# This is the Summer of Love!

Hmmm. Nope, no matter how many times you say it, the two just don't seem to go together.

At least that's what I thought, until the release of the single "You're a Superstar." It's the first single released off Love Inc.'s self titled debut album, and featured on the gav-friendly compilation album Logic Pride Vol. Two. You know you've heard the song-Green Bay radio's Kiss FM has been giving it a fair share of playtime. and video sources MuchMusic, MTVeven Za's has shown the video. I got a chance to interview founding member Chris Sheppard over the phone when he was at a Gay Pride festival in Long Island, NY where the group headlined recently. There was a loud din coming from the twenty-thousand-plus crowd, but I was still able to hear the distinctive accent in his voice (and, if I may be unprofessional for a moment, it was incredibly sexy!).

Started a year and a half ago, Love Inc. is composed of diva singer Simone Denny and spinologist / producer Chris Sheppard. Sheppard has an incredible resume featuring highlights such as compilation albums; radio deejay; rave promoter; remixer of songs by New Order, Skinny Puppy, & Jesus Jones; and member of ambient electronica group BKS. Sheppard heard a tape of Denny's work at BMG Records and knew he had to meet "that voice." "I knew from that moment I wanted to work with her," Sheppard says. The two became fast friends, and eventually collaborators in Love, Inc.

Their music has been described as "...pure dance pop music that will most definitely be embraced..." and "...Eurosplashed dance-pop rhythms..." But it's more fun to hear Sheppard explain his philosophy of inventing new sounds for the music: "I spend a lot of time trying to create quirky sounds, and I take these frequencies and bring them into a pop music context. I guess you could say that we create pop music with very sharp edges." Denny brings her own message of enthusiasm to the music as well. "The album has a very positive vibe," she says, "I sing

the words 'Every Other Night You've Got Your Name In Lights / You're A Superstar."

The message seems to be getting through. Love, Inc. has already grabbed a platinum album, took home MuchMusic's Best Video of the Year award, and nods from JUNO, the Canadian version of the Grammys. Stateside it debuted last May on Dance Music Authority's (DMA) Club chart above both Mariah Carey's "I Still Believe (Remix)" and TLC's "No Scrubs."

August, 1953 (46 years ago this month): The Los Angeles postmaster seizes all copies of ONE, a gay magazine, on the grounds that the content is obscene.

#### What was the Supreme Court's first pro-gay ruling?

Romer v. Evans, the 1996 Supreme Court decision that found Colorado's anti-gay Amendment 2 unconstitutional, was not the first time the high court ruled in favor of gay people. In January 1958, the court delivered its first pro-gay ruling in ONE, Inc. v. Oleson, a landmark decision that allowed lesbian and gay publications to be sent through the mail.

ONE, Inc., a homophile educational organization, was founded in Los Angeles in 1952 by about a dozen members (mostly men, with one woman) of the Mattachine Society. The group intended to publish a monthly magazine, also called *ONE*, instead of just participating in the Mattachine's discussion groups. The name was chosen from a quote by 19th-century British essayist Thomas Carlyle: "A mystical bond of brotherhood makes all men one."

One of the magazine's early editors, Martin Block, recalled that, for the premier issue, "We thought if we had to, we would write articles ourselves. We called our friends and asked them to contribute." The underlying message of the magazine, Block said, was that people could be proud to be gay. "That in itself was radical," Block noted. "At that time, [being] gay ... was thought to be a disease."

ONE appeared in January 1953 with the Carlyle quote on the first page. It featured articles on the Mattachine Society and several personal essays. The longest essay, "To Be Accused Is to Be Guilty," was by Dale Jennings, one of the magazine's founders. Jennings described his entrapment in a Los Angeles park by a plainclothes policeman in 1952 and his subsequent trial and acquittal. "The only true pervert in the court room," he quipped, "was the arresting officer."

From the beginning, the founders insisted on a professional look for the magazine. Even though they were paying the initial publication costs themselves, they opted to typeset and print *ONE* instead of mimeographing it (which is how many underground organizations reproduced their publications). *ONE* distinguished itself with bold graphics, eye-catching artwork and, eventually, paid advertising (one of the first ads was for men's pajamas).

To distribute the new magazine, the staff visited newsstands that carried physique magazines (which attracted gay buyers) and asked them to also carry ONE. They found a pool of eager subscribers in the membership of the Mattachine Society, and, within a few months, ONE was selling 2,000 copies a month. Its readership, of course, was much higher because many people would pass their copies along to friends after reading them.

Besides drawing gay readers, however, *ONE* also caught the attention of law enforcement officials. At the height of the McCarthy witchhunts, FBI agents in Los Angeles began collecting copies of the magazine in hopes of finding obscene or communist content. In July 1953, the FBI initiated a full-scale investigation, sending copies of the magazine every month to the national headquarters in Washington. FBI agents even wrote letters to the employers of *ONE*'s editors, advising them that their employees were "deviants" and "security risks." Despite these underhanded tactics, none of the *ONE* staffers lost their day jobs, and the FBI never succeeded in shutting the magazine down.

Postal authorities, however, were nearly able to close the magazine several times. The first time was in August 1953, when the Los Angeles postmaster seized all copies of *ONE* on the grounds that its content was obscene. But U.S. Post Office officials in Washington decided that *ONE* did not violate federal law. The following year, a Republican senator from Wisconsin, Alexander Wiley, renewed the attack on *ONE*, writing to the Postmaster General to protest "the use of the United States mails to transmit a so-called 'magazine' devoted to the advancement of sexual perversion." Wiley's letter led to a second effort by the Post Office to keep *ONE* out of the hands of its subscribers.

In October 1954, postal officials once again seized the magazine and charged the editors with sending obscene material through the mail, a violation of the 1873 Comstock Act. The Post Office cited a poem, "Lord Samuel and Lord Montague," and a short story, "Sappho Remembered," as "obscene, lewd, lascivious, and filthy" (obviously thinking one adjective wasn't enough). The poem offended, officials claimed, because it suggested that homosexuality was common among British lords. The short story was "lustful" because it depicted a woman who left her fiance for another woman.

ONE's editors hired a heterosexual defense attorney, who argued in federal district court that ONE was educational and strove simply "to create understanding of an extremely knotty social problem." But the judge ruled for the Post Office, contending that the magazine was intended not to educate but to "stimulate the lust of the homosexual reader." On appeal, a second judge concurred, dismissing ONE as "cheap pomography."

Determined, *ONE* took its case all the way to the Supreme Court. On January 13, 1958, the Court delivered an astonishing unanimous pro-gay decision, overturning the rulings of the two lower courts and limiting the power of the Comstock Act. As a result, lesbian and gay publications could be mailed without legal repercussions, though many continued to experience harassment from the Post Office and U.S. Customs.

Over the years, ONE, Inc. expanded its focus beyond the magazine, publishing books and pamphlets and offering classes. Though *ONE* magazine folded in 1967, ONE Institute for Homophile Studies continued the educational mission of the group's founders.







# Chicago 2006 Committee Formed to Bring Gay Games to Chicago!



#### Career and lob Choices - LGBT

So far, the articles I've contributed to Quest have been focused on mental health issues that are faced by gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgendered people. You are possibly wondering why I'm writing about career and job choices? What does this topic have to do with mental health?

Those of you who have worked in a less-than-satisfying job understand how quickly this can become a mental health issue. The average person who works full time spends at least eight hours a day at work, eight hours sleeping, and the rest of the time doing everything else - time with friends, watching tv, household chores, etc. In other words, one half of the time that we're awake we spend at work. This is a lot of time to spend in a work situation that's bad or even horrible. The results of working in a bad job situation can include high levels of stress or anxiety, frestration and depression.

Let's be realistic - perhaps the "ideal" jub doesn't exist. By making of being comployed, there will always be parts to a jub that are talescated better than others. But it containly inn't necessary to hate every unimate - it probably isn't even necessary to distillu ment of your job. It containly is possible to like your job, even come away from a work day faciliza cond about yourself and what you be just exent the day drive.

Up until a couple of years ago, I had the misconception that choosing a job or career was a game of chance, largely dependent on being in the right place at the right time. Don't get me wrong - a tot of people make career and job choices that way and have found satisfying jobs. However, considering the amount of time spent at work, it seems risky to leave a decision this important up to chance.

So what are the alternatives? How can a person make a sound choice that will ultimately lead to a fulfilling job or career? The first step is to

take some time to consider what sort of person you are and what things are important to you. Studies have shown that people are happiest in jobs that match their personality traits and values. For example, if you know that you are a person who likes to be alone, you probably wouldn't be happy working in a retail setting where you're around people for the entire day. Maybe you're creative, or maybe you work well with numbers - these traits can give you valuable clues about what you might be good at and what types of jobs you would enjoy.

Other things to consider early in the job seeking process are your values. What things are important to you? Do you see yourself working at something that benefits others? Is your number one goal to make lots of money? Do you want to be able to be open about your sexual orientation or gender identity with your coworkers? Would you like to have weekends off? All of these considerations will help narrow down the field of possible job options and will save you the risk of astring a job that you won't be well-suited for.

Depending on how elaborate you want to get as you do your per-sonal employment, there are personality tests available that assess your ction, there are personality tasts available that assess your personality tenits and hist out caseons that would be a good match for you. Many counselors or career contars have those available. The Myers-Bridges Personality Inventory is one example of such a test.

Assets step that will make your jub search much easier is an unto date remane. A remane gives a quick overview to a presnective employer showing your education, job experience, career goals, volwark, etc. If you need help putting a resume together (or with any other aspect of job search) there are career centers in most comties (now called Workforce Development Centers) that will help you (and it's FREE!). They also have resources for finding jobs through the internet or job postings that are available for public use.

You don't need to stay in a job that is causing you anxiety or frustration. With a little bit of work on your part, you will be able to find a job or career that is satisfying and better for your mental health!


The Miss Cream City Pageant has not been dated vet; tentatively. it will be held at LaCage, Milwaukee.

# Multi-State Phone Scam Targets Wisconsin Gay Community

Since late June an ongoing telephone scam has defrauded about two thousand dollars from LGBT supportive individuals and organizations in Wisconsin and Minnesota.

At least two different men have been making collect calls to people who are coworkers or acquaintances of a number of highly visible members of Wisconsins Gav community. The callers claim to be the community member and claim to have been robbed, mugged or had their car towed resulting in the loss of all their personal possessions. The scammers then request money be wired to them for plane tickets, towing fees, etc.

The con men have been using the automated collect calling services such as 1-800-CALL ATT or 1-800-COLLECT. They usually call at odd hours of the day and on weekends. People who refuse to accept charges are repeatedly called until

they relent, which apparently adds credibility to the phony emergency.

The names of four well-known Gay men have confirmed to date. These include Patrick Price and Papa Joe Mallien of Milwaukee and Mike Fitzpatrick and Jeff Jennings of Green Bay.

Price name was used on June 23, the day after he was the subject of statewide news coverage as the first Wisconsin man to receive the experimental AIDS preventative vaccine. Mallien and Fitzpatrick, columnists for Quest and Wisconsin Light were the next to be impersonated. The con men were using multiple Mr. Gay Wisconsin titleholder Jeff Jennings name as late as July 26.

The scammers have attempted to obtain funds from LGBT community members, business owners and others supportive of the Gay community in Milwaukee. Minneapolis, Kenosha, Madison, Green Bay, DePere, Sturgeon Bay and other cities. Amounts which have been sent to the con men have ranged from \$200 - 500 and were picked up at wire service offices in Wisconsin and California.

Because the scam involves individuals in multiple states, people with information about the schemers or who have been vic-

timized either by wiring money or by the use of their name should contact the nearest local office of the FBI.


