PAST/OUT

25 years ago a lesbian couple in Kansas City launched Naiad Press.

What is the history of Naiad Press?

In January 1973, Barbara Grier and Donna McBride, a young lesbian couple from Kansas City, Missouri, had only one manuscript and a \$2,000 loan from friends with which to start a publishing company. Twenty-five years later, that company, Naiad Press, is the country's largest, most successful, and oldest lesbian publisher, with almost 400 books to its credit and annual revenues approaching two million dollars. Its name - which means "water nymph" - has become, in Grier's words, "a synonym for lesbian."

Grier and McBride met and fell in love in 1972. McBride was working as a librarian, and Grier was a bill collector by day and editor of the Daughters of Bilitis lesbian journal, *The Ladder*, by night. Grier had joined that publication's staff in 1956, after having an epiphany the first time she saw the journal. "I remember thinking," Grier said recently, "'This is what I'm going to do for the rest of my life.'" *The Ladder* folded in 1972, but Grier and McBride were soon approached by friends - one of whom was novelist Sarah Aldridge - with the idea of starting a lesbian publishing company.

With money from Aldridge and her lover and the hard work of Grier and McBride, Naiad Press published its first title in 1973 - Aldridge's novel, *The Latecomer*, the start of a long line of Naiad romances. At a time when only a handful of women's bookstores existed, Naiad relied heavily on mail orders. Naiad inherited the mailing list of *The Ladder*, which had grown from 150 subscribers in 1956 to 3,800 at its demise, and Grier and McBride did four mailings in the first year, marketing their one and only book. The income from the mailings kept the press going. About 500 *Ladder* subscribers still receive Naiad's catalog, along with more than 25,000 other lesbians. And according to Grier, many of those 500 original subscribers own everything the publishing company ever published.

From the beginning, Naiad had no trouble finding manuscripts to publish. Many lesbian writers approached the company with their novels, and Grier also used her prior experience as a "skip tracer" (a trade term for bill collector) to track down lesbian novelists of the past whose work she admired. That way, the novels of Ann Bannon and Gale Wilhelm got second lives as Naiad reprints.

In 1980, Grier and McBride relocated to Florida, where they both continued to hold down full-time jobs while operating Naiad out of their home. "We got up at five a.m.," Grier recalled, "and Donna would go out to pack books in an unheated shed while I made breakfast." After work, they would do Naiad business until 10:30 at night. It wasn't until 1982 that Grier took a leap of faith and quit her day job, and McBride followed suit six months later. There was a recession that year, and Grier and McBride held on through several months with no income. But because the women were now able to devote all their time to the press, the company flourished.

A succession of popular titles ensured Naiad's future. Some of the press's early bestsellers are now lesbian classics, like Jane Rule's *Outlander* and Sheila Ortiz Taylor's *Faultline*. In 1982, while on a book tour with one of their authors, Grier met "a shy,

tall woman with a white Afro," who came up to her in Los Angeles's Sisterhood Bookstore and said she had a novel to submit. Grier was tired and grouchy and snapped, "Tell me, does anything happen in this novel?" The woman turned out to be Katherine V. Forrest, and the book was *Curious Wine*, which sold out its first print run of 8,500 copies in less than a month. Forrest went on to become a Naiad superstar.

But the title that really established Naiad was *Lesbian Nuns* (1985), a nonfiction book about life behind convent walls that made Naiad and authors Rosemary Kurb and Nancy Manahan \$500,000, a remarkable sum in small publishing. The book was reviewed in everything from the *Navaho Times* to the *New York Times*, and was translated into many languages. Bette Midler held a copy of it on screen in the movie "Down and Out in Beverly Hills." Naiad could finally move its office out of Grier and McBride's house and into a separate building, and the company thrived while many other women's presses failed.

Today, Grier attributes Naiad's long life to other factors, too. The press has diversified its list to include videos and books on tape, and Grier, an aggressive marketer, has successfully sold foreign rights for many of its books. Most importantly, she says, "we genuinely like what we're doing. And I have an absolute inability not to win."

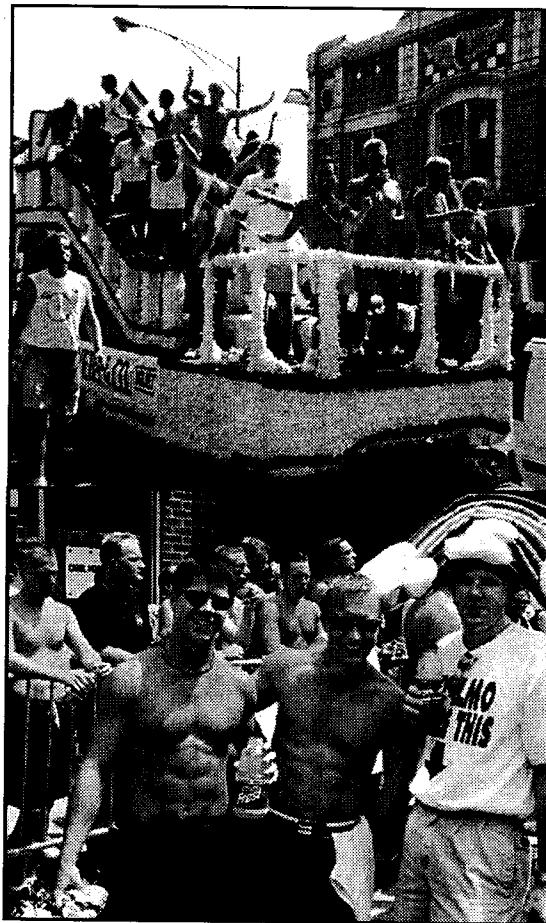

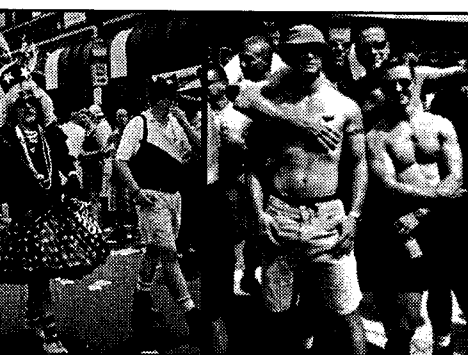

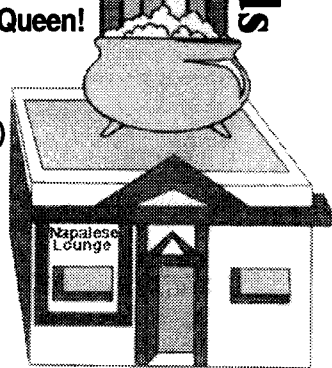

LEARNING TO CONFRONT WITH CARE

There are several of my callers who call who are in conflict with others around them, as well as being in conflict with their own wants, needs and desires. There are a few things which I like to convey to them in order that they are able to handle the situation without allowing the situation to control them. At this time, I would like to share some of my thoughts with you on confrontations, in hopes that it will help anyone who is in conflict with others or themselves.

Life without confrontation is direction less, aimless, passive. When unchallenged, we as human beings tend to drift, to wander or to stagnate. Actually, confrontation is a gift.

Confrontation is necessary stimulation to jog one out of mediocrity or to prod on back from extremes. Confrontation is an art to be learned.

To affront is easy. Examples of being caustic, critical, cutting are available in abundance. "I don't need any lessons to learn how to tell people off. I do it in my sleep."

To confront is difficult. Models for being candid, clear, confrontive without being uncaring are unusual if not truly rare. "I could use some help in learning how to confront in a way that doesn't frustrate or alienate."

The ability to offer another a maximum amount of information about their part in relationship with a minimum amount of treat to that relationship is a skill to be learned bit upon bit, new response added to old response.

Giving another feedback on he/she is coming on can be surprisingly simple when it is offered in context of caring, supportive acceptance; it can be astoundingly difficult when interpreted as insensitive, non-supportive rejection.

Hearing confrontation from another is no problem when one is certain that the other respects, values, cares in spite of all differences; but when respect is unclear and caring is unexpressed, one can feel fed up with another's feedback before it even develops.

Caring come first, confrontation follows. A context of caring can be created when a person is truly for another, genuinely concerned about another, authentically related to another. The content of such caring is, however, not a blank check approval of the other. The core of

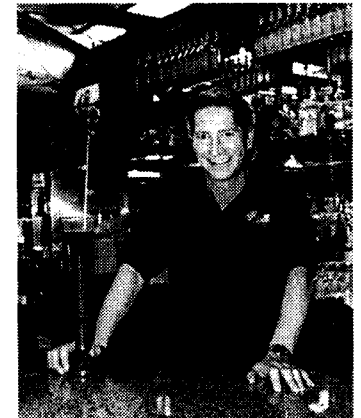

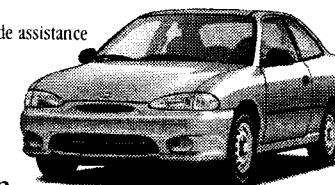

The business was best known for the Bombay Bicycle Club until the owners closed most of their Midwest locations.

The new facility, which will have a restaurant and bar, will be called Club 5, with the dance club known as Planet Q; the name for the mens bar is still being debated. The dance club will provide live entertainment, shows, etc. There will be a DJ 7 nights a week bringing you the best dance music and videos available. This place will provide a place for all Gays and Lesbians.

The mens bar will provide a bar for the gay men, the Leather/Levi community, Unicorns of Madison meetings & Clubs nights, special events, etc.

The restaurant will serve lunch and dinner 7 days a week, and will be open after bar on Fridays & Saturdays till 3:30 am; maybe Thursdays and Sundays, too, as we see how things will work.

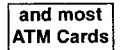

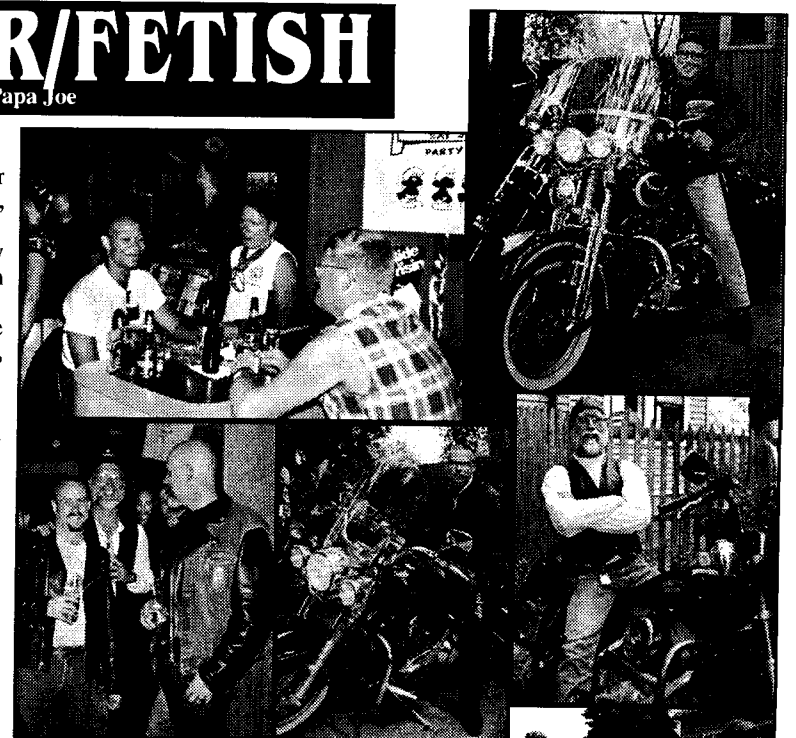

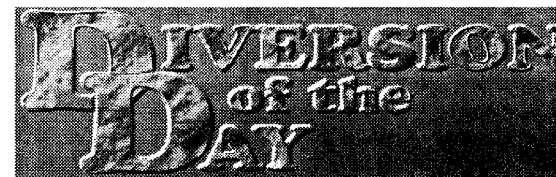
