

The biggest change that Didrikson made in her image was marrying George Zaharias, a professional wrestler, in 1938. Zaharias retired from wrestling the following year to manage his wife's career fulltime. Over the next decade, Didrikson Zaharias became one of the most successful and popular figures in women's golf. Always confident, she played to the gallery, often making jokes about her own game. "I hit it straight but it went crooked." she would guip when one of her powerful drives shot out of bounds. The media once again loved her, and the Associated Press voted her Woman Athlete of the Year six times.

But there were few tournaments for women golfers, and Didrikson Zaharias was frustrated by the lack of competition. In 1950, she and five other women tried to change that by forming the Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA). Didrikson Zaharias drew huge crowds, and in the first year, she won two-thirds of all the tournaments on the schedule. That year she also met Betty Dodd, a 19year-old golfer who quickly became Didrikson Zaharias's friend and

Though they publicly said they were "buddies." the two women were intimate, inseparable companions. George Zaharias was openly jealous of their relationship, and he and Dodd didn't get along. At one point, Didrikson Zaharias asked for a divorce, which Zaharias refused. After that, "he got meaner than a snake," Dodd recalled later. "We always had a lot more fun when he wasn't around."

In 1953, the feud came to an abrupt halt when Didrikson Zaharias was diagnosed with colon cancer. Dodd moved into the Zaharias home in Tampa to care for Didrikson Zaharias after her surgery, and the young woman never left. Though the golf star rallied and made a comeback, winning seven LPGA tournaments in the next two years, she eventually succumbed and died on September 27, 1956, at only 45. Upon her passing, even one of Didrikson Zaharias's early naysayers called her "probably the most talented athlete, male or female, ever developed in our country."

Love Making Blame

because they are unfulfilled sexually and they are wondering if their partners are being true to them or "is the honeymoon over?" Often the "honeymoon" isn't over, it's just that some of the imagination is gone and it's not leisurely enough. In this hum drum world of ours, we tend not to take the time to enioy the art of making love.

When all of this occurs, the fingers begin to pint at each other with words like, "You are never in the mood when I am," "You should know by now what I like and don't like, and "You are the one who is rigid." If I had a dollar for each time I heard these comments, I would be rich. However, spoken or silent, sexual blame leaves both parties feeling angry, resentful and wronged. When blame is ongoing, the bad feelings seep into other parts of your relationship with each other.

It's human, am nature to point the finger. That way we spare ourselves the unpleasantness of acing up to our own shortcomings. And when it comes to sex, our egos are especially fragile. How awful to think of oneself as sexually rigid or stingy, lazy or boring. How much less awful to think of our mates as flawed. Or we can shift the blame elsewhere entirely. "My job has me worried"..."I should never talk with my mother right before going to bed." Anything not to confront or disturb our blameless notion of ourselves.

Beyond simply vanity, though, we accuse each other for many reasons. A fear of rejection is one of the most common. Neither wants to be blamed, because if you really are to blame, you fear your mate will leave you. So many of us decide the best excuse which will not lead to your desired defense is a good offense.

Often sex becomes a control issue. One partner prefers one way of making love and the other likes something else. When on person doesn't get his or her way, criticism and blame enter into the picture with the comment, "You know this is something I really enjoy. If you loved me, you would to improve situations.

Keep in mind that when desires conflict. There are many callers who call me a scuffle for control adds fuel to sexual blame. The more blame pushed toward the other person for not giving into the other person's sexual pleasure, the more critical the other becomes because insistence has entered into the picture.

> I have discovered that many people feel so inadequate that they inadvertently try to dominate the relationship or openly intimidate their partner. When both partners refuse to examine their sexual fears and vulnerabilities, blame gets tossed back and fort like a hot potato, and both partners get

It is quite evident that open communication is needed in relationships. This open communication isn't just for every day situations but also for the bedroom. If one person insists on a particular situation and you feel degraded by what is being insisted upon, don't do it. Real intimacy is being able to say to your mate, "I really love you, but I'm not willing to do this because I will think less of myself and you." We all have a right to search nd seek in a relationship, but it is necessary for each of us to listen to what the other person is saying.

The point is for sex not to end up in a stalemate. When the atmosphere of blame is lifted, other choices present themselves. Much of the blaming we all do in bed might well be avoided if we can overcome our reluctance to give each other feedback. If one partner is rushing foreplay, let him/her know it. However, it will be necessary for the other person to find a way to talk to the other partner that doesn't put him on the defensive. When having this discussion, don't use the word "but" because that word is an results. Say something like, "You really are a wonderful lover, and ...(not but) maybe we could do a little more of XYZ."

Remember, you have more control over your own behavior than you do over your partner's. That's why it's so essential for people to see what they themselves can do

When you share a bed, not to mention a life, you have to be willing to address the needs of that person you are sharing it with. And there will never be perfect, blameless lovers, not in the imperfect world of relationships. Ultimately, what makes or breaks a sexual life aren't the kinks or the flaws or the problems at all. just how you nd your partner work to resolve them.

Love really does conquer all if you are open to communications with the person you are willing to share your hope,s dreams and aspirations with for the duration. Be willing to not only listen but hear what the other person is saying. In this way, you will not find yourself going from the heights of bliss to the depths of despair




