Psychic Thoughts

NEED TO IMPROVE SELF-ESTEEM

Very often I receive calls where the caller is suffer-
ing from low self-esteem. When this occurs, they
don't want to try to get into a relationship, turn to alco-
hol or drugs and suffer from depression. All of which
are self destructive in each and every way.

One can never completely escape the blues until
you have taken a good, hard, honest look at yourself
and taken active, strong measures to develop your
self-esteem.

That is because self-esteem is the foundation from
which almost all else develops...health, personality,
reactions, guilt, resentments, and sense of power.
Almost magically, once your self-esteem improves,
circumstances in your life that you are always consid-
ered totally outside your control may improve as well.

To begin, find yourself a notebook and good pen and
at least two uninterrupted hours of peace and quiet.

Make a list of all your positive qualities and talents.
These can include qualities that relate to your person-
ality (how outgoing, charming, warm, funny and
friendly you are); your ability to express honest feel-
ings to others (feelings of love, anger, needs); your
competence at work and home; your ability to keep
health, relationships, your spirituality, your personal
values and beliefs; your physical traits; your intelli-
gence, education, etc.

When you have completed the list, and don't be
modest, read it over and feel good!

Are you comfortable with your strengths, or do you
find that when people compliment
you, you dismiss what they say because you don't
think it's true? Do you feel they are just saying it to
make you feel better?

Imagine that someone is paying you a compliment
right now, practice saying out loud: "I appreciate what
you just said," or "Thank you, your compliment
means a lot."

Whatever you do, don't let yourself roll your eyes
or put yourself down when you are told you are spe-
cial. Think about it. When you do that, you are actu-
ally insulting the other person!

Remember that true humility comes from knowing
your strengths as well as you weaknesses. Recognize
that any talents you possess are gifts from a high power
for your good and the good of others. Remember -
feeling good about yourself has nothing to do with
arrogance.

In truth, people who go out of their way to put
themselves down are not showing real
modesty at all. What they are doing is fishing for
more compliments to fuel their need to feel superior.

Make a list of all of your negative qualities. You
must be totally and fearlessly honest with yourself, or
this won't work. There is no need to feel shame while
doing this. You can be flawed and still be a wonder-
ful person. We all have our own faults that we as well
as others need to deal with at any given time. As an
example, do you set boundaries with other people?

Are you unhappy with your body? Do you feel that
others see you as the type of individual who is "dumb"
because you what others have commented about you?
Do you let others control you because you feel that
you can't control your own life?

Once you have this list completed, make another
list. On this list, write down the qualities you
always wished you had...those qualities you have feel
you absolutely needed to feel good about yourself.

This is a very significant list because it contains
ideas about who you think YOU MUST BE for others
to think well of you. This quest for perfection
probably began when you were quite young, picked
up in messages from your parents. Either that, or you
took on the need to be perfect because you thought it
would please your parents. A lot of this had to deal
with problems we as individuals were dealing with,
when we were being someone we were not.

Next, very slowly, go through list #3 (weakness-
es) and #4 (wish list) to find the things you can't
change or flat out aren't likely to happen. Also
include those things that, deep down, you have to
admit you don't really want to change.

Some of you may think that you want to be seen
as assertive and strong by others. However, when
faced with that possibility, you realize you don't want
to give up being considered selfless.

If the reality of change is too far-off or scary, you
don't have to try it now. Just keep it in mind.

Now cross all of the items off the list that you
can't change or really don't want to change. Make a
final list of the items that are left. These are what you
DO have the courage and strength to change. These
are the goals you are ready to go for.

You know what your weaknesses are. Now, put
your feet up, close your eyes, and dwell on this for
awhile: You are a wonderful person, deserving of love
and forgiveness. Can you forgive yourself for the mis-
takes you made years ago? Can you love yourself, not
despite your weaknesses, but BECAUSE of them?

Your weaknesses show that you are human and
that you don't need to be perfect in order to be valued.
In fact, when you are loved by yourself or others,
weaknesses can be seen as endearing, as part of what
makes you so unique and special. Promise yourself
that you will hold yourself with dignity, accept com-
pliments warmly, and keep a sense of humor about
yourself. You will accept who you are, with all of your
limitations.

Keep in mind, that it often happens that what
seems like a weakness is, in fact, a strength or a posi-
tive choice.

When you are feeling negative about things going
on around you, look at all of the positives in your life,
and you will see that there are a lot more positives than
negatives. Let go of the self-destructive ways in your
life to make room for all of the positive things there
are. If you think negative, life will be negative. Life
is far too short to allow the negative to overpower us.

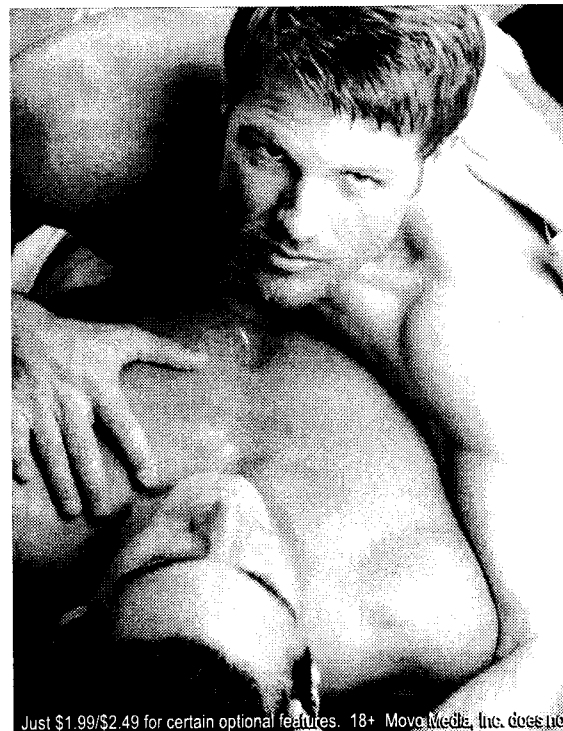

PAST/OUT

Who were some of the lesbians in Hollywood's golden age?

"I found no surprises in the Kinsey report," actress Tallulah Bankhead reportedly said. Bankhead knew that some of the most glamorous stars of Hollywood's golden age (from the advent of talking pictures through the 1940s), were part of an underground network of lesbians and bisexual women in the movie industry.

Greta Garbo was one of the most famous movie stars of her time, attracting both male and female audiences with her seductive beauty and enigmatic charm. Starting out in silent films, Garbo's first talkie was Anna Christie (1930). Her deep, sexy voice and tough demeanor made her very first lines of dialogue legendary - "Gimme a whisky, ginger ale on the side. And don't be stingy, baby." Garbo's gender-bending role in Queen Christina (1933), in which she cross-dressed and kissed her female co-star on the lips, has become a cult favorite among lesbians.

"I shall die a bachelor," Garbo-as-Christina vowed. Like the Swedish queen she played, Garbo never married, and although she had affairs with men, it was commonly believed among Hollywood insiders that she preferred women. After a much-publicized romance with leading man John Gilbert, Garbo fell for screenwriter Mercedes de Acosta in 1931. Garbo later credited de Acosta with inspiring her portrayal of Queen Christina. The suave de Acosta had been in and out of the beds of the most respected stage actresses of the time, including Eva La Gallienne and Katharine Cornell. When Garbo dumped her, she quickly took up with Hollywood's other husky-voiced sensation, Marlene Dietrich.

Like Garbo, Dietrich was famous for her androgynous sex appeal and a screen persona that defied strict gender classification. While her characters fell in love with men, they were always incredibly butch women. Studio publicists promoted Dietrich as "the woman even women can adore." Such Dietrich classics as Morocco (1930) and Blonde Venus (1932), in which she donned a top hat and tux and sang in her throaty contralto, are particularly memorable to lesbian and gay viewers.

Though she was married, Dietrich's relationship with her husband was long-distance and nonexclusive. He had a long-term mistress, and she had just about everyone else, including Maurice Chevalier, Yul Brynner, and journalist Edward R. Murrow. But she also enjoyed a host of female lovers, like de Acosta and French novelist Colette. Rumors of Dietrich's lesbian relationships had little effect on her popularity or her career, which continued unabated into the 1960s.

Dietrich didn't seem to care what anyone thought about her love life, and Tallulah Bankhead was equally unconcerned about gossip. Bankhead's one-liners about her own bisexuality have become famous in lesbian and gay culture. "Daddy always warned me about men and alcohol," she reputedly quipped, "but he never said a thing about women and cocaine."

Garbo, however, was uncomfortable with public scrutiny. Edmund Goulding, the gay filmmaker who directed Garbo in the classic Grand Hotel (1932), once implied that the star retired from movies in 1941 at the age of 36 because the pressure of hiding her lesbianism became too great. Whatever her reasons, Garbo fiercely protected her privacy until her death in 1990, making her classic line from Grand Hotel, "I want to be alone," a reality.

Other lesbian actresses were so guarded, they entered "lavender

marriages." Barbara Stanwyck, who achieved stardom as the take-charge "dame" of movies like Stella Dallas (1937) and Double Indemnity (1944), married twice, the first time to gay vaudevillian Frank Fay, whose career collapsed just as hers took off. Their stormy relationship inspired the plot of A Star Is Born. Stanwyck's second marriage, to bisexual actor Robert Taylor, was glorified by the studio's well-oiled publicity machine and provided her with a cover long after the two divorced. For many years, Hollywood's official line on Stanwyck was that she never remarried because she still pined for Taylor.

Janet Gaynor, the tomboyish lead of the original A Star Is Born (1937), was another star who married a gay man, costume designer Adrian. Gaynor's "best friend," Mary Martin, remembered for her role as Peter Pan, in turn married Richard Halliday, who styled his wife's hair and decorated all their homes. Lavender marriages provided a guise of respectable heterosexuality that gossip columnists and biographers honored and that satisfied the stars' straight fans and nervous studios.

Because so many Hollywood lesbians needed to safeguard their secret lives, they tended to socialize at parties rather than in public spaces like bars. Salka Viertel, a lesbian screenwriter with an absentee husband, hosted tea parties at her Santa Monica beach house, where Garbo first met de Acosta. Stage and film actress Alla Nazimova - whose lovers included Dolly Wilde, Oscar's niece - opened her Sunset Boulevard mansion, "The Garden of Allah," to private queer get-togethers.

Fifty years later, of course, not much has changed in Hollywood, where actresses still follow the same patterns of playing butch roles but keeping mum about their personal lives (Jodie Foster) to making the cachet of lesbianism part of their schtick (Madonna).

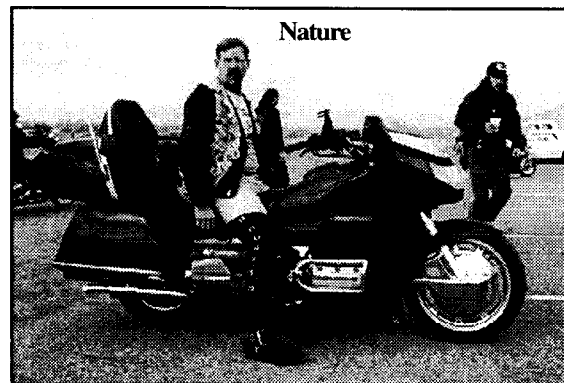

We were family and no one could deny us. We did family things. Sunday dinner, picnics, jam sessions, singalongs and card playing gave us what we felt the rest of the world denied unless we did it their way. I hope you will know that feeling, for it was good. We had fun and we had our troubles. There was bashing back then also. Far more open and above board than now. The Fishers of Men, an off beat Christian sect seemed to lead the pack. They came to save us from ourselves and the fervor of their wild ranting emboldened them to attack not unlike your pet dog turns wild when in a pack.
