I don't know about you, but as the weather gets turn to heat and add remaining ingredients. Reduce colder my thoughts turn to comfort foods that warm me from my heart to my keester. Hot Dog Chili

Jaden is a little cutie who works at M's bar. You can image my surprise when this recipe showed up in my in-box from him. What a sweetie! I can't wait to see him in his Bitchin' Kitchen T-shirt. Thanks Jaden!

- I medium onion, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- I pound lean ground beef
- 2-1/2 cups ketchup
- 2 teaspoons chili powder
- I teaspoon cayenne pepper
- I teaspoon paprika
- 2 tablespoons prepared yellow mustard
- Dash of salt and pepper
- Hot dogs & Buns

Sautee onion and garlic in oil in a Dutch oven or large kettle over medium-high heat. Add ground beef, and cook until beef is no longer pink; drain. Re-

heat and simmer 15-20 minutes, uncovered, until thickened. Prepare hot dogs according to package directions. Serve chili with hot dogs and buns.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Jaden suggests using Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper in the chili. Feel free to serve the chili alone without the hot dogs. If you're watching your weight, use ground turkey or a pound of non-beef crumbles in place of the ground beef.

Oatmeal Cake

This treat was sent by Joshua of Milwaukee. It's a from-scratch specialty that's a bit more involved than the recipes I usually publish, but if you're gonna bake. fall is one hell of a time to do it. Bake up Joshua's cake and snuggle up with a cup of coffee, a good movie and your favorite hottie.

- 1-1/3 cups boiling water

- 1-1/3 cups flour
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- I teaspoon baking soda 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1-1/2 sticks butter or margarine, softened
- I cup light brown sugar, packed
- I cup sugar
- 2 eggs



Frosting

1/4 cup sweetened condensed milk I stick butter or margarine, softened 1/2 cup light brown sugar

1 cup shredded coconut

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Combine the water and the oats. Let mixture stand until thick (an oatmeal consistency). Sift the next four ingredients together, in a small bowl. With a mixer, beat together the margarine, brown sugar and sugar until creamy. Add eggs to mixture, one at a time, while mixing.

Slowly stir the flour mixture into the butter-sugar mixture until just combined. Fold in the oat mixture. Pour into a greased 13x9-inch baking pan for 30 to 40 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean.

Meanwhile, combine the milk, margarine and brown sugar in a small bowl. Stir in the coconut. Frost cooled cake with frosting.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Don't have time to make the frosting yourself? Pick up a can of German Chocolate or Pecan-Coconut Frosting from the store. Soften butter in the microwave by putting the unwrapped stick on a plate and zapping it in 15 second intervals until it's soft. If you happen to have shredded coconut on hand, but it's a bit hard, let it sit in a few tablespoons of milk before using it.

Well now that we have talked about all that lets get to some reader mail.


Dear Brent.
