Savory Spinach Squares

Here's a sensational appetizer shared by Shelley from Franklin. Flecked with green spinach, the no-fuss pizza makes a super-duper contribution to a holiday buffet.

I can (1 8 ounces) crescent rolls I cup shredded cheddar cheese 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese 1-1/2 cup milk

3 eggs, well beaten 1/4 cup flour

1/8 teaspoon each pepper, nutmeg, onion powder 1/4 teaspoon salt

I package (10 ounces) oz frozen spinach, thawed and squeezed dry

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Place unrolled dough in a 13x9-inch baking pan. Press over bottom and 1/2 inch up the sides of the pan; seal any perforations. Combine remaining ingredients; spread over the dough. Bake 25-35 minutes until the filling is set and crust is golden brown. Cut into squares. Refrigerate leftovers.
