

New Years Vodka

Here's a great way to welcome 2011! Full of cranberry flavor, this sweet vodka shot is sure to be a hit at your shin-digs all year long!

1 cup water
1 lb fresh cranberries
2 cups sugar
2 sprigs fresh mint
4 cups vodka

In a large saucepan, bring water, cranberries, sugar and mint to a boil. Boil for 5-10 minutes or until cranberries pop. Stir well; remove from heat and cool. Pour vodka into a container, top with cranberry mixture. Cover well and store in refrigerator for 1 week. Strain cranberries and mint from liquid before serving.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Leave out the mint if you'd like, or consider tossing a handful of cherries in with the cranberries. Serve the vodka with a lemon garnish for a bright and gay presentation.

Poinsettia's Pineapple Vodka

Here's yummy home-flavored liquor from my twin sister, Poinsettia. Thanks for sharing this wonderful beverage with my readers, sis, but sorry, bitch! No free T-shirt for you!

1/2 cup chopped pineapple 2 cups vodka

Set the pineapple in a large container; top with vodka. Seal container and set in the refrigerator for 2 weeks, shaking container from time to time. Strain the vodka and serve.

Poinsettia's Pointers

Replace the pineapple in this recipe with oranges, cherries or lemons and limes. Feel free to keep the fruit and vodka mixture refrigerated for three weeks if you'd like. Add a sprig or two of fresh herbs to really jazz things up.

1 teaspoon flour

½ teaspoon each garlic and onion powders
Dash of dried basil
1 teaspoon dried parsley flakes
2 eggs, beaten
2 tablespoons butter, melted
2 cans (2.8 oz each) French-fried onions
3 tablespoons shredded mozzarella cheese
1 tube (8 oz) refrigerated crescent roll dough
1 jar (8 oz) pizza sauce

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. In a small bowl, combine the flour, garlic and onion powders, basil and parsley flakes. Stir in eggs until combined. Stir in butter. In another bowl (a larger one, this time), combine the fried onions and cheese. Set aside.

Carefully unroll the crescent roll dough. Separate dough into four rectangles. (It sort of comes that way, so this step is a breeze!). Take one rectangle and pinch the seams together. Cut the rectangle into four strips, and then cut each strip in half. (You'll end up with eight pieces.) Repeat with the other three rectangles.

Dip a piece of dough into the egg mixture; then in the onion mixture. Set on a nongreased baking sheet. Repeat with remaining 31 pieces of dough. Bake for 10-12 minutes or until golden brown. Serve with pizza sauce for dipping.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Don't use fresh parsley in this recipe. (It gets sticky in the egg mixture.) A dash is a quick flick of the wrist...no more, no less. Don't have pizza sauce on hand? Use spaghetti sauce instead.

The Center for AIDS Intervention Research (CAIR) in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine at the Medical College of Wisconsin announces openings for two positions in a new National Institutes of Health-funded research project that will develop, implement, and evaluate the effectiveness of community HIV prevention programs for African American men who have sex with men (MSM). The project's objective is to determine if friend-to-friend HIV prevention approaches that work through natural social networks of African American MSM in the community can reduce sexual risk behavior, sexually transmitted diseases, and HIV infection. Both Research Associate positions require extensive experience, knowledge, and understanding of Milwaukee's African American MSM community including settings, ways, and places where African American MSM at high risk for HIV can be reached. For both positions, relevant community experience and involvement with organizations that serve African American MSM are more essential than prior formal research experience. Positions will require frequent field work on evenings, nights, weekends, and during nontraditional hours.

Research Associates will perform activities related to the identification of community settings in Milwaukee for reaching African American MSM and for carrying out community outreach to recruit, interview, and conduct HIV prevention activities with social networks of Black gay or bisexual men. The Research Associates will also be responsible for outreach-based recruitment of friendship groups of African American MSM in community settings, for interviewing participants, and for seeking to engage friends of already recruited men to also enroll in the research. Strong interpersonal communication skills and comfort in community settings where the target population meet are important position requirements. Relevant community experience may substitute for some educational requirements.

Both positions offer competitive salaries and excellent fringe benefits. In addition to a resume or completed job application, we welcome applicants to provide an accompanying letter that describes any additional formal or informal community experience, volunteer work, or involvement with community organizations that serve the targeted population if those experiences are relevant to these positions.

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Dripping Wet 3, Falcon


Many of the most iconic Falcon titles over the years have featured fit and tan California boys poolside, where the real fun didn't begin until the trunks came off. The long-legged blondes might be gone but little else has changed in this third 'Dripping Wet' entry. Director John Bruno has assembled an appealing, hardworking cast of brunettes, including such familiar porn favorites Brandon Lewis and Rod Daily.

First at the pool is relative newcomer Jake Austin. Lounging under sun-drenched skies, his sojourn is disturbed when brawny Parker London playfully spritzes him with water.

Austin reveals an equally playful smile when Parker reveals his veiny erection which quickly gets Austin's full and undivided attention. Austin's smile, not to mention his cock, grow even bigger once Parker gets his lips locked on his own more than ample manmeat. Parker keeps up the tongue-lashing even as he primes Austin's furry nether region with fingers and later with his tongue. Both are completely drenched in sweat by the time Austin's ass is well and thoroughly pummeled. Yet Austin ruthlessly rides Parker's sheathed poker until he can't hold the cum back any longer.

Smoldering brunette Topher DiMaggio is next in the pool, appearing to float the afternoon away. Meanwhile, A.J. Irons, a near doppelganger for Topher, is at watch poolside. In a blink, A.J. is in the pool, lips locked over Topher's fully loaded torpedo. A.J. looks content to spend an eternity making a meal of his partner's primed piston, happily burying the cock down his throat until his nose is tickling Topher's neatly trimmed pubes. In short order A.J. is on a pool chaise, his legs high and wide open with Topher's fingers busily teasing and stretching the dusky sphincter. In the next scene Brandon Lewis and Tucker Scott act like two big kids who just can't get enough of playing around in the lawn sprinkler. Keeping the sprinkler between them, Brandon wastes no time getting Tucker's briefs down and his partner's slender prong at full attention. Brandon is already and quite impressively rock hard when Tucker takes his turn down on his knees. As Brandon face-fucks him mercilessly, Tucker looks like it is all he can he can do to hold on to Brandon's truncheon for dear life. The scene heats up another notch as Brandon lies on his back and Tucker slides down the quivering ramrod, impaling himself just as mercilessly, again and again and again. Once Bran-



don starts plowing him missionary, Tucker pops his creamy cork. Brandon quickly strokes his load onto Tucker's smooth chest.

If you were hoping for a couple of classic long-legged Falcon blondes in the finale, forget it. Instead you'll be treated to the pairing of Robert Axel, a veritable man mountain and Rod Daily, another muscle stud. The hot tub heats up immediately as Rod joins Robert and quickly begins munching his manmeat through the wet shorts. Rod then manfully tears off the shorts, cranks up Robert's legs and starts tonguing the meaty ass cheeks and hairless hole. When it

is his turn at the bat, Robert works Rod's rod with impressive gusto while Rod takes the opportunity to strike a few bodybuilding poses, just in case the neighbors happen to be watching. Rod then takes charge, riding Robert as if riding a massive, mechanical bull. Soon enough Rod gets his chance flex his muscle, plowing Robert at the edge of the pool before each stroke off a load.

Too bad director John Bruno didn't think to stroll through memory lane, airing out some of Falcon's legendary pool pairings of years past. It surely would have been time well spent. Instead, **Dripping Wet 3** is yet another in an increasingly long list of uninspired Falcon offerings. 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
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
