

treated to four different choices for gay press, each with a distinctively different look and

feel. It is rare to have this many choices and you the reader are lucky indeed!

There has been a myth that Quest is a paper for Green Bay because it is based there. Actually we have always covered events around the state and even beyond it's borders. We send copies to nearly every gay bar in the state and we are available in many non-gay businesses as well. We have a very strong following in Milwaukee and of course our home market in the Fox Valley. We are the first and still the only Wisconsin Gay paper to produce and print in-house. We are professionally printed on high quality white bond paper and we keep the costs down by owning the presses ourself. We are the first gay paper in Wisconsin to make it easier to reach us using an 800 toll free number. We have had the most consistent web site to date, and we have made small improvements such as developing a regional website for the leather community inside our own site. I should also note, we do not have any ads on our website either. At this time it is still totally FREE as a reader service the same as our classified ads have been for 6 years.

There is a myth advertising in Wisconsin's gay press is expensive. I can tell you it is costly to run a paper. When you compare prices in the four Wisconsin papers with other states, you are quick to discover prices here are a bargain! It is important to include how many copies of a paper is being printed and where it is distributed as well as how large the ad size is and it's price. When you compare all these factors, Quest still has the lowest prices of all four papers. We are mainly aimed at the bar going public and therefore we have a decidedly more male readership that also tends to be younger. If that is the group you want to reach, give us a call! Several advertisers who have used Quest along with other publications tell us they get their best results in Quest. Perhaps we will work great for you as well.

There are always sacrifices when trying to keep a lid on costs. Quest wanted to serve the bar scene with a paper that was inexpensive to advertise in so we included a toll free number to call us, but no staff for selling ads. If a business is willing to make the effort to contact us, we both get a better deal! If you wondered why we are not aggressively seeking your ads, now you have the answer.

We have asked people if we should join the others and change our size to a larger book. The response has been a definite no. Apparently people really do like our smaller size. It is easier to pick up and take home with you. We keep the content simple too. Wisconsin Light and In Step are already two great papers for covering news. Quest covers entertainment relative to the gay lifestyle. We try to be fair and give as many areas of the state coverage as we can. This includes markets that have never advertised in Quest!

We will continue to cover entertainment including reviews on music, books and even adult films written by our own writers. We currently run two syndicated columns we think are the best in the biz. *Past Out* by David Bianco and new to Quest and most of the country, *Tell Trinity*, an advice column by the next lady of Jazz, Trinity. The rest we do ourself with mostly volunteer staff who help out because they want to be an active part of our wonderful gay community just as Quest does.

We will not be adding a letters to the editor column at this time. These columns do little more than allow free space for someone to attack another person. This doesn't help the community and I want no part of it. If you have a bitch with Quest, feel free to call me and take your aggression out in person. It's TOLL FREE! 1-800-5QUEST5

How is her first tour going? "Great!" she says energetically. It's probably not entirely due to the fact that she's doing her outfit shopping in the Garment District today, but I'm sure that doesn't hurt! When asked about her touring experience, she laughs and relates her first time performing live. It was on a float in the Pride Parade out east. "There not as smooth as you think...lots of starting and stopping."





## The history of butch-femme identity in lesbian culture

"Butch-femme" usually signifies the lesbian bar culture of the middle part of the 20th century. But the origins of butch-femme identity may go back at least 100 years before that time, and its social and cultural legacy continues to the present day.

The exact origins of butchfemme identity are unknown, though there are scattered 19thcentury references to female companions who might be the precursors of later butches and femmes. In the 1820s, for example, "Miss Willson and Miss Brundage" were two unmarried women who lived together on a farm in upstate New York. Sarah Brundage wore the pants in the family - literally - and undertook traditionally male chores, like plowing and planting. By contrast, Mary Ann Willson

Brvant made a brief reference to another proto-butch-femme couple whom he had encountered in northern Vermont, "One of them ... might be said to represent the male head of the family," Bryant wrote; the other he described as "a gentle companion, ... a fond wife.'

In the late 19th and early 20th centuries, a number of upper-class women paired off in romantic relationships, with one partner perceived as "mannish" in appearance and manner, while the other was more traditionally "feminine." Poet Amy Lowell, for example, smoked cigars and wore tailored suits, while her companion, Ada Dwyer Russell, gave up her career on the stage to type Lowell's manuscripts. Gertrude Stein and Alice B. Toklas were another prominent female couple whose relationship

incorporated traditional heterosexual gender roles; the two even referred to each other as "Hubbie" and "Wifie."

In the 1920s, British writer Radclyffe Hall immortalized a butch-femme couple in her novel, The Well of Loneliness. Hall's Stephen Gordon was a classic butch woman, based on actual case studies of female "inverts" from the files of sexologist Havelock Ellis, who perceived lesbians to be men trapped in women's bodies. By contrast, Stephen's lover Mary was more feminine and therefore not a true invert. Lesbian historians have suggested that Hall's widely read novel may have set the stage for the butch-femme culture that began forming in American cities in the following decade.

Unlike Hall's focus on aristocrats, recent historians have studied working-class butch-femme couples of the mid-20th century. With the rise of industrialization and the growth of cities in the years following both world wars, working-class women were freer to move away from their families. find iobs, remain unmarried, and form social networks. An urban lesbian subculture began to emerge and thrive particularly well in bars - havens where women could meet each other for love and friendship.

The subculture of lesbian bars had rules that governed its membership: a lesbian (or "gay girl," as was often said at the time) was either butch or femme. Codes for dress and behavior were strict. One lesbian bar in Massachusetts even had separate washrooms, with doors marked "butches" and "femmes."

Butches - or studs, as they were also called - dressed in male attire, held doors for their femmes, and lit their cigarettes. But "I never considered myself being a man," Mabel Hampton, an African-

American lesbian said of her butch identity. "I never liked the men that much. And anything I don't like, I don't take up." Femmes, on the other hand, cultivated a more traditionally feminine appearance and manner, often wearing high heels and makeup and acting demure.

Some lesbians found it difficult to find a place for themselves within this strict dichotomy. In her memoirs, poet Audre Lorde described the quandary of being unable to identify as either butch or femme. "I wasn't cute or passive enough to be 'femme,' and I wasn't mean or tough enough to be 'butch." Lorde wrote. "I was given a wide berth." Women who refused to choose one or the other role were sometimes called "kiki."

Besides being a social set-up, butch-femme identity also constituted a security system. Butchfemme couples, who were more obviously queer than middle-class lesbians, often faced anti-gay harassment, rape, and other violence. Butches, who were seen as usurping male privilege, were particularly targeted by straight men. The butch's job was to protect herself and her femme. "I took care of my woman," Hampton said proudly of her long relationship with Lillian Robinson.

Sometimes violence erupted among butches themselves.

though. One lesbian in Buffalo recalled a raucous night in a bar when "glasses were flying and everything. I remember I went under a table and thought, 'Oh God! What is this?" But the woman continued to frequent the bar because it was the only place in town, she noted, "where I could get to know people like me.'

With the coming of the women's liberation movement, some lesbians of the 1960s and 1970s dismissed butch-femme roles as imitative of heterosexuals.

In place of butch-femme, many lesbians opted for an androgynous look and manner as a feminist political statement.

But butch-femme roles earlier in the century were political, too. They provided a way for lesbians to maintain a separate space for themselves and survive in a hostile environment, and that in turn led to the forging of lesbian identities. In the 1980s, many lesbians began to reclaim butch-femme identity, and it remains an important means of expression in contemporary lesbian culture.

#### **HIV Cases Rise Sharply Among Women.** Youth & African Americans

A startling new trend of increased HIV infections among women, youth and communities of color has been reported in Wisconsin.

According to data recently released by the State AIDS/HIV Program, the rate of new HIV infections catapulted 15% among Wisconsin women and 14% among African Americans in 1999. New HIV infections among youth more than doubled last year.

The state reports 375 new HIV infections in 1999, down slightly from the 380 new HIV infections reported in 1998.

As of Dec. 31, a total of 997 women, 153 teens, 2,161 African Americans and 516 Hispanic individuals have been diagnosed with HIV in Wisconsin.




