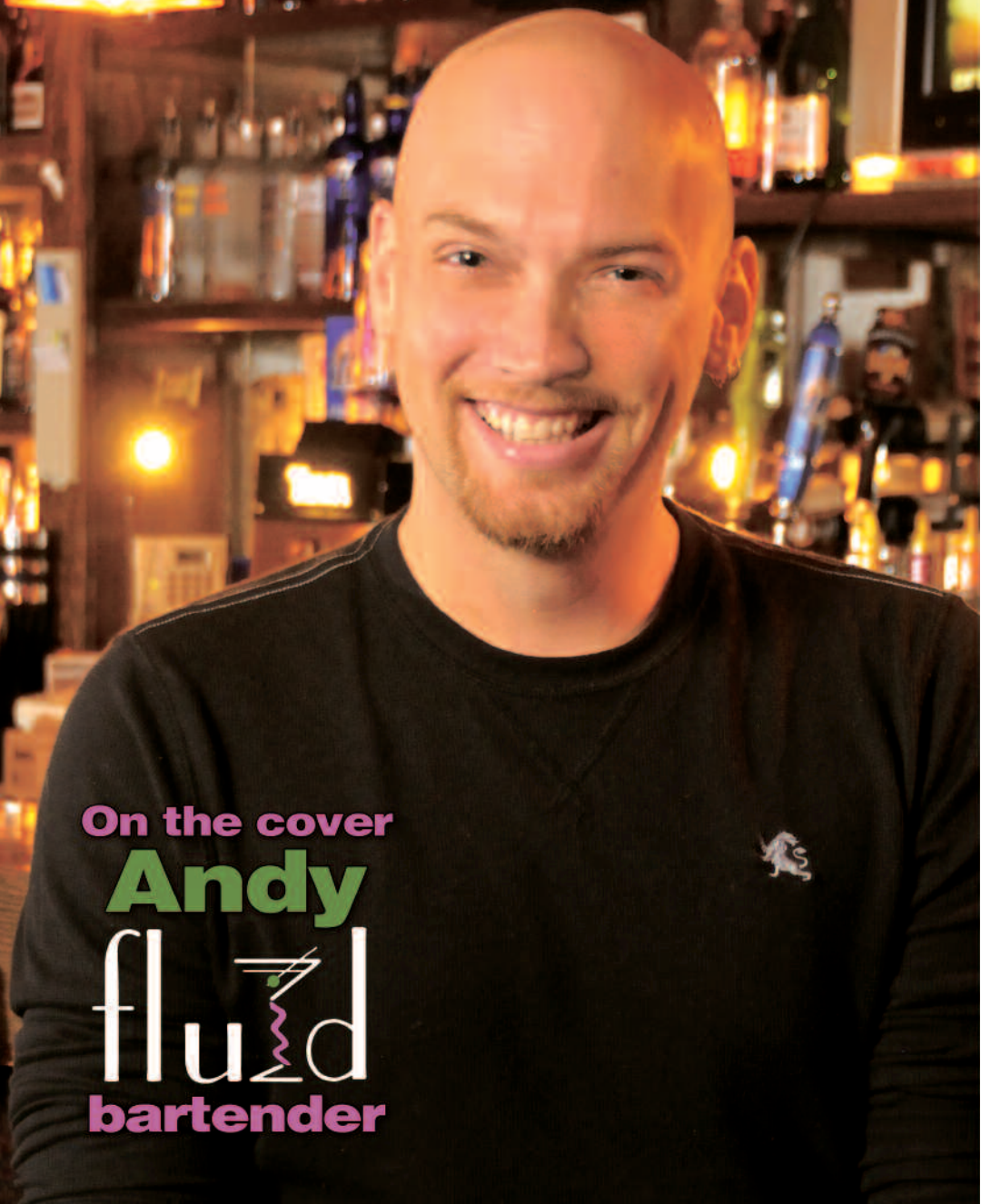

promise to get weekends off to a fun start. So what are you waiting for? Fall is here! Your job is to figure out how you can make the most of it!

Fall is also a great time to hunker down with a satisfying bite to eat. Casseroles and baked goods are perfect nibbles on chilly autumn nights. Whether you're a seasoned cook or a novice, the recipes in my Bitchin' Kitchen this month are perfect for this season. Whip them up and see for yourself. Now, sit down, grab a fork, eat good and shut up!

BITCHIN' TUNA CASSEROLE

I call this a bitchin' casserole not only for its flavor, but because anyone can put the damn thing together in just a few minutes. Featuring lots of cheese and pasta, it's a satisfying meal-in-one that's perfect for a fall dinner!

- 3 cups medium shell pasta, uncooked
- 1 can (6.5 oz) stems and pieces mushrooms, drained
- 1/2 cup frozen peas
- 1 can (10-3/4 oz) condensed cheddar cheese soup
- 1 jar (2 oz) diced pimientos, drained
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1-1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 3 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 can (12 oz) solid white tuna in water, drained
- 1 can (2.8 oz) French-fried onions

Cook pasta according to the package directions. Meanwhile, heat oven to 375 degrees. Spritz a 9x9-inch baking pan with cooking spray. In a large bowl, combine the mushrooms, peas, soup, pimientos, milk, cheeses and tuna. Transfer mixture to baking dish. Bake, covered, for

30 minutes. Carefully remove from oven and top with French-fried onions. Bake, uncovered, for 5-8 minutes.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

Use whatever the heck pasta you have on hand for this recipe. Feel free to try this dish without the tuna, using cooked and cubed chicken instead. Get crazy trying different flavors of cheese, too. One can of French-fried onions may sound like a lot, but you'll be surprised that a 2.8 oz can covers a 9-inch baking pan just right.

DAMN-GOOD CHICKEN HOT BAKE

Here's a casserole that's perfect for using up garden veggies or farmer market finds. Plus, it's damn good. Period.

- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 2 medium yellow summer squash, cubed
- 1/2 pound sliced mushrooms
- 1 large zucchini, cubed
- 3 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 cups cooked and cubed chicken
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 can (10-3/4 oz) condensed cream of chicken and mushroom soup
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1-1/2 cups crushed butter-flavored crackers
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted

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Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Meanwhile, use a large skillet, to sauté the first five ingredients in the oil. In a large bowl, combine the vegetable mixture with the chicken, cheese, soup, sour cream and salt.

Spritz a 11x7-inch baking dish with non-stick cooking spray. Pour vegetable mixture into the baking dish. In a small bowl, combine the cracker crumbs and butter. Sprinkle over the vegetable mixture. Bake, uncovered, for 30 minutes or until mixture is bubbly and topping is golden brown.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

A sleeve of Ritz crackers equals the 1-1/2 cups called for in this recipe. If you're careful, you can break the crackers in the sleeve without making a mess or dirtying a bowl. Leave out the chicken for a great side dish or a meatless main course.

SPANK THE MONKEY BREAD

If you've never had monkey bread before, get your keester to the grocery store and buy the crap for my must-try version. Ideal for experienced bakers and newbies alike, this tasty autumn specialty couldn't be easier. It's a great treat to make with little ones, too!

1 cup pecan halves, divided
¾ sugar
2 teaspoons ground cinnamon

4 cans (7.5 oz each) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits
½ cup butter, melted
½ teaspoon vanilla extract
¾ cup packed brown sugar

Heat over to 350 degrees. Meanwhile, spritz a bundt cake pan with non-stick cooking spray. Sprinkle pan with half of the pecans. In a large resealable storage bag, combine the sugar and cinnamon. Separate the dough into biscuits, and cut each biscuit into four quarters. Set the biscuit pieces into the bag. Seal bag and shake to coat. Set biscuit pieces into pan. Top with remaining pecans. Bake for 45 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 5 minutes, before carefully inverting pan over heat-proof serving plate. Remove pan; serve immediately.

Ruthie's Culinary Clues

I make this recipe with Roundy's brand buttermilk biscuits. I also use a 1-gallon resealable storage bag to mix up the cinnamon sugar. It's easy to cut the biscuits into quarters using kitchen shears. It's perfectly fine that the biscuit pieces are coated to various degrees with the sugar. In fact, it'll make the baked loaf that much more attractive!

Jury Duty, Titanmen

Joe Gage's amazing career continues in **Jury Duty**, a hot new release from TitanMen. A few establishing shots lead viewers to a jury room where a group of six men, well guarded, have the responsibility to determine if a porn video is obscene.

Each of the six briefly introduces themselves. Amongst them are a handyman, a high school principal and a network engineer.

There's not much discussion before the guys wrap it up for the day. Cut to a hotel room where sequestered jurors Scotch Inkom and Bronson Gates are winding down. Scott starts teasing Bronson, his cock out and hardening. Bronson doesn't jump right in but when he does, he positively downs Scotch's rocket, later getting his facing up close and personal with Scotch's sphincter, rubbing his face in for good measure. As his reward, he gets to set a spell on Scotch's tongue and from the sound of things, Scotch has one wicked tongue. So wicked a tongue in fact that Bronson quickly takes matters in hand and oozes out a load while Scotch diddles with his 'taint.

Scott, left ramrod hard, is quick to his feet to answer a knock at the door. Enter Sven Norse who, initially at least, seems puzzled at what he's walked in on. Not for long. By the time Scotch is on his knees, Sven is amply ready for action. Gage perfectly captures Sven smoothly feeding his erection to Scotch, while Bronson watches intently in the background.

Being a hotel room, there's a handy bed to be had and Scotch is quick to surrender to a pummeling by Sven's sheathed weapon, Bronson is willing to bide his time. Sven eventually calls Bronson over. After plowing the balding silver daddy, briefly, Sven's on his back and spread wide as Scotch mounts him. Again, Bronson is content to watch, coaxing out another load solo on the couch while Scotch creams over Sven's cock.

After Gage's Hitchcockian cameo, jury foreman Dirk Caber gets pulled into the utility room by bearded security guard Roman Wright. Roman tells Dirk he's got to 'fuck or fight.' Tough choice. Dirk might look uncertain but in the blink of an eye he's hard and swallowing the guard's meat like there's no tomorrow. When it is his turn, Roman manfully downs Dirk's dagger, relentlessly engulfing the throbbing manmeat. With Dirk due back from lunch, there's only time for each to stroke out a load, Dirk's an impressive gusher.

Before they can reach a decision, the jury decides they actually need to see the filth for themselves. As they watch, Bronson recognize a dick on the screen as David Anthony's. Tension mounts as David slowly unzips and offers up his curved truncheon for a thorough examination of the oral variety. Sven is the first but definitely not the



last on his knees to offer a spit polish. For his part, David, legs spread, is content to allow each to worship his monster cock. Foreman Dirk proves particularly adept at deep-throating. This final jury room scene continues as Ethan moves on to the next stud, this time kneeling before Bronson. Then Ethan hops onto the conference, spreads wide and whimpers like a bitch in heat as the bald daddy plows him deep and steady.

Gage saves the best and biggest for last with a pairing of horse-hung David Anthony and a not too shabby Sven Norse. As Sven struggles to swallow more than a few inches, Ethan's wanders back into the action, lubing up and sliding right into Sven's back entrance easy as he pleases. Still Sven slobbers mightily on David's primed plunger until David turns Ethan into the meat of a sweaty fuck-sandwich. Ethan gamely pummels Sven, all the while expertly riding David's sheathed erection. Disappointingly, the scene wraps up with the three jurors stroking their massive members. Both David and Sven pop off both immediately and impressively. Lagging behind, Ethan has to play catch-up, fisting David's solid saber until he's finally able to jizz.

Legendary pornmeister Joe Gage is happily behind the camera and if **Jury Duty** is not quite amongst his best, it is still damn good. Gage has an eye for picking sexy, everyday sorts of guys. Dirk's geeky glasses are a perfect touch. With a little editing, the final scene would have been off the charts. Horse hung David Anthony is a total stud.

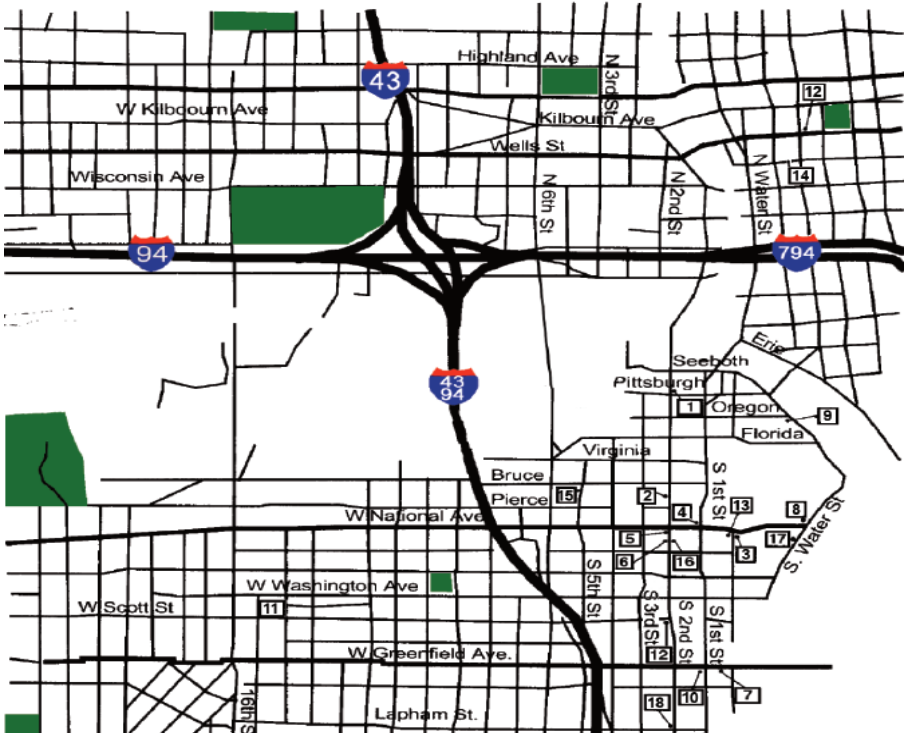
