CC: Some of the same great characters will be back - such as Barbra Streisand. Last year I thought I'd give Babs a rest, but my audiences were not as eager to let her go. I soon found myself back in Barbra garb and wig. She's definitely a crowd pleaser and probably the largest gay icon.

Eunice P. Hole, my own creation and the overall crowd favorite, will be back in next year's tour with more of her wacky antics. She has become the 'mascot' of the CC Rae Show.

After six years of impersonating PeeWee and the Church Lady, I've decided to put them to rest. I feel burned out on these characters....it's time to move on. They will be replaced with amusing new characters such as Morticia Addams (from the Addams Family), Linda Richman (from SNL's Coffee Talk) and some new character creations of my own which I'm not ready to divulge, including my new puppetry contraption.

QUEST: As you travel the country, do you notice a difference in your audiences from state to state?

CC: Oh, yes! It also varies from city to city and club to club. I notice that the smaller the town, the more appreciative the audience. It also depends on the type of clientele. Although the enthusiasm varies from place to place, I generally get a terrific response to the show. Touring has been a very wonderful experience! QUEST: With your third year of touring about to begin, can you look back at the beginning of your career and share some thoughts?

your career and share some thoughts?

CC: I began by entering lip sync contests in Green Bay and Appleton, Wisconsin. Comedy was my first choice; dance my second; female impersonations my third. I was never interested in "drag" and only persued it because I found myself envious of the attention female impersonators were getting. I dared myself to be as good at it as the others, perhaps even better. In most ways, I think I've succeeded, although there's always room for improvement. For example, I'm still learning about make-up. Some impersonators can complete their make-up job in 20-30 minutes. It still takes me a whole hour to finish.

QUEST: Thinking back to the beginning of your career, did you have any idea you would become as successful as you have?

CC: Not a clue! If someone would have told me

CC: Not a clue! If someone would have told me this is how it would eventually be, I would have laughed in their face. When I began touring I really had to 'pound the pavement' to get book-

ings. Now the clubs are calling me before I can get to them. It's a great feeling.

QUEST: Is there anyone you would consider 'most influential' in helping you get started? CC: Jim Suthers (a Wisconsin native, now living in L.A.). I learned a great deal from Jim about make-up, props and set building, as well as writing monologue material. He was a great teacher.

QUEST says quite plainly: We believe The CC Rae Show is unique, hot, hilarious, fast-paced, simply wonderful....and an excellent booking for any club in the country. It can be a special treat for patrons and a very profitable venture for the club.



### CC RAE PLANS AN ALL NEW 1995-96 COMEDY/VARIETY SHOW!

By the end of this year, national touring star and Wisconsin native, CC Rae, will have taken his show to 42 of the contiguous United States.
