





December 1, 1952 (46 years ago): A New York City tabloid breaks the story of Christine Jorgensen's sex change in Denmark.

Christine Jorgensen, A Sex Change Pioneer!

Today, with the growth of the transsexual movement, sex reassignment surgery is becoming more and more familiar. But in 1952, when George Jorgensen, Jr., underwent surgery and emerged as Christine, the story made headlines - especially in tabloids around the world. Jorgensen was not the first person to have a sex change operation. Experiments in sex reassignment surgery had taken place sporadically in Europe since the early 1930s. The word "transsexual," however, was not used to describe those who underwent the surgery until 1949, when D.O. Cauldwell wrote about "psychopathic transsexuality" in the popular journal, Sexology.

But it took the story of an ex-G.I. from the Bronx to bring transsexuality to public attention. Born in 1926, George Jorgensen was a slender blonde boy who grew up liking to do needlepoint. In school, children laughed at his "sissified" ways. At 19, when he was inducted into the army, he weighed only 98 pounds, with almost no body hair and underdeveloped genitals. Jorgensen worried that he was a homosexual, but as he got older he began to believe that he might be a woman in a man's body - "a sexual mix-up," he told the psychiatrist he consulted after his release from the army in 1946.

Jorgensen studied photography under the G.I. Bill but spent most of his free time searching for information about his "condition." After reading a book called *The Male Hormone*, he became obsessed with chemical theories about gender and with "conversion" surgery. He even enrolled in medical technician classes to learn as much as he could about his body. While in school, Jorgensen was able to obtain female hormone pills and began experimenting on himself.

Jorgensen slowly saved his money and by April 1950 had enough for a one-way passage to Copenhagen, where hormone treatment and conversion were being done by Dr. Christian Hamburger and his associates. Jorgensen offered himself as a guinea pig to Hamburger, who had a theory that a person could be outwardly a man while his body chemistry and brain remained female. Because the work was still highly experimental, Jorgensen was charged nothing for his treatment, which began in August of that year. After a year of hormone treatment, during which Jorgensen's physical appearance changed drastically, his doctors recommended surgery. Because Jorgensen was an American, the surgery had to be approved by the Danish Ministry of Justice. In September 1951, Jorgensen underwent his first surgery, which removed his testicles. He then applied for and was granted a new passport under the name Christine - a feminine version of Dr. Hamburger's first name.

Jorgensen had never told his family why he was in Denmark. Ostensibly, he had been studying photography and beginning to earn a living at it. In June 1952, Christine Jorgensen wrote a long letter to her parents, in which she revealed that "nature had made a mistake. which I corrected, and I am now your daughter." She enclosed photos of herself since the surgery. Amazingly, her parents were open-minded and accepting, cabling her back immediately: "Letter and pictures received. We love you more than ever. Mom and Dad."

Late that fall, Jorgensen had a second surgical procedure. While still recuperating in the hospital, she found out that a front-page story would be breaking in New York's Daily News on December 1, under the headline "Ex-G.I. Becomes Blonde Beauty." A technician at the hospital had tipped off a reporter, who then approached Jorgensen's parents for an interview. In the interest of getting the correct story into

print, her parents cooperated with the newspaper, even lending the "after" photos that their daughter had sent them and her letter detailing the reasons for her surgery.

When the story broke, Dr. Hamburger began receiving hundreds of letters from individuals seeking treatment. Jorgensen, too, was bombarded with mail, but many of those who wrote simply wanted to capitalize on her overnight celebrity. Warner Brothers Studios advised her contact them if she was interested in a movie career. Clubs and theaters from New York to Las Vegas offered her as much as \$1,000 a week for an appearance. Jorgensen had no real talent for performing. but she quickly decided that "if [the public] wanted to see me, they would have to pay for it." She hired an agent, who booked her into nightclubs across the country. Introduced by the song "I Enjoy Being a Girl," her act consisted mostly of witty repartee with a comedian named Myles Bell. Reviewers noted that, while she couldn't really sing or dance, Jorgensen had fabulous costumes and a flair for "showmanship." She continued on the nightclub circuit well into the 1960s and also did stints in summer stock.

In 1959, Jorgensen made headlines again when her application for a license to marry John Traub was denied, because she had never had her birth certificate changed to read "female." Though the tabloids reported that Traub "dumped" her, she wrote in her autobiography that the two mutually agreed to drop their marriage plans and parted as friends.

Jorgensen died in 1989 after a long bout with liver and bladder cancer. One of her many obituaries was titled "A Girl at Heart." Though trivialized and sensationalized by the media. Jorgensen's story did bring transsexuality out of the closet and offered hope to many individuals who had felt similarly trapped in their bodies.


Be assured, it's still all happening with Eagles in Milwaukee and Minneapolis, Barracks in Madison opening in the last year even more so than ever.


