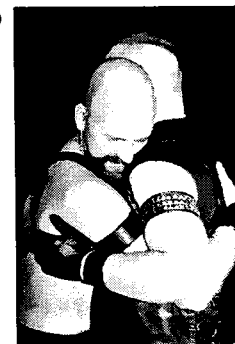

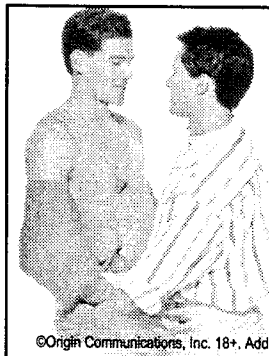

August 1957 (42 years ago this month): Lorraine Hansberry, author of the award-winning play, *A Raisin in the Sun*, writes to *The Ladder*, a lesbian magazine.

Who was Lorraine Hansberry?

"I was born black and female," playwright Lorraine Hansberry wrote, summing up the influences on her life and work. If she had lived longer, she might have added "and lesbian" to her description of herself.

Both of Hansberry's parents were civil rights activists in Chicago. In 1938, when Lorraine was 8, the family moved from a black ghetto to a mostly white, middle-class neighborhood in order to challenge the city's Jim Crow housing laws. "Literally, howling mobs surrounded our house," Hansberry later wrote, recalling the angry white neighbors who threw bricks through her family's front window. The Hansberrys fought all the way to the Supreme Court for a black family's right to live where it pleased. Hansberry's landmark play, *A Raisin in the Sun* (1959), took its inspiration from her family's experiences with racial discrimination in housing.

In her high school yearbook, Hansberry wrote that her ambition was to be a journalist. After a few years of college at the University of Wisconsin, she moved to New York City and joined the editorial staff of Paul Robeson's radical journal, *Freedom*. Following in her parents' footsteps, she too became an activist for black civil rights. Hansberry wrote to a friend that she would "attend meetings almost every night, ... usher at rallies, make street corner speeches in Harlem." At a demonstration against the exclusion of blacks from university sports, she met Robert Nemiroff, a white Jewish intellectual and music producer, and the two married in 1953.

But the marriage lasted only a few years, because Hansberry soon began coming to terms with her lesbianism. Around 1957, she and Nemiroff quietly and amicably separated, though they didn't divorce until seven years later. At the same time, Hansberry joined the Daughters of Bilitis, the pioneering lesbian organization based in San Francisco, and began receiving their journal, *The Ladder*. She also subscribed to *ONE*, the homophile magazine published in Los Angeles.

In May 1957, Hansberry wrote the first of two thoughtful letters to *The Ladder*. Since the policy of the magazine was to identify letter writers only with initials, "L.H.N., New York, N.Y." followed Hansberry's letter. Barbara Grier, the editor at that time, identified Hansberry as the writer only after her death. In her letter, Hansberry expressed relief at having discovered the magazine: "I'm glad as heck you exist," she wrote. She also mused about everything from butch-emme culture to the gaps between lesbians and gay men, displaying a feminist awareness that would grow stronger over the next few years.

In August of that same year, "L.H.N." once again wrote the *The Ladder* with more feminist commentary. The connections she drew between sexism and homophobia were ahead of her time, and her political insights stood out from the magazine's other, lighter fare. "Homosexual persecution," Hansberry wrote, "has at its roots not only social ignorance, but a philosophically active anti-feminist dogma."

By 1957, Hansberry was already well into writing *A Raisin in the Sun*. Eighteen months after her second letter to *The Ladder*, she became an instant celebrity when the play opened on Broadway.

Accompanying Hansberry on opening night was her close friend, James Baldwin, with whom she often went to gay bars and artists' hangouts in Greenwich Village. The two had met in 1957, during a dramatic production of Baldwin's gay-themed novel, *Giovanni's Room*. "She sat way up in the bleachers," Baldwin remembered, "taking on some of the biggest names in the American theater because she had liked the play and they, in the main, hadn't."

A Raisin in the Sun made theater history for African-Americans and for women. Never before had a black woman writer's work appeared on a Broadway stage. "I had never in my life seen so many black people in the theater," Baldwin marveled about the opening night. After the play, in the alley behind the theater, Hansberry and Baldwin were mobbed by fans. "Lorraine handed me her handbag," Baldwin said, "and began signing autographs. 'It only happens once,' she said." Hansberry became the first African-American and the fifth woman to win the New York Drama Critics' Award. Softened of some of its defiance, the play became a hit movie two years later.

Hansberry's second play, *The Sign in Sidney Brustein's Window* (1964), received only lukewarm reviews, however. She was criticized for writing about white people and straying from "black" topics. She also presented radical ideas about gay activism. "If you don't like the sex laws," Sidney, the protagonist, tells David, a gay male character, "attack 'em.... Please get over the notion that your particular 'thing' is something that only the deepest, saddest, and most nobly tortured can know about. It ain't." Hansberry's words foreshadowed the "gay is proud" attitude of 1970s gay liberation.

Sadly, Hansberry's contributions to theater, to African-American culture, and to gay liberation were all cut short. After a bout with ulcers, she learned in July 1964 that there were serious problems with her intestinal system. Six months later she died of cancer at the age of 34. Nemiroff, her literary executor, spent the next 25 years keeping her work alive. But Hansberry's sexual identity remained hidden until lesbian scholars brought it to light in the 1980s.

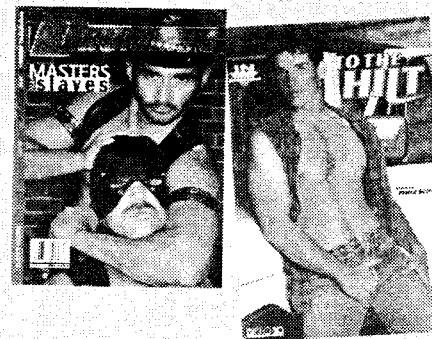

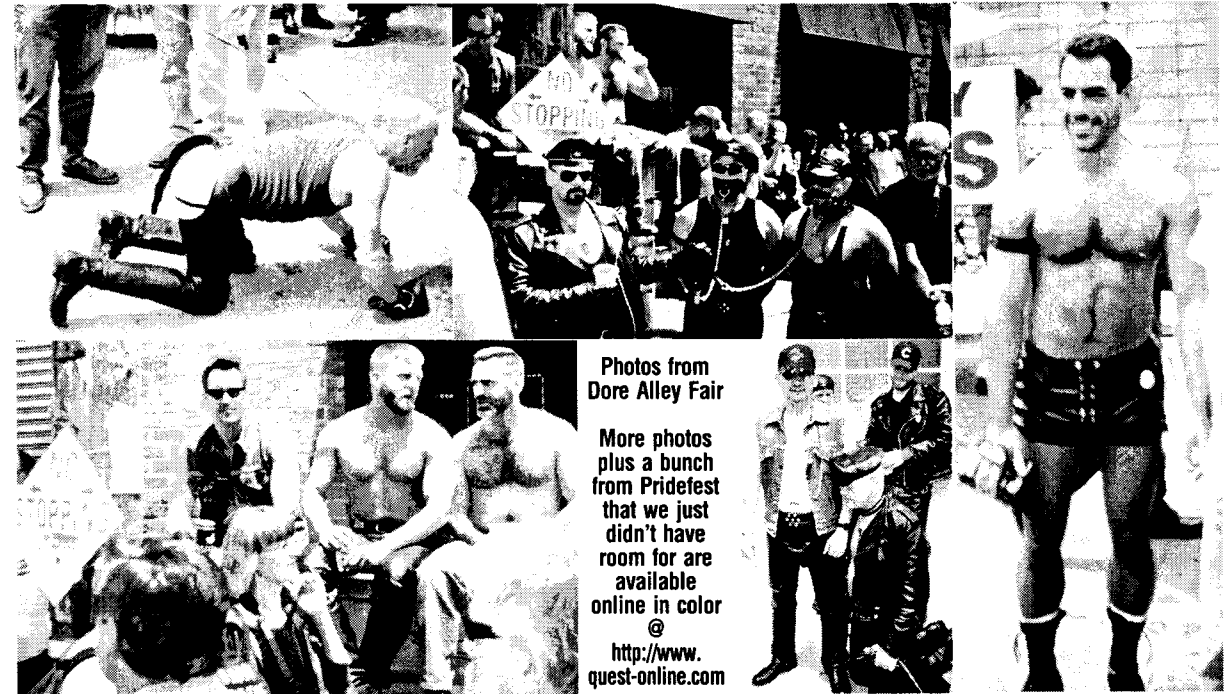

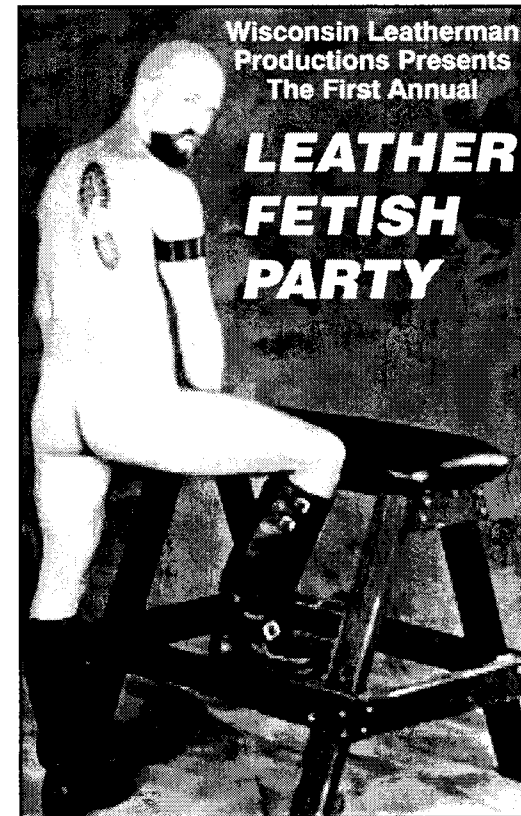
