EMMY LOU'S SUNDAY SPECIAL

Ask any trailer-trash cook and they'll be the first to tell you that Tater Tot casserole isn't something to dick around with. You either got a good recipe or you don't. Period. Here's one you can't live without. Try a slice of bubbling, greasy heaven tonight and you'll lick the damn dish clean!

1 lb. ground beef

I small onion, chopped

I (10 oz) can cream of chicken soup

1/2 cup water

I package frozen Tater Tots

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Brown the beef and onions in a nonstick skillet; Drain. Spritz a 9x13x2-inch baking dish with cooking spray. Spread beef mixture evenly into dish. In a medium bowl, combine the soup with the water. Pour over the beef mixture. Top with Tater Tots. Bake, uncovered, for 30 minutes or until bubbly and a knife inserted in the center comes out clean.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

The cast of the play suggests serving the casserole with a green salad and cookies for dessert. They also say you can cut the dish's overall fat by setting the cooked, drained meat in a colander and rinsing it in cold water.

RUTHIE'S STICKY BUNS

Alright, alright. Let's not worry about how my buns got sticky in the first place. Just know that my buns are the best you've put your lips on in a long, long time. Best of all, you set the little suckers in the oven the night before, then just bake them up in the morning. Your tricks have never been so impressed.

18 frozen dinner rolls

I Small package butterscotch pudding

(Cook & Serve)

1/2 cup brown sugar

3/4 teaspoon cinnamon

1/2 cup chopped pecans

1/2 cup whole pecans

1/2 cup butter, melted

Spray a 9x13x2-inch baking pan with cooking spray. Place frozen rolls somewhat evenly in pan.

Combine all of the dry ingredients, including the nuts, and sprinkle over the frozen rolls. Drizzle butter over the top of everything. Cover the rolls loosely.

Before going to bed at night, set the baking dish in a cold oven (keep the oven off), allowing the rolls to rise overnight.

In the morning, uncover the rolls and bake at 350° for 30 minutes. (Cover the rolls loosely with foil towards the end of the baking time, if they begin to brown too fast.) Cool for 5 minutes. Place platter or another 9x13 pan over top of the pan and invert the rolls.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Do not use instant pudding in this recipe. You must pick up the mix for which the pudding is made on the stovetop. Use a clean kitchen towel to cover the buns overnight. Just be sure to remove the towel before baking in the morning! If you forget to bake the rolls the next morning, toss out the pan and start all over again.







DJ TONY MORAN TO BRING "THE EVENT" TO PRIDEFEST

He's written and re-mixed for the biggest names in music: Madonna, Celine Dion, Michael and Janet Jackson, Jennifer Lopez, Whitney Houston, Cyndi Lauper, Gloria Estefan, George Michael...the list goes on and on. Over the years he has been a major contributor to the dance and pop music scene, and on Saturday, June 7th, Moran will bring his magic to PrideFest's Dance Pavilion with a blazing DJ set that will be one of the biggest dance events of the year.

Every live DJ set by Moran can be considered an event, but this year's PrideFest gig comes on the heals of the release of the compilations, "The Event" and "The Event 2008."

Moran released the albums the hard way — by himself. Despite painstaking hours of recording, remixing and producing, the resulting two-CD limited edition and the new "Event 2008" are testaments to the handsome DJ's staying power in the fickle world of dance music.

Whether as a music editor, record producer, songwriter, singer or DJ, Tony Moran has stayed on top of his game, exhibiting time and time again that his creativity is unrestricted.

"I don't try to reinvent myself. I work at making music and playing music because I love it. I don't set boundaries, nor do I allow them to be built around me," explains Tony. "I go where the music takes me."

"The Event" limited edition is a momentous 24-track compilation of mostly tribal beats overlayed with some of the biggest voices in dance music. "Walk Away" is the lead single, featuring gay dance darling and Moran muse Kristine W. Remixes by Moran and protégé Warren Rigg are available on the

single and on iTunes. Kristine simply sounds amazing, and it's evident in her live performances that she enjoys this new hit.

Moran enlisted other divas with big vocals as well. Deborah Cox joins in on "Everybody Dance," a cover of the disco classic by Chic. This version definitely embodies the feel of the 1978 original, but Moran and Cox craft a modern classic. Cox, of course, unleashes her considerable pipes.

A remix by Offer Nissim is already floating around the Internet, a good sign that a single is forthcoming.


Vicki Shepard and Jeanie Tracy team up on the infectious "I Got a Feelin'," Danielle Bollinger lends her clear, crisp vocals to "Surrender Me," and Martha Wash blasts her way through "Keep Your Body Workin'" with her usual tremendous sound. Moran even throws in a dance remix cover of "Black Magic Woman" for good measure to close out the second CD.

Not one to be left out, Moran steps back in front of the microphone to sing vocals (as he did on his 2004 cover of "The Promise") on "Something About You." Nissim does the remixing honors.

Perhaps the granddaddy of them all is "Brokeback Revisited" by the DJ Seekers (Moran, Rigg and Manny Lehman). It's a re-worked version of "The Wings" by Gustavo Santaolalla from the "Brokeback Mountain" soundtrack, featuring a healthy dose of the mournful guitar that still packs a club punch, much like the original remixes from last year.

All in all, Moran crafts two amazing collections, and they serve as a powerful calling card for the visit he'll pay to PrideFest's popular dance pavilion on June 7th.

ever provide sensitivity to the wearing in the area of the piercings. Finally we also have to talk about the guiche piercing; it is placed behind the scrotum and in front of the anus. Basically the taint (why do they call it taint?) Because it taint your nut sack and it taint your pooper! Now that we have that bad joke out of the way. The guiche piercing is nice for people who like rimmers as well as actual intercourse, when the piercing is placed right it puts a slight pressure on the Prostate gland, which as we all know is the male G-spot. 
I was wondering why you always talk about male piercings in your column. How bout doing something for us ladies! ----Tina

Veteran director Doug Jeffries takes viewers into the depths of one very hot sex club in his latest effort, **Chosen**. What makes it so hot is that everyone looks like a porn star. Perhaps that's because everyone found there are indeed porn stars.




