the city of Milwaukee have only been tattooing for less than I year. In a real shop someone with that experience isn't even trusted to clean the toilet! So when you are choosing a shop make sure to ask how long they have been tattooing for, and make sure the number sounds believable. After all, you don't want to get tattooed by a guy who says he has been tattooing for 30 years when the guy himself is only 20! And if you believe that, I have some swampland in Texas to sell you!

Also when you are at the shop make sure to check out the room that they use to tattoo, this room should be clean and neat and tidy. If they are tattooing you in a lounge chair with fluffy frills then you might want to leave. While you are in the shop make sure you check the license on the wall and make sure they are all valid and not expired.

Finally we have to talk about aftercare; since there are so many types I will touch on most of them and then tell you which one I have had the best results with. Each tattooist has their own versions of aftercare. These are the ones I have used. First I have tried using A&D ointment. This really helps heal but when the scabs begin to fall off, the ointment can pull the scabs off prematurely and cause damage to the tattoo. The second way is to use a lotion like Lubriderm to help heal the tattoo. This way also works similar to the A&D ointment and also has the same drawbacks, although not as bad because the lotion spreads easier on the skin. The final way is to dry heal, this is when you put nothing on the






