

Book in Review

Wonder Bread and Ecstasy: The Life and Death of Joey Stefano by Charles Isherwood. Alyson Publications, Los Angeles, CA 90078. Published in 1996, 209 pages Softcover.

On the back cover of the book we read: Drugs, sex, and unbridled ambition: these were the main ingredients in the lethal cocktail that killed gay pom's brightest star, Joey Stefano. As pornography's most marketable gay face and body, he was filmed having sex in more than 35 hardcore videos, danced an unforgettable striptease in clubs across America and Europe, and hustled his way through thousands of dollars paid to him by clients around the globe. But none of this filled the void inside Nicholas Iacona, a.k.a. Joey Stefano. From his childhood in the country's heartland to his tragic rise and fall

in Los Angeles' dark and dangerous world of gay porn, Wonder Bread and Ecstasy paints a grim portrait of an American life gone berserk." Nicholas Anthony Iacona, Jr. was born on New Year's day in 1968 in Philadelphia. Joey Stefano a name given by two people; Catalina Studios' Chris Mann suggested the surname. He thought Iacona resembled a Catalina gay porn star Tony Stefano. Chi Chi LaRue gave Iacona his new fist name, Joey. Why the title Wonder Bread and Ecstasy? Wonder Bread was Joey's favorite food. Stefano never had a car or a home, he had no concerns about money, and simple taste


in food. He'd call up Pink Dot, a market chain that delivered basic food stuffs, and order the Stefano staples: Wonder Bread, peanut butter and jelly Haagen-Dazs ice cream, and a carton of cigarettes. Ecstasy is an amphetamine-like drug also known as MDMA. It provides an euphoric high that can last for a couple of hours, characterized by both a heightened sense of self and a feeling of connection with other people; communications become imperative. Joey was deeply addicted to Ecstasy. However, when Joey died of a drug overdose at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center after being found unconscious at the seedy Hollywood La Brea Motel, his 26 year old body was shot through with a lethal cocktail of assorted drugs: cocaine, morphine, heroin, and ketamine (Special K - an anesthetic). He learned in late 1990 that he was HIV positive. He was described by friends as being sexually compulsive, never having safe sex, and always sharing needles. The author states on page 58 "his arrival as a gay porn superstar was a phenomenon the industry hadn't seen before for a simple, significant reason: He was a 'bottom'- the passive performer in anal sex, the active one in oral. The top rung of the industry had traditionally been occupied exclusively by 'tops,' men whose machismo would theoretically have been compromised by more versatile screen behavior. They dominated their partners; they were served. It was believed that that was

the way gay porn audience like its stars-remote, superior, and equivocally 'masculine.'

Indeed, half of the mystique of stars such as Jeff Stryker, Rex Chandler, and Ryan Idol is not just that they're masculine but that they are straight. Whether in fact they are or not is irrelevant, the image they project is what they are selling, and they and their handlers chose to sell an image of quasi™heterosexuality." On page 60, the author goes on to say: "there is considerable evidence, anecdotal though it is, that many gay men find straight men more attractive than men who are perceptibly gay. Witness, for example, the ubiquity of the term 'straight acting' as a quality sought in respondents to personal ads. One can assess the appeal of straight men in gay erotica by looking at the thematic breakdown of films in the Adam Gay Video 1991 Directory. Professions receiving multiple depiction in

gay videos include athletes (71), construction workers (27), cops (19), cowboys (15), farmers (6), mechanics (9), military men (17), movers and haulers (5), repairmen (9) and men in uniform (25). Generally speaking, these are trades not noted for their gay-friendliness. It needs to be added that there are no listings for films depicting occupations traditionally associated with gay men...interior decorators, fashion designers, and hair dressers...." Isherwood does not analyze Stefano's life much in detail, although he provides some fascinating facts and insights. He describes Iacona as running

away from home at sixteen, fleeing to Manhattan, where he turned tricks for food and drugs. Iacona is described as getting into the porn business to get attention, not money. The author says Iacona could not find fulfillment in the attention he got through inter-personal relationships, so he tried to replace them with the attention he got from being the object of desire of thousands of men. On page 40 Stefano describes his type as "real butch, rough, manly, dominate men. I like older guys." The author's insight is that the attention paid to Joey Stefano initially gave a boost to Nick Iacona's selfesteem, but eventually it became a drain on it. The more people fawned over Joey Stefano, the less valuable Nick Iacona seemed to become. In the last year of his life, Stefano describes himself as: "No job. No money. No self-esteem. No confidence. All I have is my looks and body and that's not working anymore. I feel washed-up. Drug problem. Hate life. HIV-positive!" Stefano goes on to say that he felt like an old hooker with a bad drug habit. He died by overdose because he could not hide his terrible hunger for oblivion, his desire to escape the world as often as possible and as long as possible. This is a good book that helps us to understand the gay porn industry and how it destroyed one of its biggest



December 1, 1987 (10 years ago this week): Celebrated writer James Baldwin dies in France.

Who was James Baldwin?

"I've loved a few men and I've loved a few women." That's how noted African-American writer James Baldwin once characterized his sexuality. Baldwin - who died ten years ago this week - never embraced the word "gay," though he wrote four novels that stand at the forefront of gay literature.

Baldwin was born in Harlem in 1924 to a single mother. When he was three, she married a Pentecostal preacher. Religion was an early and powerful influence on Baldwin, who used it as an escape from his abusive stepfather. Baldwin became a preacher himself at the age of fourteen, and his first novel, Go Tell It on the Mountain (1953), fictionalized his youthful career as a popular and talented orator in a Harlem congregation.

The other strong influence on Baldwin's life and writing was his sexual orientation, about which he expressed confusion at an early age. Friends and family members guessed his sexuality before Baldwin himself did. His younger brother told an interviewer after Baldwin became famous, "Honey, I knew when Jimmy was a little boy. Of course we just knew."

Two of Baldwin's early mentors were black gay men - the poet Countee Cullen, who taught him in high school; and Beauford Delaney, a painter whom Baldwin met in 1940. For many years Delaney was the most important person in Baldwin's life. Delaney introduced him to music, art, and literature, as well as to the gay artistic circles of Manhattan. Whether or not he also introduced him to sex, Baldwin never said. After his informal education with Delaney, Baldwin noted. "Then I could really write."

Living in Greenwich Village in the 1940s and working odd jobs, Baldwin launched his writing career, distinguishing himself as a critic and commentator for such publications as The Nation, Commentary, and The Partisan Review. To his disappointment, Baldwin found that even in the supposedly "bohemian" and "free-thinking" Village, the fact that he was both black and queer made him a frequent target of harassment. In 1948, sick of American racism and homophobia and with just \$40 to his name, Baldwin moved to Paris to start over. "It wasn't so much a matter of choosing France," he later told an interviewer, "as it was a matter of getting out of America."

In doing so, Baldwin joined a long of line of expatriate queer American literati - such as Natalie Barney and Gertrude Stein - who found France a more welcome home for their literary and personal

persuits.

In Paris, Baldwin met "all kinds of very different people," including Lucien Happersberger, a young Swiss who became his great love and lifelong friend. "I starved in Paris for a while,"

Baldwin wrote in later years, but he learned that he could find love - a goal he had found elusive in the United States. Happersberger, however eager to sample the joys of gay sex with his

friend, didn't share Baldwin's dream of romantic love between men. Happersberger eventually married a woman and had a son whom he, ironically,

Unrequited love makes good material, and the experience with Happersberger inspired Baldwin creatively. His second novel, Giovanni's Room (1956), was a portrait of gay male love and abandonment that repulsed both his editor, who rejected the manuscript, and his agent, who advised him to burn it. It wasn't that the novel was sexually explicit, which it wasn't, but that Baldwin dared to consider a gay relationship an acceptable topic for fiction. The other shocker was that Baldwin's narrator was white at a time when such racial lines were rarely crossed. The novel eventually found a publisher in England and then in the United States. Despite all the barriers, Giovanni's Room was hailed by critics in this country as a masterpiece.

Baldwin went on to write three more novels with gay or bisexual main characters. Another Country (1961), a bestseller, put forth the credo of Baldwin's life and career - that love can't be restricted by race or gender. Tell Me How Long the Train's Been Gone (1968) and Just Above My Head (1979) also depicted gay relationships in a complex, sympathetic, and unapologetic way, foreshadowing the work of today's out gay novelists.

After his death from a stroke on December 1, 1987, Baldwin's body was brought back to New York for a star-studded funeral attended by 5,000 people. A tribute from his family, printed in a pamphlet and distributed among the mourners, recalled Baldwin's membership in "the society of the human heart." That euphemism is evocative of some of the other non-labels the writer used for his sexuality during his lifetime. Despite the positive queer content of his novels, Baldwin consistently rejected both the labels "gay" and "bisexual." He and his lovers, he told a reporter in 1984, were simply people who "moved in the world." Though he lived long enough to witness the many gains of the gay liberation movement, he took no part in it and maintained until the end of his life that his sexuality was no one's business but his own and God's.
