What were physique magazines?

At the turn of the 20th century, Bernarr Macfadden - a publisher. health enthusiast, and presumed heterosexual - began putting out the first male bodybuilding magazine in the United States. Physical Culture was filled with almostnude photographs of sculpted. athletic male bodies, which made it understandably popular among gav men. Macfadden, however, didn't intend his magazine for sexual titillation. When he became aware of its homosexual following, he publicly denounced his gay readers as "painted, perfumed, kohl-eyed, lisping, mincing youths," whom he encouraged other men to beat up.

Macfadden's success with the magazine sparked the founding of many copycats, none of which were intended for a gay gaze. Just after World War II, however, gay photographers began to publish their own work celebrating the male body beautiful. Two gayrun photo studios, Bruce of Los Angeles and the Athletic Model Guild, led what became known in gay culture as the physique movement.

Initially, these photographers peddled their work through their own mail-order pin-up businesses. Fifteen cents bought a full catalog of available photos. Bob Mizer was only 23 when he started AMG and its catalog in 1945. He originally operated out of a spare room in his mother's house. She wasn't particularly happy that he was gay, but she cooperated because she liked the extra income he shared with her. When Mizer's business boomed, he built a separate studio next door to Mom. He recruited models at gyms and along Venice Beach, searching for a particular type: chiseled, muscular, white. Many of the models he hired were heterosexual.

homoerotic images grew, and

Mizer looked for another way to distribute them. In 1951, he began publishing Physique Pictorial, a pocket-sized magazine created especially for a gay audience. Eventually there were several dozen physique magazines, serving as many as 70,000 readers by 1958. Many also included illustrations and launched the careers of erotic artists such as Tom of Finland. Gay men signed up for subscriptions or bought the magazines at newsstands, though at that time doing either was considered extremely risky.

Because of the oppressive atmosphere of the 1950s, physique magazines were careful to disguise their homoerotic intent. Postal inspectors and FBI agents were on the lookout for pornographic content, such as "excessive genital delineation." They particularly targeted gay publications, trying to indict them for violation of the 1873 Comstock Act, which prohibited sending obscene material through the mail. To avoid harassment, Physique Pictorial adopted a lofty mission statement: "A fine healthy physique," it claimed, was "a great compliment to our creator who planned for the utmost perfection in all of his universe." A beautiful body, according to Mizer's publication, "makes the soul sing."

A number of early physique magazines, with names like Grecian Guild Pictorial. Adonis, and American Apollo, tried to cover their tracks by purporting to foster the "Grecian" ideals of morality, honesty, and physical beauty. Photos of men in G-strings or with carefully placed fig leaves ran next to articles on the development of the mind and spirit, often written by clergy members. "I seek a sound mind in Popular demand for these a sound body," was the Grecian Guild Pictorial's credo. "I am a

Grecian." The word "Grecian." however, could easily be read as underground code for "gay." Grecian Guild Pictorial became increasingly campy and tongue-incheek over time, comparing its own images to "the magnificent art treasures handed down from antiquity."

Also popular in the 1950s were "all-American" physique magazines with names like Vim and **Trim.** Unlike other physique magazines of the time, all-American ones regularly included images of African-American men. They typically featured photographs of muscle men engaged in weightlifting contests and carried articles about the benefits of exercise. Though Vim and others were geared toward gay men, they camouflaged their purpose by promoting the traditionally masculine, he-man interests of sports and competition.

Despite all these efforts at concealment, physique magazines came under repeated attack from the U.S. Post Office and law enforcement agencies and were often required to defend their right to exist in court. In 1965, one case, Manual Enterprises v. Day, went all the way to the Supreme Court. A significant victory was won when the high court ruled against the obscenity charge, stating that the publication in question lacked "patent offensiveness," even though it was "unpleasant, uncouth, and tawdry."

The court decision in Manual

a flourishing of gay pornography, complete with full frontal nudity. Physique magazines were too tame by comparison and either fizzled out or completely revamped themselves to meet the new trend. Mizer began producing low-budget movies with (as The Advocate reported in 1970) "hunky actors" and "slappedtogether settings" like Marine barracks and locker rooms. These movies were the direct descendants of the first modern gay erot-

An Interview with the "Divine" Miss Gay Wisconsin 2000

I'm naked & wet, and the room is steamy. Not in the preferable way, unfortunately—I had just stepped out of the shower last Thursday to catch a phone call from Za/Mark. "Honey, you're coming out Saturday, aren't you? I have an interview with a performer for the next issue I'm dying for you do." At this point, I almost flat out refuse—I have an out of town date I am not going to miss. But I give him a chance to hype it up for me. I'm glad I did. "I have Miss Nova D'Vine lined up for the cover and I was hoping you'd put pen to paper," Za said with that quick fervor I've come to recognize in his voice as excitement. How can I say no to that? Very easily, but I decided delaying my trip to Milwaukee for two hours was worth it. I've seen Nova perform on numerous occasions, and thought this would be a fun interview. She didn't disappoint.

Jess Littleman: How are you doing? Nova D'Vine: Very well, thank you.



JL: What titles do you currently hold?

ND: I am currently Miss Gay Green Bay America, and also Miss Gay Wisconsin America 2000.

JL: and you're running for something shortly...

ND: I'm going to Washington DC for the National pageant..

JL: How long have you been doing this...performing, I mean?

ND: Just under three years.

JL: Since nineteen ninety-six. (Nova Nods.) How did you get into performing? ND: Actually, I went out for Halloween—which is another story—and one of the performers who was working at 219 saw me, and asked me to do a show. At first, I was like, "Oh, no no nonononon! this is just for Halloween!" But then later, she got me to do it. And once I did it, I was hooked! (Nova snaps her fingers and laughs)

JL: What's changed in your performance and in your persona, since you've started?

ND: My attitude and who I am haven't changed at all. When I started doing drag, as it were, I wouldn't be the typical drag queen. I'm not saying that a lot of my friends are this way, but everybody knows there's that whole thing about drags

queens being bitter, backstabbing, and all of that. I'm very determined not to be that way, and I think I've succeeded in that.

The way that "Nova" has changed, though, is better makeup, better hair, and better outfits. I was very tacky when I started.

JL: You've "classed up?" a bit?

ND: I think so, but I also don't think I'm the best I can be. The minute that you start thinking, "I'm the Diva in Wisconsin." it's over, because you don't know where to

.IL: For those of our readers who don't know where to see you perform live...

ND: I have a show at 219 in Milwaukee every other Thursday, and now I work every Sunday at the Late Show. We just started Early shows on

Sunday, at eight-thirty. I emcee the early show, and perform in the late show.

JL: And we can see you every other Thursday, too.

ND: (Corrects me) People should also come for Lily White's night, the opposite Thursday.

JL: Did you do any other types of performing before you got into drag?

ND: Yeah, I was in plays in high school. I mean, I loved being on stage. Anyone who is shy to the stage wouldn't be able to do something like this. Being onstage is another whole world, having all of those people looking at you.

JL: Of course you like the attention, but it's the fact that you're performing for them and that they appreciate it—that's the high! ND: Exactly!

JL: It's been mentioned by some people that perhaps that although there was a growth of drag earlier in the decade, that the art of impersonation is in a state of decline right now.

ND: I think that the tapering off has already happened, and now it's on the rise again, I think. Due to people like RuPaul and other music artists using female impersonators in their videos, I think it's on the rise again.

JL: What do you think the performers could do, as artists, to promote impersonation?

ND: I think as performers ourselves, what we could do to get it back up to where it was before is to just be interesting. A lot of times, performers will wear the same costumes time after time, do the same music time after time, and that's not a good thing, because how many times do people wanna see somebody do the same song over and over? It's got to be interesting and current.

JL: OK, that makes sense. What are you doing to be interesting and current?

ND: What I've been doing is...(thinks about it for a moment) more costumes and trying to learn more music. You see, I've never had a certain style of music. I've tried everything. And now I think I'm getting into my niche. I'm finding where I should be and what type of music I should do.

JL:Do you want to talk about your "boy" life?

ND: Yes...I'm very, very busy! (Laughs) I've had the same partner for the last seven years. His name is Mario. I don't ever intend on stopping that. I'm a full time father of two children, and they are also very involved with their mother. Mario and I have a cleaning business called "A" Cleaning Service (in Milwaukee 414/264-6520) and I also work in a nail salon. I make all of my costumes, along with my friend Donna. I have a very full plate, and I wouldn't be satisfied if I didn't.

As I made my exit to be on time for my date, I asked Miss Nova D'Vine if she had any messages she wanted me to carry to you.

ND: Support us, because we definitely support all of the people out there. There is a lot going on in our community. A lot of times people will say "have fun", like a cliche, but I really mean it-Have Fun!

I'd like to personally wish Nova all the best on her journey to Washington DC for Nationals—she should be competing as this issue goes to print. Bring back the crown, girl!






