





April 21, 1985 (14 years ago this month): Rudi Gernreich, cofounder of the Mattachine Society and designer of the topless bathing suit, dies in Los Angeles.

Who was Rudi Gernreich?

Rudi Gemreich secured a place for himself in fashion history as the designer of one of the most controversial pieces of women's wear, the topless bathing suit. But in gay history books he'll also be remembered as a cofounder of the Mattachine Society, the early gay rights organization.

Born in Vienna in 1922, Gernreich showed early artistic talent. He was introduced to fashion design by his aunt, who owned a dress shop where Gernreich spent many hours after school sketching clothes and learning about fabric. When he was 12, a designer saw his sketches and offered him an apprenticeship in London, but his mother vetoed the move.

In 1938, Gernreich and his mother left Austria, along with thousands of other Jews fleeing Hitler. The Gernreichs had friends in Los Angeles and decided to settle there. Living near Hollywood was a dream come true for the teenage boy. "I'd seen movies and read American magazines and suddenly I was there!"

Gernreich later said. Gernreich quickly became fluent in English and eventually spoke it without a trace of accent. In 1943, he obtained American citizenship.

Gernreich put himself through art school by running errands for various advertising agencies. After graduation, his first job was as a costume sketch artist for lesbian designer Edith Head at RKO Studios, but he "hated every minute." A dance performance by Martha Graham inspired him to make a career shift, and he joined the Lester Horton Dance Troupe. Dance, he later observed,

influenced his fashion designs: "[It] made me aware of what clothes do to the rest of the body - to the hands and feet and head."

By the late 1940s, Gernreich recognized his limited dancing talent and returned to designing. Some of his first designs were costumes for his former dance troupe. At the Horton Studio in 1950, he met Harry Hay, whose young daughter took dance classes there. Hay later recalled that Gernreich stared at him from across the studio. They made a date for dinner, and "we fell madly in love, of course," Hay later recalled. Gernreich had had only had short flings with men before Hay. Because the designer still lived with his mother and Hay was married, they carried on their romance at hotels and in friends' apartments.

Hay, a Communist organizer, had written a prospectus for a homosexual rights group and was looking for people to help him start it. He showed the plan to Gernreich, who told him, "This is the most dangerous thing I have ever read - and I'm with you 100 percent."

Together with two other men, Hay and Gernreich started the Mattachine Society, the first long-standing gay rights organization. They distributed flyers at gay bars and in the gay areas of beaches, trying to recruit members. Meetings were held in secret at members' homes. "The whole group was fearful," Martin Block, an early member, said, "although I think Rudi was more so ... because he was an immigrant."

Gernreich and Hay had been lovers for a year when Gernreich temporarily moved to New York for a design opportunity. The distance hurt their relationship, and when Gernreich returned to California, the two-bruke up. Hay spondated that Control to career ambitions challed too stands with Hey's communing gay political work. Gentreich left the Matanthian, and Hay homored the group's socrecy pledge by looping sums about Gentreich's involvement until after the designer's death.

Geraseich's career soon soared with a line of simple, comfortable women's clothing. In 1952, his "nothing-inside-but-you" bathing suit (without a molded, built-in bra) was both controversial and sought after. It was only a short step to the fashion item that made him famous. In an interview in 1962 in Women's Wear Daily, Gernreich observed that some women on the Riviera wore only bikini bottoms. Soon topless bathing suits would be the rage, he said. WWD printed his prediction, and, concerned that another designer would scoop him, Gernreich produced the topless suit himself. Photographs of the first topless bathing suit, modeled from behind, appeared in Look magazine in June, 1964 and launched Gernreich into overnight celebrity.

Gernreich's design was denounced by everyone from the Vatican to the Kremlin. In St. Tropez, officials warned that wearing the suit would bring "legal repercussions," and helicopters patrolled the beaches for offenders. Many stores refused to carry the suit, but a total of 3,000 top-less suits were sold by reputable establishments like B. Altman and Lord & Taylor.

The uproar over the topless bathing suit overshadowed Gernreich's other designs, which included the first miniskirts. In 1967, he was inducted into the Fashion Hall of Fame. Throughout his career, Gernreich continued to shock the fashion world - he was the first to use models with shaved heads, for example - and to advocate for freedom in clothing.

Gernreich's gay identity was not publicly revealed until his death from lung cancer in 1985. At that time the American Civil Liberties Union announced that Gernreich and his lover, Dr. Oreste Pucciani, had endowed a trust for litigation and education on lesbian and gay rights.



Gay... and Married

There is an estimate that in the U.S. 2,000,000 gay men and lesbians are married to persons of the opposite sex. I don't know where that estimate comes from. Bernie shared this at a PFLAG meeting a couple of months ago. All I know is that Bernie is a great PFLAG dad who gives really good hugs and I believe what he says. I feel saddened by that number, knowing that what it really means is there are lots of gay and lesbian people who feel alone, confused, and unsure of which way to turn to make their lives more meaningful.

It's fairly easy to figure out how gay men and lesbians end up in heterosexual marriages. For starters, we're taught that in order to complete our journeys toward becoming whole human beings we need to fall in love with someone of the opposite sex, get married, and have children. This message is delivered over and over again at home, school, church, on television and everywhere in between. This is the script we're handed at birth and it's reinforced by the toys we play with and questions we're asked by well-meaning relatives. The expectation is that we'll follow this heterosexual script without question.

Many gay and lesbian people want more than anything to do "what's right" even to the extent of denying their own feelings. Others simply hope that by getting married the feelings they have toward people of the same sex will disappear and they will go on to live a "normal" life. Quite often gay or lesbian people do love their opposite sex partners - it's just not the same kind of love or attraction that is felt with someone of the same sex.

Let's understand one thing before going any further. Although discovering that you're lesbian or gay while in a marriage to an opposite sex partner opens up a can of worms, being gay is not the problem. No matter what anybody says, BEING GAY IS NOT THE PROBLEM (got it?). No doubt if you choose to come out to your spouse attempts will be made to define your sexual orientation as the problem. The real problem is that we live in world where we get approval and rewards for living as heterosexuals even if we're gay.

Gay or lesbian people who are married are often able to deny their same sex attractions and stay in their marriages for awhile - how long is dependent on each situation. I know people who remained married to their spouses for 20 years or more. Sometimes children are part of the family and choices may be made to stay in the marriage for them. But while the "American Dream" is being endured, there

more frightening prospect are choices made by some to act out same sex attractions in ways that involve sneaking around, use of drugs or alcohol and the risks of exposing spouses to the dangers of unsafe sex.

Coming out while in a heterosexual marriage is a complex process. There are many issues and coming out to yourself is the beginning. Other pieces of the puzzle include the reactions of spouse, children, family of origin, in-laws and coworkers. The idea of making changes to live as the person you truly are can seem overwhelming and impossible.

There's no right way to come out while in a heterosexual marriage - and certainly no handbook that outlines the process. It takes time and usually involves hurts and losses. The goal is to be able to live out the truth of who you really are and this can be extremely freeing. If you are married and considering going through the process of coming out, please know that you are not sick, bad or immoral. You are also not alone. There are people that you can talk with who have had similar experiences and know what you're going through. There are also





When I travel, I dig out the yellow pages and the first spare minute I have, I am there. Secondly, the leather you get from a pawn shop can be very good and inexpensive. It will more than likely be mellowed out and broken in. The Pawn Shop in Rapid City, S.D. is a leather pawner's dream. Hundreds of jackets for under \$50.00. Lee got one for \$42.00; it fit him like a glove, had over \$50.00 worth of Harley patches on it and well broken in.

A pawn/resale shop, on Santa Monica Blv'd, LA, just up from the Pleasure Chest, was another to-die-for shopping experience. I bartered and came home with a pair of heavy duty (\$500.00 +, custom made) chaps, which are still may favorite. They drip testos-

Then, there are resale shops. Here in Sat., Apr 24, 1 pm Charity Auction @ the Milwuakee, there is one on the SW corner of


N. Water St., at Chicago. They have jackets hanging in the window and behind the counter. The last time I was in there, the marked price is more than double of what it should be; in fact they have some "very" used First Gear type leather, priced more than new stuff over at Changing Times. If you show some interest, they will knock it down. For those into the unifrom scene, you might want to check it out.

I have seen little in Survival Revival nor stores like Goodwill, St. Vincent DePaul. I've been told the good stuff is snapped up before it gets to the sales floor.

It may be different in your city, so look thru the yellow pages for all the resources available, then shop away. Before long, you will know brand names, styles etc., and be well aware of the worth. You will know the differance between trash, a good buy and a rare find. When you see a treasure, don't wait for the price to go down, barter if you can, but don't leave without it. Don't expect to find much in the way of boots, pants, chaps or vests unless you get to a gay re-sale shop in a major city. Worn Out West on the west coast comes to mind.
