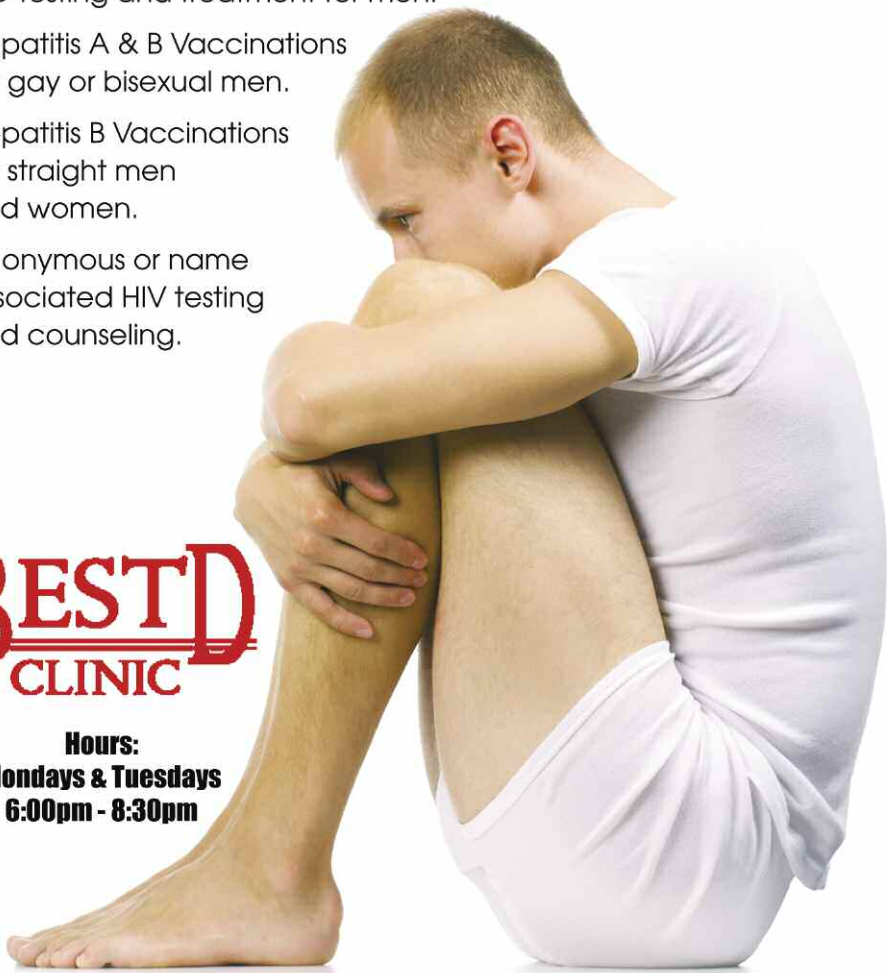

½ teaspoon dried basil
 2/3 cup Greek vinaigrette (from a 16 oz bottle)
 1 large yellow summer squash, thinly sliced & quartered
 1 large zucchini, thinly sliced and quartered
 5 radishes, thinly sliced
 1 carrot, thinly sliced
 1 medium red onion, sliced

Mix the basil and dressing in a large bowl. Stir the other ingredients into the bowl. Toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate salad overnight. Serve with a slotted spoon. Refrigerate leftovers.

I use Kraft Greek Vinaigrette Dressing & Marinade for this recipe. Pump up the flavor by tossing in a small cucumber, thinly sliced, right before serving. You can

also add a half-cup of crumbled feta cheese right before, too.

Summer's Best Side Dish

"Everyone loves a corn pudding with a summer barbecue," promises Steve of Bay View. "Here's a no-brainer my mom used to make in the slow cooker. It fucking rocks!" Thanks Steve! You're free Bitchin' Kitchen T-shirt is on the way. (And it fucking rocks, too.)

¾ cup water
 1 teaspoon salt
 ¼ cup butter, melted
 1 box (6.5 oz) corn muffin/bread mix
 1 can (4 oz) chopped jalapeno peppers, drained
 1 bag (1 lb) frozen corn
 1 can (14.75 oz) cream-style corn
 2 cans (11 oz ea) Mexicorn, drained

Mix the first four ingredients together in a large bowl. Stir in the

remaining items. Pour mixture into a greased 3- or 4-quart slow cooker. Cover and cook on low for 3 hours. Stir; cover and cook 3 hours longer. Refrigerate leftovers.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

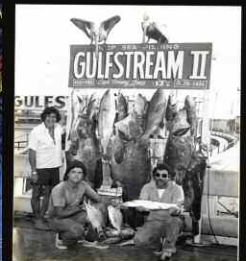
Like things spicy? Add a dash of red pepper flakes to the mixture. Like it a bit on the mild side? Leave out the jalapenos. Mexicorn is simply whole kernel corn that's canned with bits of green and red pepper. For extra flair, sprinkle some finely shredded cheddar cheese or taco-flavored cheese over the pudding before serving.

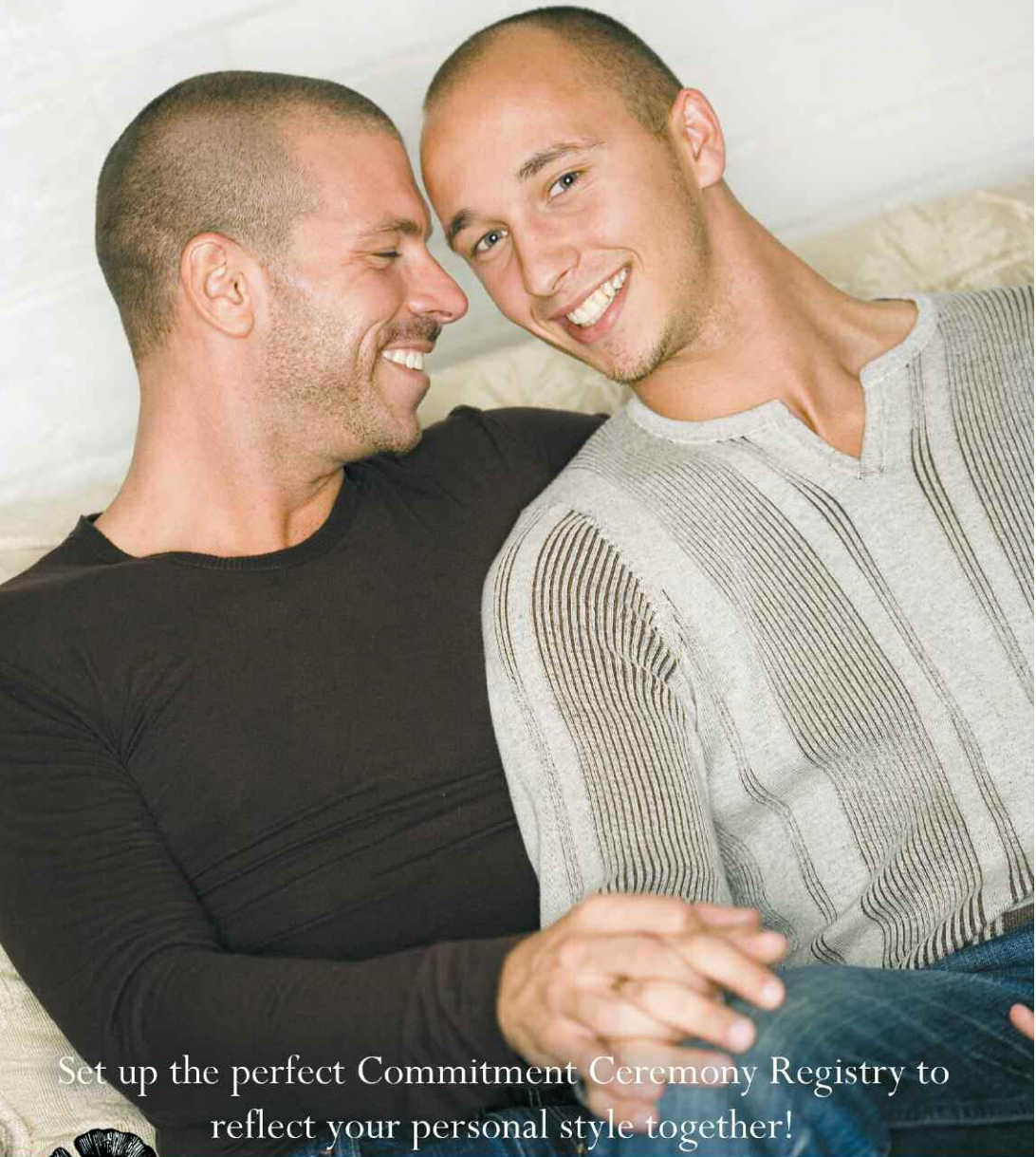

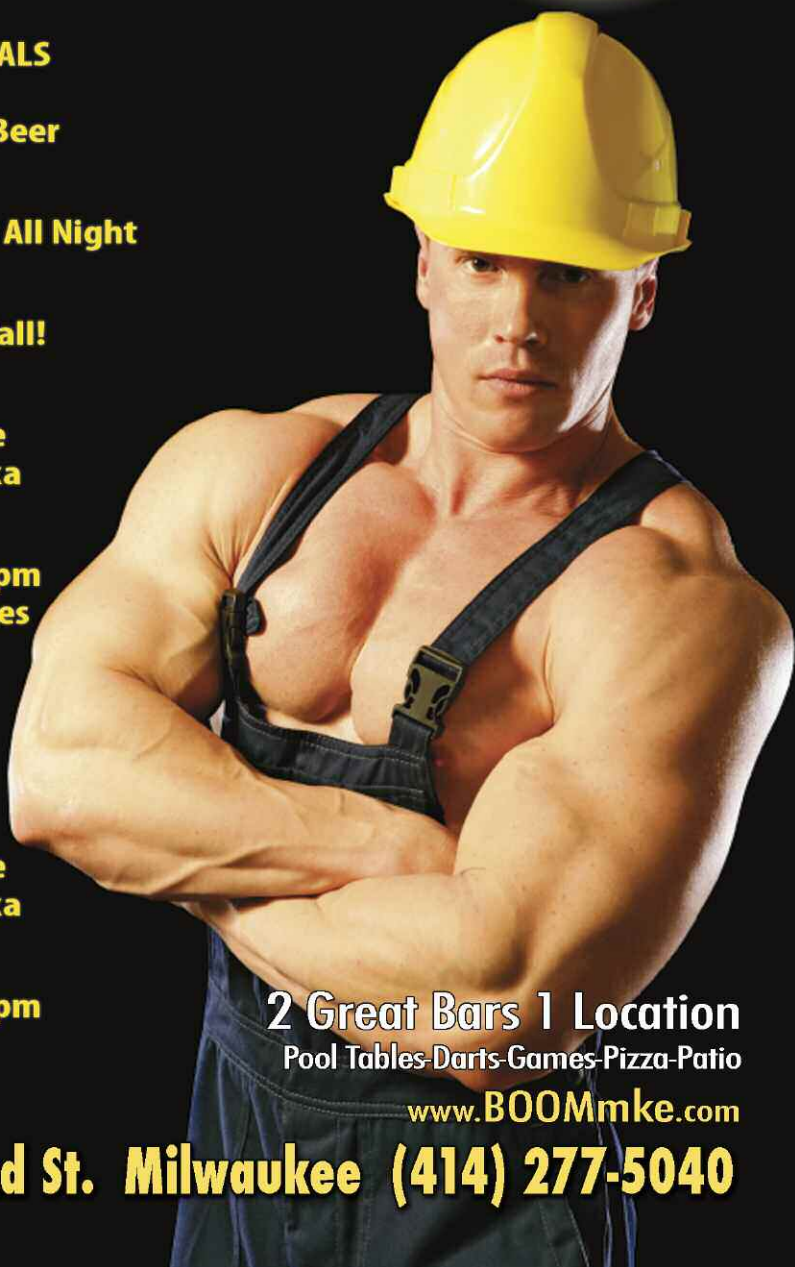

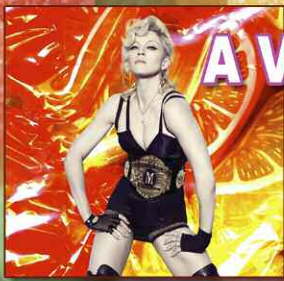

Well July has come and gone and State Fair is here so that can really only mean one thing. . .its AUGUST! Now I'm not really sure why I'm so happy about that, although it may have something to do with the 3 Redbulls I have chugged down in the last 20 mins. But hey, I have to get through this somehow. July was of course my birthday month and thank you to all who helped me celebrate it. Of course I don't know who half of you are thanks to a few bartenders at Boom but I had fun, and rest assured I will get you all! Okay let's get to this month's topic. Dermal anchoring! Dermal anchors have become increasingly popular and unfortunately a lot of shops are not letting everyone know all of the facts with regard to them so without any further ranting and raving from me let's get right into it.

First off let me explain one thing to all of my avid readers, DERMAL ANCHORS ARE NOT PIERCINGS! That's right dermal anchors more closely resemble something called a trans-dermal implant. To translate, it's a piece of material permanently implanted underneath the skin and a part of that material sticks through the skin. More than likely you have seen the guy who has a Mohawk made out of spikes these are trans-dermal implants.

Having said that and hoping you all read the *permanent line* this is permanent. Now there are a number of shops claiming that they can remove these in their shop, While this is true as well as the fact that I can do open heart surgery if I want to, that doesn't make it correct. The way dermal anchors are held in is that your skin actually grows into and through the piece of jewelry making it extremely difficult, not to mention painful, to remove without anesthetic or a scalpel. So keep this in mind if you are thinking about doing this. These WILL have to be surgically removed by a doctor if you ever decide you don't want it. Dermal anchors can also have a very high migration rate. This means they can actually be pushed out of the body. They can migrate for any number of reasons like irritation, bad placement, and just your body not being able to heal it in place. This makes them very risky and they can leave a very deep scar if they do migrate.

Other than that the care for dermal anchors is actually very simple. First keep them bandaged tightly to your skin using a Band-Aid or some other device which will keep the piercing from falling out. Don't use tape though as when you peel off the tape it can pull the anchor out as you remove it. Secondly wash it with anti-bacterial soap about 1-2 times daily. And most importantly leave it alone. 90% of all problems with piercings occur due to irritation. Things like playing with it and sleeping on it will do more damage to any piercing or dermal anchor than not cleaning it. So just leave them alone!

That is about all I can really cram into this one as my brain is starting to stop working lol. If you have any questions about dermal anchors that I have not answered here please drop me an email at Avantgarde@voyager.net. Seems we have a bit of space so let's get to some reader mail.
