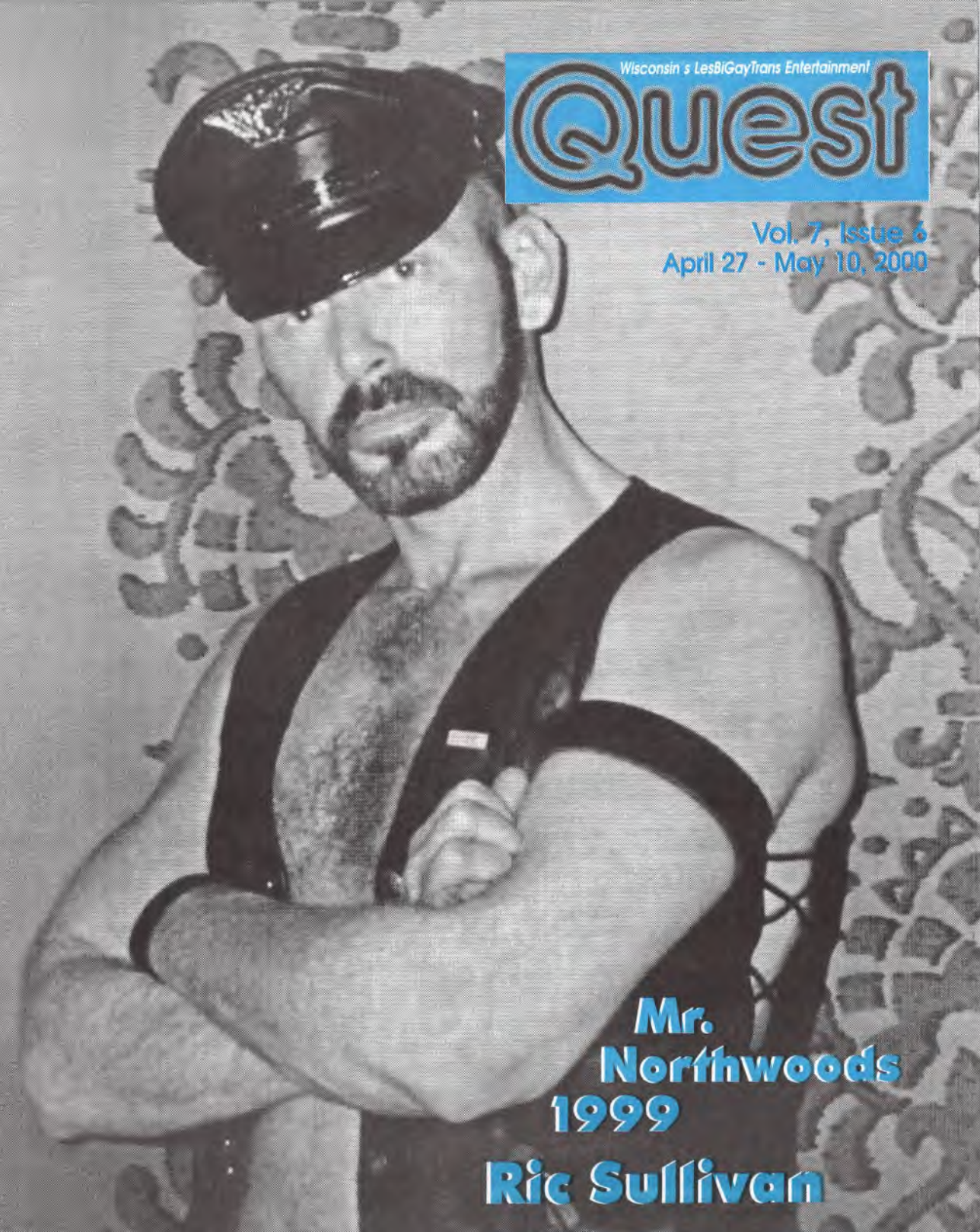

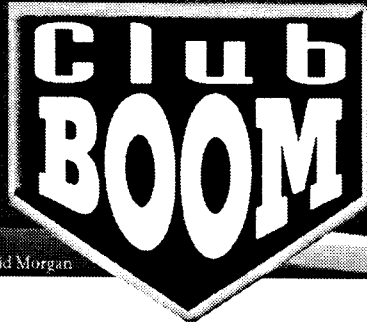

April 26, 1970 (30 years ago this week): The musical play *Company*, with score and lyrics by Stephen Sondheim, opens in New York City.

Musical Theater Composer Stephen Sondheim

By the age of 21, Stephen Sondheim had met and gotten pointers from both Oscar Hammerstein II and Cole Porter. With luck, connections, and talent, he became one of the greatest lyricists and composers in American musical theater.

Born in New York City on March 22, 1930, Stephen was the only child of Herbert Sondheim, a dress manufacturer, and his wife, "Foxy," a fashion designer. Herbert's favorite pastime was playing the piano for his family and friends. Although Stephen took up piano at age 7, he was not initially very interested in music. But his parents' divorce in 1941 inadvertently changed that.

Foxy used her divorce settlement to buy a farm in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and moved herself and her son there. Famed songwriter Oscar Hammerstein II and his family lived nearby, and because Stephen had been friendly with one of the Hammerstein children in New York, he quickly became a fixture in their household.

Having taken Broadway by storm with *Oklahoma!* and *Carousel*, Hammerstein was at the peak of his career, and the young Sondheim began consciously emulating his famous neighbor. He wrote his first songs at 15 and soon after expanded them into a three-act play called *By George*, which was produced at his private high school.

Sondheim dreamed of Broadway, but Hammerstein dashed his hopes when he read the play. "If you want to know why it's terrible, I'll tell you," Hammerstein said, launching a relationship of master and apprentice that lasted until the older man's death in 1960. Hammerstein suggested a plan of action for learning to write

musicals: pick a play he liked, improve on it, and add music.

At Williams College, Sondheim undertook a musicalization of George S. Kaufman's *Beggar on Horseback*. Sondheim's drama professor knew Cole Porter, who lived near the college, and Porter agreed to listen to the score of Sondheim's version, *All That Glitters*. Sondheim recalled that the composer "would come to the piano ... and say, 'Wouldn't that sound a little better that way?'" Years later, Sondheim consulted with Porter again, when he was writing the lyrics for *Gypsy*.

During college, Sondheim took a summer job as the office boy for Hammerstein's *Allegro*, a highly innovative play that flopped. "It was the seminal influence on my life," Sondheim claimed, and the reason he was drawn to doing adventurous, experimental work throughout his career.

After graduation, Sondheim studied with the avant-garde composer Milton Babbitt. When Sondheim's music fellowship ran out, Hammerstein came to his aid again, helping him get a job as a scriptwriter for a new television series, *Topper*. The series was successful and Sondheim's future in television looked promising. But his desire to write Broadway musicals hadn't diminished. He set himself the goal of having a play on Broadway by his 30th birthday.

His luck ebbed and flowed. What looked like his big break came in 1955, when he was picked to write the music and lyrics of a Broadway-bound musical called *Saturday Night*. The show languished, however, when its producer suddenly died.

At the same time, Sondheim became friendly with Arthur

Laurents. Laurents was working on the book of a new play, a modern retelling of the Romeo and Juliet story, with music by Leonard Bernstein and choreography by Jerome Robbins. Bernstein needed a lyricist, and, though Sondheim wanted to be a composer, he took the job anyway.

Sondheim got to Broadway in 1957, three years before his goal. Though *West Side Story* was a critical hit, Sondheim later dismissed the play as "melodrama" and most of his lyrics as "self-conscious."

After his first success, opportunities flew Sondheim's way. Laurents was writing the book for a musical based on the life of stripper Gypsy Rose Lee, and he suggested Sondheim as composer and lyricist. But the star, Ethel Merman, didn't want an unproven composer. Jule Styne was enlisted for the music, and Sondheim was offered the job of lyricist. Though disappointed, he listened to Hammerstein's advice once again: Writing for Merman was worth the postponement of his composing career.

Gypsy (1959), another hit, was the last play for which Sondheim wrote lyrics without also composing the music. He followed *Gypsy* with a string of critical and popular successes. Each new production, with increasingly complex music and lyrics, helped innovate a new, more adventurous musical form: *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* (1962), *Company* (1970), *Follies* (1971), *A Little Night Music* (1973), *Sweeney Todd* (1979), *Sunday in the Park with George* (1984), *Into the Woods* (1987), and

Passion (1994).

Throughout most of his astonishing career, Sondheim's private life remained an enigma. There was a much-publicized "romance" with actress Lee Remick in the 1960s, but the relationship was probably never sexual. As Remick's mother put it, "Everyone knew he wasn't interested in girls that way."

In fact, Sondheim began questioning his sexuality in college, when he realized that there was "something different" about him. Men made passes at him when he first came to New York after graduation, but it took a while before he actually had sex with another man. "I was sexually very late blooming," he said.

Sondheim's first long-term relationship began late in his life, with a younger man named Peter Jones, whom he met in 1991. The two eventually lived together and exchanged wedding rings (but Jones has since moved out). Finally, in an authorized biography published in 1998, Sondheim came out publicly as gay.

Now in his 70s, Sondheim is still a force in musical theater. The story for his next play (with the working title *Wise Guys*), about two enterprising brothers named Addison and Wilson Mizner, has been in the back of his mind since the 1950s. Though the lead character in *Company* was a 30-something bachelor, *Wise Guys* is Sondheim's first play with a bona-fide gay character.

Governor Bush: "I Welcome Gay Americans" & "Sexual Orientation Not a Factor in Hiring"

Recently Governor George W. Bush, Republican candidate for President, met with gay Republicans and declared, "I welcome gay Americans into my campaign."

In a 90 minute meeting, Bush told twelve gay and lesbian leaders from five states and the District of Columbia that sexual orientation was "not a factor" in hiring in his administration.

Bush also confirmed his support for the continued funding of the Ryan White CARE Act, and expanded funding for AIDS/HIV research through the National Institutes of Health. (The legislation was first signed by his father, President Bush.)

The Governor said everyone should be treated with respect and dignity and condemned the name calling of the past. "We judge people based on their heart and soul. That's what the campaign is about."

"I am a better person" for having met with this group, Bush said at a press conference immediately following the meeting. He added, "It's important for the next President to listen to people's real life stories. These are people from our neighborhoods, people with whom all of us went to school. I appre-



Q. Leather, the care and cleaning of.

Even if you have a boot boy, you should know a few basics. Unless you have a fancy or suede finsh, water will not hurt the leather. Prolonged heat does the most damage. Never put your boots, for that matter any leather near heat, especially when drying it. To dry, hang at room temperature until dry, and them stick the garment, which may be a bit stiff, in the clothes dryer on high heat for about 5 minutes and then tumble for a bit more. After that a light coating of your favorite conditioner or oil is all you need.

Beware of too much oil, for you might leave an oil slick when you sit.

Back in my Army days, when you got new boots, you put them on and walked in a mud puddle or stood in the shower with them on. I know it sounds like I never gave up splashing in puddles like I did as a toddler, but the purpose was to get them to form to your feet. Wet leather will form to fit.

If your boots are dirty and dry, brushing/wiping don't do it, go at it with a wet rag or brush. You can use mild soap if you need to, just remember to rinse thoroughly, let dry and then apply oil or conditioner. In the case of chaps, vests and even jackets, you can stick them in the washing machine. This is especially good if you have a new garment and you want to get the new "rookie" smell out of it. Use a longer cycle if you are going for the "I've been around" look.

Q. Leather, the storage of

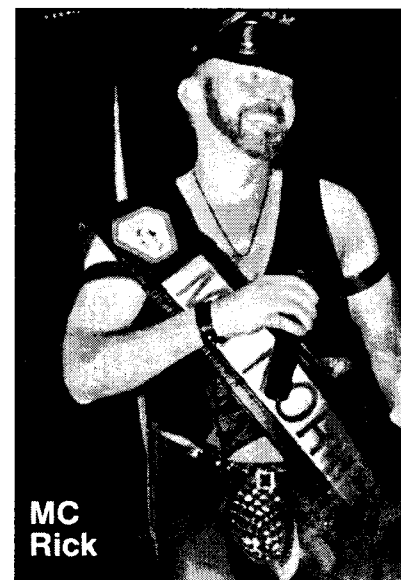
Try to remember leather will take the shape you allow it to have. If you store your boots upright where the tops can collapse, fall over or crease, it will not be long and you will have a bitch of a time getting it back in shape. The same will happen if you fold your pants, chaps etc and store it on a shelf for a couple of months. Hangers can also distort the shape of leather garments.

Boot storage: Probably the best is to hang them by the tops and insert something tubular inside to keep them from collapsing

inward. This could be carpet cores, heavy mailing tubes, but one of the best I have found, is soda and water bottles. They come in many sizes and there is one just the right size for every boot.

If they are to be storred for extended periods, the toes will tend to curl upward if the toes and insteps are not stuffed with newspaper or the like.

Garment storage: Rotate, re-fold or re-hang your garments two or more times a year, making sure you don't repeat the same crease. Padding hangers with old towels for more bulk, will prevent that crease across the shoulders.

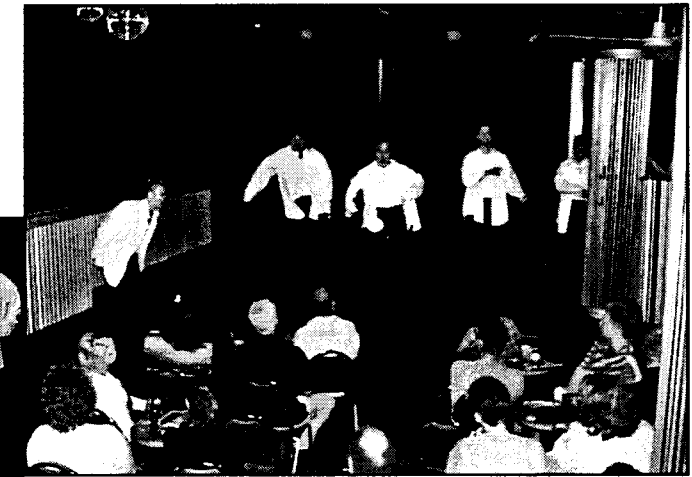
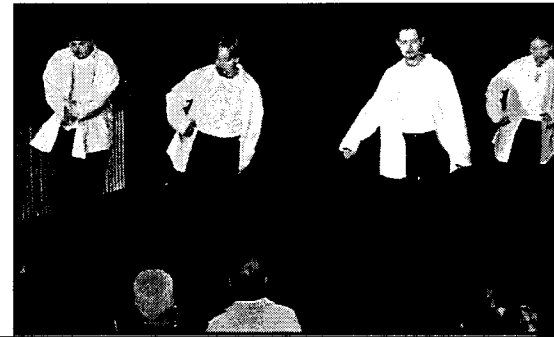
