Gay Soldiers ask Congress to Include Acknowledged Homosexuals in Military if Draft Returns

GROUP OF 15 GAYS AND LESBIANS CURRENTLY SERVING PETITIONS FRIST AND HASTERT

SANTA BARBARA, CA, January 7, 2003 - Following Representative Charles Rangel's announcement two weeks ago that he would recommend reinstating the draft, a group of 15 gays and lesbians now serving in all branches of the military has written to Congress to propose that if the draft returns, acknowledged homosexuals should be included in the armed forces.

The President of the group, known as the Gay and Lesbian Service Members for Equality (GLSME), submitted the January 6 letter to Congress through an intermediary, the Center for the Study of Sexual Minorities in the Military (CSSMM), in order to preserve anonymity. CSSMM staff members conducted background interviews and checks to verify GLSME's authenticity after the group's president first contacted them in November.

According to the letter, which was addressed to Senator William Frist and Representative Dennis Hastert, GLSME members propose "that if there is a draft, gays and lesbians should be included...and called on to sacrifice like everybody else. So, we ask you to call for the inclusion of acknowledged homosexuals if the draft is re-instated."

The letter follows last week's declaration by Professor Charles Moskos, the primary architect of the "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" policy, that the gay ban should be scrapped if the draft returns. Moskos said that "You can't use a gay ban with a draft because that would make it too easy for people to get out." A copy of GLSME's letter below.

Dear Senator Frist and Representative Hastert:

In this time of shared sacrifice, I am writing as President of the Gay and Lesbian Service Members for Equality, a new group of 15 gays and lesbians currently serving in all branches of the armed forces. All of us are dedicated to serving our country, and to making a difference. Every day when we go to work, we put on uniforms in which we take pride, and we do the work that we know can make a positive change in the world both at home and overseas. All of us are dedicated, hardworking, and loyal.

The Don't Ask, Don't Tell policy is harming the military by wasting precious talent and resources. Because of the policy, the loyal members of my group live under the threat of blackmail, exposure, and the loss of our careers. The simple fact that we are gay has no impact on our job performance, nor the performance or morale of those around us. All of us have heterosexual friends and coworkers who know that we are gay, and they do not care in the slightest. What is paramount amongst the ranks of today's military is professionalism, ability, and dedication, not the personal orientation of any particular member.

As Congress considers whether to end the military's system of voluntary enlistment, we are writing because we believe that if there is a draft, gays and lesbians should be included in the draft and called on to sacrifice like everybody else. So, we ask you to call for the inclusion of acknowledged homosexuals if the draft is re-instated. We know from personal experience that acknowledged gay and lesbian service members would not seek to undermine their units, to use the military to promote the acceptability of homosexuality, or to obtain special rights. Rather, they would simply seek the right to acknowledge who they are.

In this time of shared sacrifice, we believe that the military cannot afford to waste the talent of any American who is able to serve.

FREEDOM COMMUNICATIONS BECOMES FIRST NATIONAL NEWSPAPER CHAIN TO ENACT EQUAL ANNOUNCEMENTS POLICY

Following the lead of its flagship paper, "The Orange County [Calif.] Register," Freedom Communications Inc. has become the first national newspaper chain to enact a policy prescribing all its papers to print same-sex union announcements. Its new policy affects more than thirty newspapers throughout the country that print wedding announcements, including "The [Alton, Ill.] Telegraph," the "Brownsville [Texas] Herald," and "The [Panama City, Fla.] News Herald."

The policy change — confirmed to GLAAD by Janet Ryan, the assistant to the President of Freedom Community Newspapers on Dec. 17 — involves a total of 35 Freedom Communications newspapers across 11 states. Since August 2002, GLAAD has kept a tally of newspapers that print same-sex union announcements, and Freedom Communications' decision brings GLAAD's list to 181 papers.

"This is another huge step for gay and lesbian couples," said Joan M. Garry, executive director for the Gay & Lesbian Alliance Against Defamation (GLAAD). "We are proud to have fueled a discussion in the newspaper industry that leads corporations to consider the equity of their policies towards gay and lesbian readers. Freedom Communications deserves to be congratulated and should serve as a role model for other companies."

In August 2002, GLAAD launched its Announcing Equality project, a yearlong campaign to double the number of newspapers in the United States that print same-sex union announcements. The goal was met just a few months later, and GLAAD currently lists 181 papers that print same-sex union announcements.

Those included Sheila Hall, Gail Clodfelter, Allan Cook and Rev. David Morgan Seay. Rep. Larry McKeon was in attendance and his presence was known by the Mayor and Council.

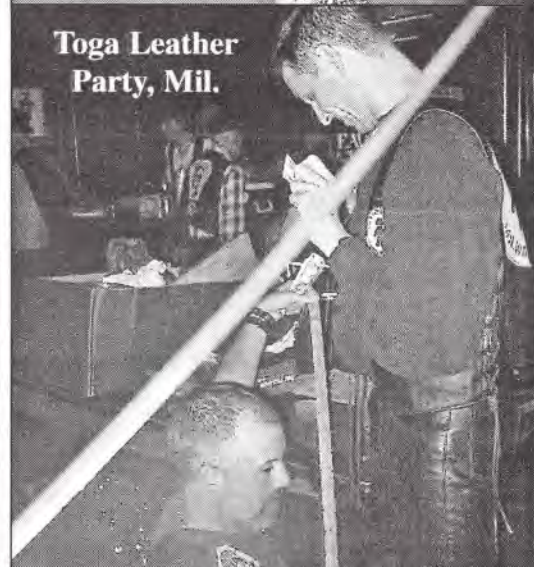

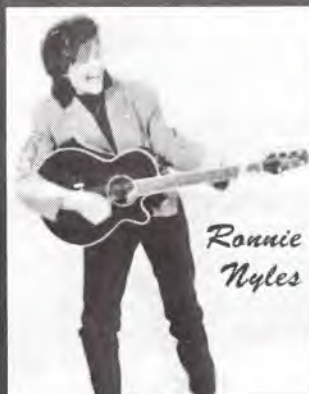
