

the future. However, there several tools that can be used with clairvoyance to clarify and enhance the readings.

Tarot cards are an excellent way to clarify readings. There are 78 cards in a deck which include the 22 Major Arcana and 56 Minor cards. The first approach allows us to see that the trumps are a collection of qualities and attitudes which are most valuable for living. In the Major Arcana, a person will find creativity, peace, positive action and a sense of personal power. These specific cards are a reading. We must keep things in perspectreated as the progress of an individual on the tive and remember that these form only one path of enlightenment

Major Arcana as a sequence which is divided in some way. Some see it as two halves with the break coming at the Wheel of Fortune. Thus, the first half deals with the outer concerns of life, such as work/career, marriage/relationships, and the achievement of success and power. At a certain point in our lives we will realize the limitations of such things and turn inward on a a quest for self-knowledge. Thus, self-knowledge is represented in the second half of the deck.

Inner awareness is brought out in the second half of the deck. We live in a time which looks primarily at the self. For many individuals, psychology has replaced religion in life and psychology deals with personal issues. The Tarot reminds us of concerns outside ourselves which are necessary so as to be met with complete success.

In a Tarot reading, we are shown how to deal with specific issues in our personal lives This includes out emotions where we find ourselves at the heights of bliss and the depths of despair. In a reading, you are allowed the opportunity to bring both bliss and despair into the picture. Thus you are guided through the negatives and the positives.

The Minor deck consists of four suits: Wands, (Clubs), Cups, (Hearts), Swords, (Spades), Pentacles, (Diamonds). Each suit has fourteen cards: Ace through 10, plus Page. Knight, Queen, and King. The four suits structure themselves around the concept o the four elements: Earth, Air, Fire, and Water

Wands belong to the element of Fire. The Wands thus show us scenes of electricity. experience, action and optimism. All of these qualities are associated with Fire and fiery personalities.

Cups belong to Water, which flows rather

Clairvoyance is one form used to see into than forces, giving way rather than resisting. Cups cards show scenes of love and gentleness. It is also a sign of fantasy and inspiration when Cups come up in a reading. Fire brings about power, and Water brings about a sense of passiveness where individuals are unable to take a strong course of direction.

Swords are the most complex of the Tarot Cards. They show sorrow and pain, but also analysis and truth. They signify the pains and defeats life tends to inflict on us, and for this reason, many people find them frightening in part of our lives. We can learn a great deal There are some readers who interpret the from the negative part of these cards, so there is no real need to be fearful of them.

Pentacles are derived from the element Earth. The other suites symbolize states of mind or types of experiences. The Pentacles refer to the outside world. Thus they symbolize money, nature, career, and prosperity. Pentacles prefer society to adventure, discipline and hard work to gain a sense of freedom. Through Pentacles you will see that

there is satisfaction to be gained from creating something very real in our own worlds. When Pentacles appear in a reading, the person being read will enjoy the magic which is hidden within nature and ordinary life.

In summary, Wands and Cups tend to show more positive experiences, while Swords and Pentacles denote the more difficult aspects of life. Wands and Pentacles deal with practical concerns, while Cups and Swords depict the emotional side of things in our lives.

I did a short reading on someone who had the eight of Swords in the past, the two of Wands in the present and the Ace of Pentacles in the future. This person felt that there were limitations and restrictions

around him and he didn't know how to break free from this. He then had to take a strong look at what he had accomplished in his life. and he needed to make the plans necessary for him to succeed. Once he was able to lay the ground plans for what was yet to be, he found that he would be met with complete success, personally, professionally and financially.



McDonough, living with HIV for over three years, is a client and volunteer at AIDS Resource Center of Wisconsin. Green Bay (Center Project).

The Task Force meets quarterly. UN Headquarters in New York, Uganda and Argentina are scheduled for this year.




of Grass, Whitman repeatedly changed pronouns from "he" to "she." The "man who wandered with me" in his New Orleans poem became in a revised version "a woman I casually met there who detain'd me for love of me." Whitman invented a heterosexual history for himself, complete with six illegitimate children. though there is absolutely no evidence to support his claims.

In fact, the evidence all points to Whitman's intimacy with men and boys. Peter Doyle, a former Confederate soldier whom Whitman met while living and working in Washington, D.C. during and after the Civil War, is perhaps the best known of his "camarados," as he referred to his companions. "Our affection is quite an affair, quite romantic," Whitman wrote home. Forty years later, Doyle remembered their chance meeting on a streetcar as love at first sight: "We were familiar at once - I put my hand on his knee - we understood."

In his final years, incapacitated by a stroke, Whitman relied on first a teenage, live-in "special friend." Bill Duckett, and then a personal secretary. Horace Traubel. He held court at his row house in Camden, New Jersey, greeting such well-known admirers as Oscar Wilde and Edward Carpenter. Though Whitman continued until his death to be evasive about his sexuality, more openly gay poets like Carpenter, who were inspired by Whitman's homoeroticism, had few doubts about the older man's sexual leanings. "Walt Whitman," Carpenter wrote, "was before all a lover of the Male. His thought turned toward men first and foremost, and it is no good disguising that fact."

March 26, 1892 (106 years ago this month): Poet Walt Whitman dies in Camden, New Jersey.

Who was Walt Whitman?

Walt Whitman, the preeminent nineteenth-century American poet, is sometimes called the "good gray poet," because as an older man he sported a flowing white beard and hair. But we might also dub him the "good gay poet," since his homoerotic poems were early celebrations of love between men and his intimate relationships were all with men and boys.

Whitman was born in 1819 near Huntington, New York, a town on Long Island. His family moved a lot during Whitman's childhood, as his father, who was beset by financial problems, tried his hand at everything from farming to construction. Whitman left school at age 11 to help support his family by apprenticing to a newspaper printer.

When he was 17, the mostly self-taught Whitman began a brief career as a teacher, taking several short-term positions in towns around Huntington. Though most sources are vague about why he left teaching four years later, one recent biographer, David Reynolds. found evidence that Whitman may have made advances toward his male students and been driven out of the profession.

Whitman discovered a second, more lasting career, in journalism, and in 1838 founded a weekly newspaper, The Long Islander, which is still is circulation 160 years later and boasts "Founded by Walt Whitman" on its masthead. For the next few decades, Whitman held editorial positions at seven different newspapers, mostly in New York City but also in New Orleans, and he always wrote as an outspoken advocate of social, economic, and political reform.

But it was his poetry that secured him a place in American history. His first collection, Leaves of Grass, was published in 1855 as a slim volume of 90 pages, which he himself set into type at a Brooklyn print shop. Always a perfectionist, Whitman revised and republished the book eight times during his life. The 1860 edition is the most significant for gay readers, because it contains the original "Calamus" cycle of poems, which extol male camaraderie or "adhesiveness," as Whitman called it. "I believe," he wrote in one of these poems, "the main purport of America is to found a new ideal of manly love...."

While many of the Calamus poems use vague words like "brotherly," "the man I love," and "comrade," it's hard to mistake the meaning behind some of the more erotic ones. In "Loafe with Me Upon the Grass," Whitman reminisced about "... how we once lay, such a transparent summer morning;/How you settled your head athwart my hips, and gently turned over upon me, ..." The poems are filled with samesex longing, as in "Once I Passed Through a Populous City," written about his sojourn in New Orleans: "I remember only the man who wandered with me, there for love of me,/Day by day and night by night, we were together...."


At the time that Whitman wrote these poems, homosexuality as an identity and a sexual orientation did not quite exist. It wasn't until the late 1800s that doctors and psychiatrists became interested in samesex desire and began to theorize about it as an "inversion" of proper, man-woman desire. What once passed in Whitman's poems as nonsexual, brotherly devotion thus became a sexual "abnormality" several decades after they were written. In subsequent editions of Leaves

You can buy a rubber vest with patch, MR T-shirts and other assorted rubber goods found in the newsletter. You get invited to pay to play parties (usually \$20.00) which allows you to invite guests, who also must pay, Club nights, beer bust all designed to build the treasury. With almost 200 members and one hell of a following, this could build into a nice career.

MIBCI, is a club run by a boot man for boot men, Scotty/Vancouver. Annual membership fee of \$32.00 US, which gets you a very respectable quarterly magizine with notice of events, boot related articles, fantasy tales and art, personal ads and the like. You can also buy T shirts and a few other related items. This group also has a very sizeable membership spread out on five continents that I know of. Web site

CBMI, owned and operated by a boot man David/Palm Springs, for bootmen, has no dues, for that matter, no nothing. If you are into boots, you just need a computer before you ask David to put you on the E mail list. This site is very extensive with lots of related pictures and bios.

There are many more, catering to many different fetishes, but the above should give you a range of the way they are run or controlled.


