October 25, 1783 (215 years ago): **Deborah Sampson, a passing woman, is discharged from service in the Massachusetts Regiment.**

Were "passing women" lesbians?

Throughout American history, there were a number of women who cross-dressed in order to pass as men in society. Lesbians today usually claim these "passing women" as their dyke foremothers. While it's true that some of these women sought to conceal same-gender relationships, others who passed in the past were probably closer to what would call transgendered.

The earliest recorded instance of an American woman passing as a man was during the Revolutionary War. Deborah Sampson was born and raised in Massachusetts and spent her youth working first as a domestic servant and then as a schoolteacher. In 1782, near the end of the American Revolution, Sampson disguised herself as a man and enlisted in the Continental Army under the name Robert Shurtleff. As a soldier in the Massachusetts Regiment, Sampson fought with distinction in several battles and was wounded near Tarrytown, New York. While hospitalized, Sampson's secret was discovered, and she was quietly given an honorable discharge on October 25, 1783.

Though her cross-dressing probably started for reasons of employment opportunity and personal freedom, Sampson romanced several women during her passing period, which suggests that she had same-gender erotic desires that her cross-dressing allowed her to act on. Eventually, though, Sampson married a man and had three children. In a biography of Sampson written in 1797, the author emphatically denied popular rumors that Sampson "refuses her husband the rites of the marriage bed."

Other women who sought economic independence by passing were at the same time trying to hide existing relationships with women. In the first years of the 20th century, Cora Anderson, a Native American woman, lived and studied nursing in Chicago with her companion, Mary White. Anderson and White soon discovered the difficulties of trying to support themselves in a society where women earned very little money and had to contend with the sexual demands of their employers. As Anderson later put it, "Steady work in my profession ...depended upon the giving of myself."

To avoid sexual harassment, Anderson metamorphosed into Ralph Kerwinio and as a man was able to move around freely and find work easily. The couple began living as Mr. and Mrs. in Cleveland, where Kerwinio first worked as a hotel bellboy and later in manufacturing jobs, earning enough so that White could stay home. However, Kerwinio apparently developed a roving eye and after 13 years abandoned White for another woman, Dorothy Klenowski, whom Kerwinio legally married. For revenge, White revealed Kerwinio's secret to authorities, and Kerwinio was charged with "disorderly conduct" for impersonating a man. Kerwinio denied any sexual relations with Klenowski, but the denial was probably out of self-protection, to avoid a morals charge.

About the same time in Oregon, Alberta Lucille Hart was a rare case - a female medical student. In addition to her unorthodox career choice, she also had what she considered a "phobia" about men and sought treatment from a psychologist in Portland. The personal history she related to the doctor sounds to modern readers very much like a young butch lesbian battling her sexual longings. The psychologist, however, perceived Hart's erotic desires and her career aspirations as

masculine ambitions that were unnatural to women. Following contemporary ideas about lesbians as a "third sex," the psychologist recommended that Hart have a hysterectomy and pose as a man. Hart took the doctor's advice, even though she had never had the desire to be a man. She lived from the 1920s until 1962 as Dr. Alan Hart, a leading physician in the field of tuberculosis detection. Hart eventually married a woman, and the fact that "all parties to the deal were fully cognizant of all the facts involved," as the psychologist cagily put it, seems to indicate a lesbian relationship.

In another famous case in 1930s Oklahoma City, musician Dorothy Tipton found herself unable to get a job in the male-dominated world of bands and nightclubs. Wrapping her chest tightly, donning men's clothing, and lowering her voice, Dorothy transformed herself into Billy and immediately got a job with a band. Over the next 30 years, Billy Tipton enjoyed a successful career, becoming the leader of his own band. His female lovers later claimed that they had not known Tipton was biologically female, because he never took his clothes off in front of them and he apparently concealed a dildo in his underwear. "The first time we danced," one of his lovers recalled, "I noticed he seemed to have a permanent hard-on." Tipton was probably transgendered, since he identified as a "normal person" (to use his words) and not as a lesbian.

In terms of sexual identity, then, each passing woman was unique and should not automatically be considered lesbian. The reasons for passing were complex - from a desire to fulfill same-sex attractions to an affinity for the accoutrements of manhood such as pants or pipes. However, the one common reason that women passed for men was economic - the inability as women to get the jobs they wanted. "The world is made by man - for man alone," Cora Anderson / Ralph Kerwinio said in defense of passing. "Do you blame me for wanting to be a man?"

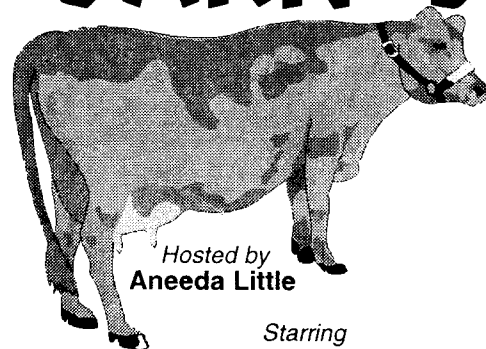

Robert Davolt, Editor and co owner of **Drummer** and the **International Drummer** contest, looked up this column on the net, and said "Oh, you used THAT picture! I can remember the moment well. I was so surprised I won I wanted to show appreciation to SOMEONE, so I went down on the trophy! About the only sex I got out of that title, too!"
After a couple of messages, I asked him to bring us up to date on what has been happening with him.

Quote "Just to fill you in on the last few years, this is the short version: I don't know if it was the appearances I made with the title (WI L/L Daddy) or my ex-lovers obit or what, but after ten years, it finally occurred to my employer in Madison that I might be gay. The sons of bitches who fired me: FABCO-Caterpillar, with locations throughout Wisconsin and Upper Michigan, Homophobes of the first order, who didn't hesitate to try and set me up on dates with gay highway commissioners, but fired me because they "couldn't trust someone who was gay."

Protected by the nation's oldest gay rights law, they still were able to get away with it on a technicality. It was a sobering lesson: **Once won, rights must constantly be re-won. Take no victory for granted.**

My "contingency-basis" lawyer was no match for their \$275-an-hour shark (but at least I have the satisfaction that the case cost them a bloody fortune).

But of course, I'm not bitter..... I started taking on freelance writing and design projects, but they weren't paying the bills. I moved to Seattle, put everything in storage and finished up the freelance work, then moved to Amsterdam. I spent almost three months there before being transferred here (San Francisco) to take on Operations Manager of **Drummer**.

January of 1997, the guy who was supposed to coordinate the **Drummer** contests flaked out, so I got the job. 14 cities a year, about 70,000+ miles, plus putting on the international finals here in SF..... in addition to still coordinating the design and production end of the magazines.

On New Year's eve last, the company's general manager suddenly quit. When I went through the books, I got a very quick lesson in the "front-office" end of things. To pull it back together, the owner made me editor and publisher and co-owner.

Drummer has always seemed to require a resident lunatic. I seem to

be doing something right, after all I have the ringing endorsement of the original lunatic, John Embry.

We publish **Drummer** bi-monthly (with plans to be monthly again in early 1999) and we are getting ready to re-launch **Drummer Tough Customers** as a quarterly in 3 to 4 months. It takes about 70-90 hours a week and I still maintain the travel schedule. It may be many things, but it is never boring.

That's about it. Local boy makes good...or makes bail....or something. **I have had a lot of support from the leather community in Wisconsin.**

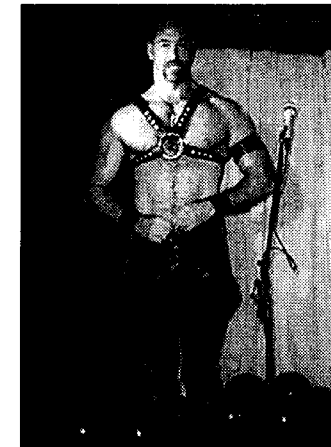
