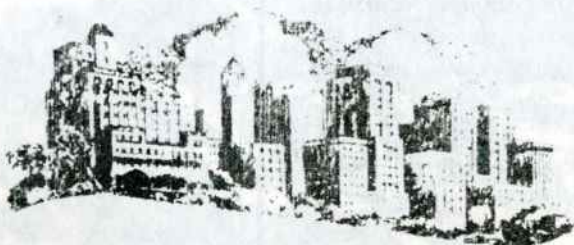

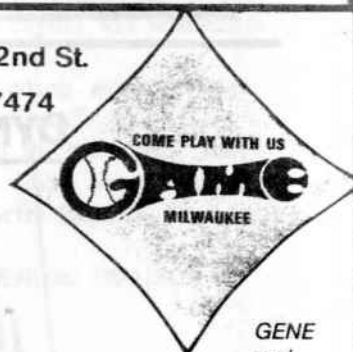

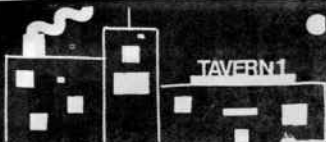
is that a lot of crap is getting played just because it is on video. Thats sad.

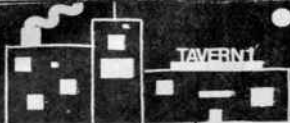

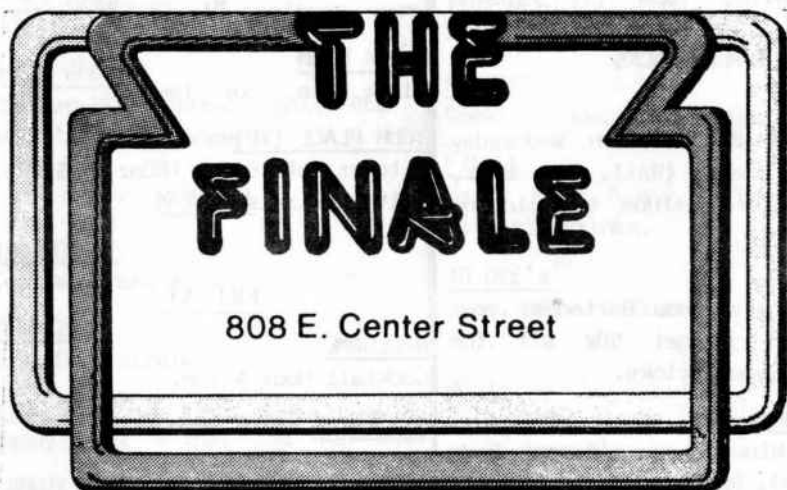

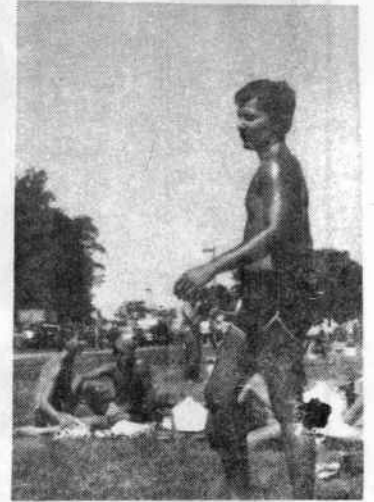
