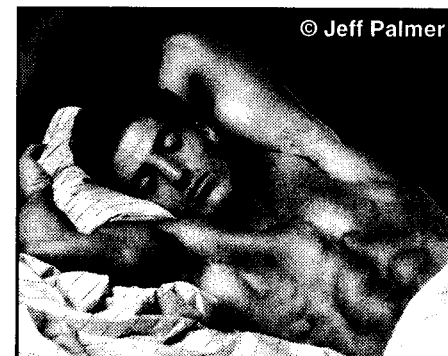
South California Fires Delay

Benefit Calendar Delivery

(But No Delays in Donations)

Flames came to within 25 feet of the Aids Benefit Calendar offices on October 21, but nothing was damaged and no one was hurt. Partners Joe Pascale and Jeff Palmer kept the flames at bay with garden hoses and shovels. "We packed up the computer, the Calendars, Calendar orders, tax papers and receipts, some personal photos and our cat and took them to the top of the hill where they would be safe, then came back down and fought the fire!" relates Jeff Palmer. "We never really thought of leaving the property." Telephone service and electric power were off for nearly one week which made for great difficulties and caused some delays in processing and shipping Calendars, but the fires didn't stop the contributions from reaching agencies that provide direct service to people with HIV and AIDS. The first two recipients of proceeds from the 1997 Calendar are Fraternity House, a residential home in northern San Diego County and Positive Directions, a full service agency in Boston, Mass.

The 11 x 22 month-at-a-glance Calendar features thirteen photographic images including powerful and beautiful images of men alone and men



with men -- sensual and erotic, but non-sexual -- all celebrating the beauty of men and male couples. Proceeds from the sale of the Calendar are distributed to agencies across the country that provide direct services to people living with HIV and AIDS. More than \$350,000 has been distributed since the first Calendar issue in 1990.

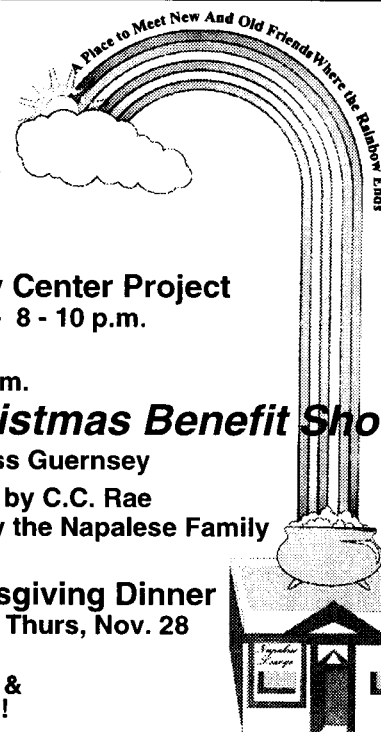

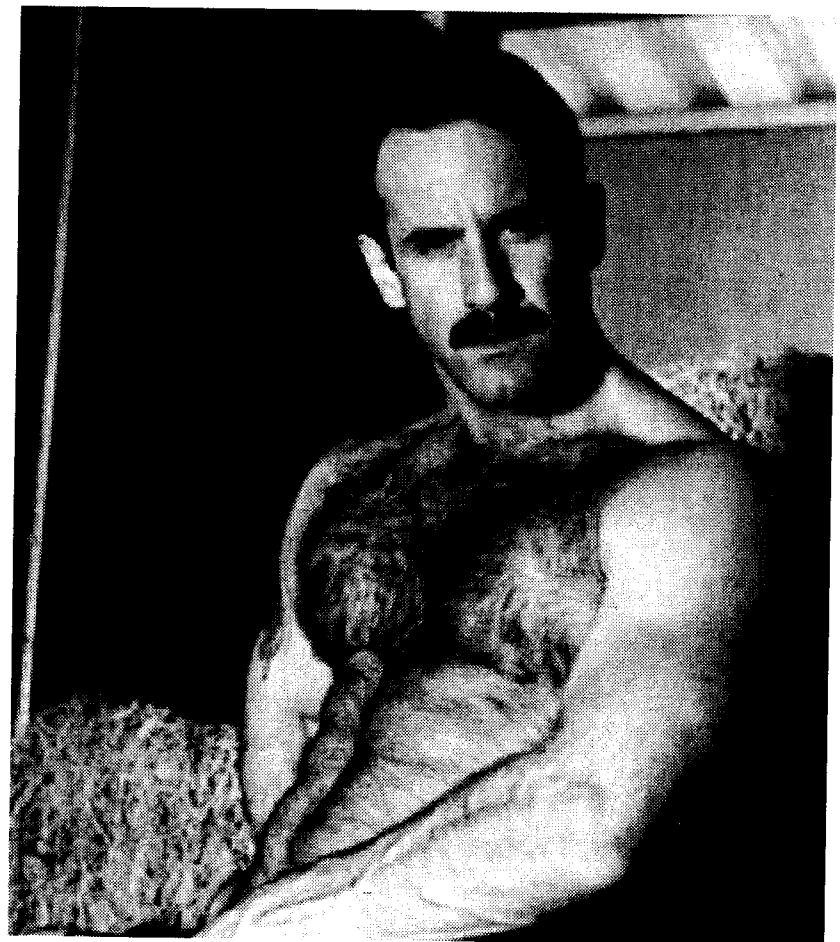
